# D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

## PERSONAL CONTACT

**DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)**  
Officer Kimbark observed a white sedan traveling eastbound on S.R. 706 (W Indiantown Rd.) traveling at a high rate of speed. He advised the vehicle was traveling at over 100 MPH in a posted 45 MPH zone and was approaching S.R. 809 (Military Trl.). Officer Kimbark continued to update the vehicle's location as it continued traveling east on S.R. 706. Officer Turner was in the area and located the vehicle traveling eastbound over the S.R. 706 bridge over the Intracoastal waterway. Officer Turner provided a tag number of FYPR70 (FL) which returned on a white 2013 Toyota Carolla. When the tag was run, it was determined that the registration for the tag expired on 12/23/2017. Officer Turner advised that the vehicle made a u-turn and was now traveling westbound on S.R. 706, back over the bridge. I observed officers activate their overhead emergency lights in the approximate area of S.R. 706, at the base of the aforementioned bridge, on the west side. The vehicle passed at least one suitable driveway to pull off the main road but continued on and slowly coming to a stop in the parking lot at 225 E Indiantown Rd. Officers approached the vehicle and identified the driver, and sole occupant of the vehicle, to be Ivan Valdes (w/m; 12/23/1984) by his suspended Florida driver license.

### OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I observed Valdes to have glassy eyes and slurred speech. As I spoke to Valdes, I could detect the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on his person, which intensified as he spoke. Valdes was unable to provide his registration or insurance information to Officer Kimbark or myself. Valdes advised he was coming from work (Ruth Christ Steakhouse) where he had consumed 2 "cocktails." When Valdes exited the vehicle, it appeared as if he began to lose his balance, to the rear, as he was leaning backwards and had to take a step back and use the open door to his vehicle to steady himself.

### DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Valdes advised he was coming from work (Ruth Christ Steakhouse). He further advised he consumed 2 "cocktails" prior to driving. After stating he had 2 cocktails, Valdes quickly changed his answer and stated he consumed 2 beers. He was unable to approximate how long ago he drank and advised he ate steak and seafood prior to drinking. While speaking with me, Valdes had slurred speech and stumbled over his words.

### ODORS:

Odor of unknown alcoholic beverage on person, which intensified as he spoke.

**SPEECH:** Slurred, Stumbling over words

**ATTITUDE:** Calm, Cooperative, Quiet, Mood Swings, Pleading, Crying

**CLOTHING:** White long-sleeve shirt, black pants, and black shoes



**Other Observations:**

Valdes had difficulty standing with his feet together, heels and toes touching. Initially, as the stimulus moved, Valdes was not moving his eyes with the stimulus and was keeping them fixated on me. While checking for Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation, Valdes continued to not watch the stimulus and his eyes were moving in the opposite direction as the stimulus. Valdes was moving his head along with the stimulus and had to be reminded several times to keep his head still and follow with his eyes only. Valdes continued to either move his head or refuse to move his eyes to follow the stimulus and I determined that Valdes was unable to successfully complete the task.

**WALK & TURN**

After acknowledging that he understood to stand in the starting position (left foot on the line, right foot in front heel-to-toe, and arms to his sides) until told to do so, Valdes failed to stay in the starting position during the Instructions Stage. Valdes placed his right foot off the line and stood with his feet approximately shoulder-width apart for the remainder of the Instructions Stage. At the conclusion of the Instructions Stage, Valdes continually stated "heel-to-toe" several times before beginning the task. Valdes stepped off the line, to the left, on steps 1 and 5. Valdes did not take 9 steps down the line, as instructed, but took a total of 11 steps and did not count any of his steps out loud, as instructed. Valdes turned by pivoting on his toes and appeared to lose his balance, to the rear and took a step to his rear to regain his balance. Valdes missed heel-to-toe on steps 8 and 10. Valdes stepped off the line on steps 2, 7, and 9. Valdes stepped off the line, to the right, on step 3.

**ONE LEG STAND:**

After being told to stand with his feet together, arms at his sides and not to move until told to do so, Valdes placed his hands on his hips and raised his right leg, mimicking my demonstration as I explained the task. Valdes raised his right leg off the ground and did not count out loud, as instructed. Valdes was swaying from side to side during the exercise. Valdes kept his leg raised for approximately 18 seconds before putting his foot on the ground and appearing to wait for further instruction from me instead of picking his foot back up off the ground, as instructed. At the conclusion of a timed 30 second period, I concluded the task.

**FINGER TO NOSE:**

After explaining the task to Valdes, he advised he understood but would not close his eyes, as instructed. When I gave the command of "left," Valdes did nothing. I explained the instructions to Valdes a second time and began the exercise. On the first call of "left," Valdes touched the pad of his left hand to the tip of his nose and did not return his hand to his side. On the first call of "right," Valdes touched the pad of his right finger to the tip of his nose and did not return his hand to his side. On the second call of "left," Valdes touched the pad of his left finger to the tip of his nose and did not return his hand to his side. On the second call of "right," Valdes touched the middle pad of his right finger to the tip of his nose and did not return his hand to his side. On the final call of "right," Valdes kept his right finger on his nose and stated "sir, yes sir." On the final call of "left," Valdes touched the pad of his left finger to the tip of his nose and did not return his hand to his side.

**ROMBERG ALPHABET:**

Valdes advised he had a doctorate degree and that he was comfortable with the alphabet. When advised to recite the entire English alphabet, Valdes advised he spoke a different language but he knew the English alphabet from A to Z. Valdes also advised that the task was "a little more difficult than normal" and advised he would do the best he could. When advised to begin, Valdes did not recite the English alphabet, as explained and demonstrated, and began reciting an alphabet that I could not understand. After several seconds, Valdes began counting, in Spanish, before I terminated the task.
