D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN:

No driving pattern observed by officers. King was involved in a two car motor vehicle crash, driver of the opposing vehicle stated King made an improper U-turn at US Hwy One / Canal Point. Officer conducting the crash investigation found King at fault for failing to yield the right of way resulting in a crash.

In a sworn written statement the other driver Gay Johansen stated "after pulling over, the driver (blonde haired man) got out his truck to look at my car and his truck". Johansen observed King operating his vehicle at the time of the crash.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Upon approached to the vehicle I observed King standing at the rear of the vehicle. I made contact with King and immediately smelled an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from King's breath and his person. King was standing with his hands to his side presenting with an orbital sway from the center more than six inches. When I asked King to move to a more flat surface he slowly paced himself while walking to maintain his balance. King struggled to maintain his balance and repeatedly moved his stance from side to side. King repeatedly raised his hands more than 6 inches for balance and support. King was slow to respond to any questions or actions requested of him.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

When asked if king had consumed any alcohol he stated "two beers with lunch". After arrest, King repeatedly stated "this isn't how this works, you can't arrest me" and "I'm on medication". When ask during the initial interview if King was on medications he stated "you don't need to know" and "It's only topical".

ODORS:

Moderate amount of an unknown alcoholic beverage for his breath and his person. General body odor.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: slow, methodical, mush mouthed, confusing, repetitive, slurred,

ATTITUDE: Uncooperative at first then indifferent, relaxed, carefree with occasional profanity.

CLOTHING: patterned polo shirt, shorts, sandals

MEDICAL/OTHER: stated no medical issues other than taking a topical medication for a skin condition.

CAN NOT DO, WHY?

WALK AND TURN:

King was unable to stand in place and continued to shift his feet and sway during the instructional phase. King continued to start the task before instructions were completed. King was unable to walk heel to toe on any steps and stepped off line on steps 3, 4, 5, and upon return stepped off line on steps 2, 3, 6, 8, 11, 12. King took 10 steps on first half and 14 steps upon return. King continuously used hands for support by raising them over 6 inches for balance.

CAN NOT DO, WHY?

ONE LEG STAND:

King refused to stand in place during the instructional phase stating "I don't know why I have to". King continued to sway side to side and raised his arms more than 6 inches for balance. King began the task with his foot raised approximately 3-4 inches above the ground. King was began counting 1,2,3, and so on very fast then placed his foot down. I advised King again of the proper procedures and asked if he would like to restart the task he stated "No"

CAN NOT DO, WHY?

FINGER TO NOSE:

King was unable to stand in place during the instructional phase, King repeatedly separated his feet and raised to his arms more than six inches for balance. When asked to begin the task King continued open his eyes and move his head forward. The observations are as follows left - finger pad to top of nose, right - finger pad to side of nose, left - finger tip to side of nose, right - finger pad to bridge of nose, right - used left finger pad to top of nose, left - finger tip to side of nose.

CAN NOT DO, WHY?

ROMBERG / ALPHABET:

King did not wish to stand in place during this task and continuously separated his feet and raised his arms for balance. Upon start of the task King refused to close his eyes and would not tilt his head. King started his alphabet slow stating A,B,C,D,E,F,G,H,I,L,M,N,O,P paused for approximately 5 seconds and continued in a melodious rapping manner stating Q,R,S,T,U,V,W,X,Y,Z. Upon completion King then stated "that was a little rap for you"
