**PROBABLE CAUSE**

On the above date and time I was in service in Palm Beach County, FL. I was traveling northbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) north of Lantana Rd. (County Road 812). The weather was cloudy and the roadways were wet. As I was approaching 6th Ave. dispatch then put out a BOLO (Be On The Look Out) for a grey in color compact vehicle in which its driver was banging on the window of the complainant's vehicle window located southbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9) south of 6th Ave. I then advised dispatch of where I was located and that I would be enroute. As I was turning around on 6th Ave. to travel southbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9), dispatch then advised that the complainant advised that the person who was banging on their window got back in the grey in color vehicle and continued to travel southbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) and were approaching Lantana Rd. (County Road 812). As I got back and entered onto Interstate 95 (State Road 9) I observed a grey in color compact vehicle traveling in the inside HOV lane unable to maintain a single lane. I then advised dispatch that I had a visual possibly on the BOLO'd vehicle and if they could have the complainant advise if they see me and if they do if they can confirm that I am behind the correct vehicle. Dispatch then advised me that the complainant advised that I was behind the correct vehicle. I continued to observe the grey in color vehicle unable to maintain a single lane. The grey in color vehicle then traveled to the outside lane to exit off onto Lantana Rd. (County Road 812). I then activated my emergency lights and sirens in an attempt to conduct a traffic stop on the grey in color vehicle. The grey in color vehicle continued to travel up the exit ramp and came to a stop just before the traffic control signal located at the intersection of the southbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9) exit ramp and Lantana Rd. (County Road 812). I then advised the driver of the grey in color vehicle through my vehicles intercom to turn off the vehicle. Once I observed that the grey in color vehicle was turned off I then approached the grey in color vehicle on its drivers side. I then observed a Hispanic female driver in the drivers seat. Once contact was made with the female driver who was later identified to be Jasmine V. Sasauo 10/18/1992, I observed her eyes to be red and glossy in color. Ms. Sasauo was very incoherent upon my initial contact with her. Ms. Sasauo was then advised of the reasoning of the traffic stop and asked who was in the vehicle that she was said to be harassing. Ms. Sasauo then advised me that her girlfriend was in that vehicle. I could then smell the odor commonly associated with the smell of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her breath as she spoke to me. Ms. Sasauo was then asked if she had anything to drink tonight. Ms. Sasauo then advised me that she had two (2) Tito's (Vodka) and water. Ms. Sasauo was then asked to step out of the vehicle and go to the rear of her vehicle. As Ms. Sasauo was stepping out of her vehicle she was then asked if she had any drugs or weapons in the vehicle in which she then advised me that she did not. As Ms. Sasauo exited her vehicle I observed her to be off balance and stumble to the rear of her vehicle using her arms for balance. I then made contact with Ms. Sasauo at the rear of her vehicle and asked her where the incident with her girlfriend began. Ms. Sasauo then advised me that she was at Blue Martini in West Palm Beach. Ms. Sasauo also advised me that she was coming from work at Revolutions. Ms. Sasauo was then asked again if she had anything to drink and if she was sure it was only two (2) drinks. Ms. Sasauo then advised me that it was only two (2) drinks. Ms. Sasauo continued to sway back and forth and be off balance. I then went on to advise Ms. Sasauo that I had reason to believe that she was impaired and that I would now be requesting for her to perform a series of roadside exercises. Ms. Sasauo then advised me what would happen if she said no. Ms. Sasauo was then advised that if she did not perform the exercises that were requested of her to perform that she would be placed under arrest based off my observations of her and the information she had provided me. Ms. Sasauo then advised me that she would perform the exercises that I have requested of her to perform.

The area for the following roadside exercises was level and free of debris. Subject agreed to use a thick solid yellow straight line to perform the walk and turn exercise. Subject was then asked if she had any problems with her eyes aside from corrective vision, or injuries that would prevent her from performing any of the exercises that will be requested of her to perform. Subject then advised me that she did not have either eye or physical injuries or limitations and would be able to perform the exercises.

**Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:**

- Was not able to be performed due to Subject not being capable of following instructions after several attempts.

**Interaction Phase:**

- Subject had a hard time remaining in starting position. Subject swayed in starting position. Subject continued to lose balance. Subject continued to get out of starting position. The exercise was demonstrated and explained to the Subject. Subject advised she understood instructions and did not have any questions. Subject was not taking heel to toe steps. Subject lost balance. Subject stepped off line several times. Subject did not turn around as instructed. Subject used arms for balance. Subject took more than instructed steps. Subject attempted to conduct the exercise a second time. On the second attempt the Subject continued to lose balance. Subject continued to get out of the starting position. The exercise was demonstrated and explained to the Subject. Subject advised she understood instructions and did not have any questions. Subject was not taking heel to toe steps. Subject lost balance. Subject stepped off line several times. Subject did not turn around as instructed. Subject used arms for balance. Subject took more than instructed steps.

One Leg Stand Exercise:  
Interaction Phase:  
- Subject had a hard time remaining in starting position. Subject swayed in starting position. Subject continued to lose balance. Subject continued to get out of starting position. The exercise was demonstrated and explained to the Subject. Subject advised she understood instructions and did not have any questions.  
- Subject did not count as instructed. Subject hopped. Subject used arms for balance. I observed that the Subject was unable to conduct the exercises and was then advised that she could not conduct the exercise. The exercise was then concluded.

Finger to Nose:  
Interaction Phase:  
- Subject had a hard time remaining in starting position. Subject swayed in starting position. Subject continued to lose balance. Subject continued to get out of starting position. The exercise was explained to the Subject. Subject advised she understood instructions and did not have any questions. Subject swayed during exercise. Subject missed her nose. Subject would not keep her eyes shut. Subject continued to lose balance and the exercise was then concluded due to the Subject not being able to perform any further exercises.

Based on the totality of circumstances, Ms. Sasauo was placed under arrest for DUI pursuant to Florida Statute 316.193.1 at 01:38 AM. Ms. Sasauo was then searched and placed in the back of my patrol vehicle. During the inventory search of Ms. Sasauo's vehicle, little orange pills in a plastic bag were located in her glove box in which were possibly identified to be Alprazolam. Those pills will later be submitted into evidence for a laboratory analysis. Ms. Sasauo was then transported to the Palm Beach County Jail in which she arrived at 02:15 AM. After the defendants 20 min observation she was given the opportunity to provide a breath sample in which she refused to provide at 02:38 AM. The defendant was then given the opportunity to provide a sample of her urine in which she also refused to provide at 02:38 AM.




