	On May 27, 2019, at approximately 2143 hours, I responded to 4000 N. Dixie Highway in reference to a vehicular traffic accident. Officer Crowe (ID#807) was also on scene and was the primary officer investigating the traffic accident. Upon my arrival, I made contact with one of the driver's involved in the accident; W/M, Gordon Krieger who was in operation of a red, 2002, Dodge Ram bearing Florida tag# Y61XCS. Krieger was the sole occupant in his vehicle.								
C A U S E	Upon my making contact with Krieger, I observed signs of impairment. I immediately detected the strong smell of an alcoholic beverage emanating from Krieger's person. His eyes were glassy and red and his pupils also appeared dilated. Krieger's face was red and flushed. He was slurring his words and stated numerous times that he did not know what had happened and how he had gotten involved in a car accident. Krieger stood up and then sat back down several times while on scene. I noticed that each time he stood up, he was uneasy on his feet and was stumbling. Krieger movements were extremely slow and deliberate. When I initially asked him for his driver's license he leisurely checked his pockets in an attempt to locate his wallet.								
	It was later determined via Officer's Crowe accident investigation that Krieger was the at-fault driver whom caused the accident. All parties involved in the accident were given a BRPD case card with the case number along with their vehicle documentations at the conclusion of the accident investigation. Officer Crowe issued Krieger the following traffic citations: Failure to Stop at a Steady Red Light, 316.075(1C1), A8EU09E and Driving with an Expired License over 6 Months 322.03(5), A8EU0AE. See Officer Crowe's accident report for further details. I subsequently read Krieger his Constitutional

Warnings from an agency issued Miranda Card at the conclusion of Officer Crowe's accident investigation. I informed Krieger that I had observed signs of impairment (alcohol on his breath, uneasy on his feet, and glossy eyes). I asked Krieger where he was coming from and he stated from his residence. He stated that he was at a bar named The Whistle Stop located at 395 NE Spanish River Blvd (Boca Raton) before. He stated that he was at The Whistle Stop for approximately 1 hour with some friends, had three beers, and did not eat while at the bar. Krieger stated again, "that he did not see a red light, he was just driving, and all of sudden bam, everything hit him". He also stated that he was driving through the light and did not think that he ran a red light. Krieger stated that "he did not see it coming". I asked Krieger to perform several field sobriety tasks to dispel my alarm that he was impaired. Krieger stated that he did not want to perform field sobriety tasks. I informed Krieger that my decision would therefore be based on my observations of him. I asked Krieger once more if he would perform several field sobriety tasks to dispel my alarm that he was impaired. He stated that he did not want to perform field sobriety tasks to dispel my alarm that he was impaired. On May 28, 2019, at 2302 hours, Gordon Brent Krieger was placed under arrest for DUI pursuant to F.S.S 316.193(1). He was given a court date of Monday July 1, 2019 at 0830 hours at the Delray Beach courthouse. He was subsequently transported to BRPD booking facility in marked BRPD unit (345). Officer Renteria (ID#800) was inside the holding facility for the Intoxilyzer 8000 testing. I asked Krieger if he would submit to a lawful test of his breath for the purpose of determining its alcohol content. Krieger refused to submit to a lawful test of his breath. Due to having a prior suspension for Refusal to Submit to Lawful Test of Breath, Urine, Blood. Krieger was also charged with Refusal to Submit to A BAL Test pursuant to F.S.S 316.1939(1E). Krieger was transported to Palm Beach County Jail. It should be noted that James Garner observed/witnessed Krieger in control of his vehicle. He also observed Krieger exit his vehicle and approach another person involved in the crash. Garner completed a sworn written statement which was submitted into BRPD evidence.
