## PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On the aforementioned date at approximately 2156 hours, I responded to the area of S.R. 706 (W Indiantown Rd.) and N Pennock Ln. in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, FL as a backup unit for Officer Schneider, who had conducted a traffic stop on a gray 2017 Toyota Tacoma bearing FL tag # DCE65. At the time, I was driving an unmarked Jupiter Police Department patrol vehicle (vehicle 1916), I was wearing a JPD uniform clearly identifying myself as a Jupiter Police Officer, and I was wearing my department-issued Axon body camera. Upon arrival, I made contact with Officer Schneider who advised the following: He was traveling westbound on S.R. 706, approaching Pennock Ln when he observed the aforementioned vehicle apparently having difficulty maintaining its lane. He stated he observed the vehicle weaving within and across the lane lines and almost struck another vehicle traveling the same direction. When he turned on his overhead emergency lights, the vehicle came to an abrupt stop in the left turn lane in front of the Brass Ring (1150 W Indiantown Rd.). See supplement from Officer Schneider.

## OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I approached the vehicle on the driver side and made contact with the driver and sole-occupant of the vehicle, identified to me by his valid Class E Florida driver license to be Irenaldo Garcia III (w/m; 12/02/1971). Garcia's vehicle was off and the key to the vehicle was on the roof, above Garcia's head. When I made contact with Garcia, I immediately noted he had very glassy eyes. I requested Garcia provide updated registration and insurance information, as the information he provided to Officer Schneider was expired. Garcia opened the glove compartment and removed a large stack of papers. Garcia flopped the papers on the front passenger seat of the vehicle although it appeared as though this was not his intent (poor dexterity/coordination). I noted Garcia's speech was heavily slurred and I could smell the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on Garcia's breath. After searching through the paperwork on the passenger seat, Garcia provided me with an up-to-date registration but appeared to have forgotten to provide me with his insurance information.

## DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Garcia advised he was picking up his girlfriend from "Mango's" (Johnny Mango's - local bar in Jupiter). Garcia advised she ended up getting an Uber back to the house and that's why he was the only occupant of his vehicle at the time of the stop. Garcia advised he was drinking at the bar before driving his vehicle, stating he had one Stolli (vodka) and soda before he left. When I asked Garcia to exit the vehicle, Garcia advised he was not going to do anything without a lawyer present. At this point, I advised Garcia of his Taylor Warnings, and he stated he was willing to complete roadside tasks.

## ODORS:

Strong odor of unknown alcoholic beverage on Garcia's breath which intensified as he spoke.

## GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Heavily slurred

ATTITUDE: Cooperative, Carefree

CLOTHING: Green t-shirt, Tan cargo shorts, Black sandals

MEDICAL/OTHER: Garcia advised he does not take medications, has no medical problems, is not diabetic, and is not epileptic.

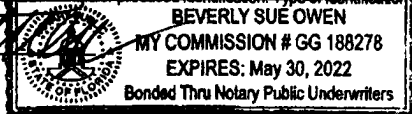

**Other Observations:**

I attempted multiple times to check Garcia's eyes for the aforementioned Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus clues. Each time the stimulus was moved to check for equal tracking, Garcia would either slightly follow the stimulus or remain focused straight ahead instead of following the stimulus. Garcia was given multiple reminders to keep his eyes on the stimulus and follow it with his eyes. After multiple attempts to check Garcia's eyes proved unsuccessful, I terminated the task.

**WALK & TURN:**

Garcia had an extremely difficult time remaining in the starting position. When the instructions were given for the starting position, Garcia would place his left foot on the line, right foot in front (leaving a small gap between his feet) and immediately start walking. Garcia continued this behavior multiple times before finally standing appropriately while the instructions were given. During the Instructions Stage, Garcia lost his balance several times, breaking his feet from the line each time. On the first walk down the line, Garcia missed heel-to-toe on every step. Garcia took a total of 9 steps down the line prior to turning. Garcia turned improperly by taking small steps with both his feet to turn around. On the return walk, Garcia missed heel-to-toe again on every step. Garcia stepped off the line, to the right, on steps 3, 4, and 9. Garcia took a total of 9 steps back down the line.

**ONE LEG STAND:**

Garcia elected to raise his right leg off the ground, standing planted on his left. Garcia almost immediately swayed to his right and raised his left hand from his side to balance. Garcia had to be reminded to watch his elevated foot. On Garcia's count of 1004, he placed his foot on the ground. Garcia attempted to raise his right foot off the ground again (counting over from 1001) and almost immediately lost his balance, to his right, and placed his foot on the ground. I advised Garcia to keep going until told to stop and he advised "I'm done." I again advised Garcia of his Taylor Warnings and asked if he was willing to continue. Garcia advised he wanted to continue with SFSTs.

**FINGER TO NOSE:**

Before starting the task, Garcia advised he did not know his left from his right. I asked Garcia what he would do if I said left, he raised his left hand and touched his finger to his nose. I asked what he would do if I called right, and he raised his right hand, touching his right finger to his nose. Although he stated he did not know his left from his right, Garcia appeared to have demonstrated understanding of his left and right and I continued with the task. On the first call of left, Garcia touched the pad of his left finger to the tip of his nose. On the first call of right, Garcia touched the pad of his right finger to the tip of his nose. On the second call of left, Garcia touched the pad of his left finger to the tip of his nose. On the second call of right, Garcia touched the pad of his right finger to the tip of his nose. On the final call of right, Garcia opened his eyes and touched the pad of his right finger to the tip of his nose. On the final call of left, Garcia touched the pad of his left finger to the tip of his nose.

Prior to completing the task, Garcia advised he had completed some college and was comfortable with the alphabet from A to Z. Garcia Recited the alphabet as the following: ABCDEFGJIH \*pause\* KLMO \*pause\* NOMS

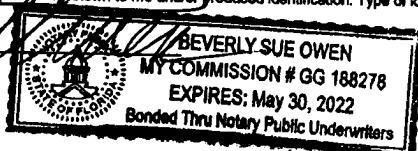

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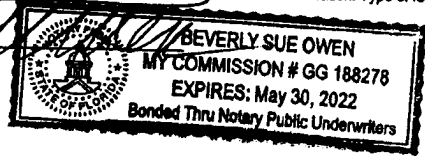

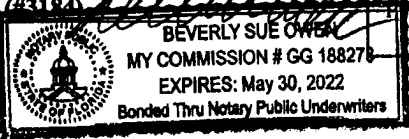
