Probable Cause				

On January 6th, 2018 I Trooper Lucas M. Tavares (3913/1421) with the Florida Highway Patrol was on active DUI patrol in Palm Beach County, Florida. I was in a marked FHP unit equipped with overhead emergency lights and external siren. At approximately 11:58 p.m. I received a call in reference to a white in color Chrysler 300 traveling, northbound on Interstate 95. The caller advised us that the vehicle did not have its lights on and was traveling all over the roadway. At one point the caller stated that the vehicle almost collided with another vehicle.

At approximately 12:01 a.m. January 7th, 2018 I observed the vehicle traveling northbound on Interstate-95 at Hypoluxo Road. The vehicle was in lane number two. It was a white in color Chrysler 300, which matched the description of what the caller stated. The vehicle did not have its head lights on and did not have its rear lights on. I observed the vehicle to be heavily swaying from lane to lane. The vehicle was straddling lanes and making sharp adjustments to the point other

vehicles were avoiding the immediate area around the vehicle. The vehicle was varying in speed from approximately 70 mph to 50 mph.

Based upon my observations of the vehicle and the infractions I initiated a traffic stop upon the vehicle. I activated my emergency lights and sirens at I-95 (NB) at Lantana Rd. There Tpr. Todd (1577) joined behind me. The vehicle took longer than usual to pull over, but got over to the right paved shoulder. The vehicle contained two people.

I then approached the driver's side of the vehicle. The driver was a white male wearing a blue shirt. Once I approached the window the driver rolled down the rear left window and had trouble pushing the window button. I then demanded his license and registration for the vehicle. The driver then attempted to get his license out of his wallet, in which his passenger had to assist. While standing out of the vehicle I could detect a very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the direction of the open window. I observed the driver's eyes to be bloodshot and watery. His movements were lethargic and slow. I asked him if he was ok and he stated yes. I asked him if the vehicle was ok and he stated yes. I asked if he had anything to drink and he stated no. I then advised him that I detect alcohol and he stated he only had two beers. I later identified the driver to be Jason Steven Vanderloo by his Florida's Driver's License: (V536-437-77-222-0).

Suspect vehicle: 2015 White Chrysler 300 with Florida Tag: (GXUT12) attached.

I then had Mr. Vanderloo step out of the vehicle to the rear. While outside of his vehicle he was swaying. His speech was slurred and his eyes were bloodshot and watery. I could detect a very strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on his breath that grew stronger as he spoke.

Based upon my observations I requested Mr. Vanderloo to perform field sobriety exercises in which he consented to do.

Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE):

The area for the following roadside exercises was level hard surface and was free of debris. The weather was clear.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

I advised the subject to stand straight with their feet together and arms down by their side. I asked subject if they wear any glasses or contacts, they advised they do not. For the exercise I used my issued red in color pen light. I asked the subject if they could see the red pen light, they stated yes. The subject was asked about any current medical conditions, they stated that they he does not. I advised the subject to follow the red pen light with their eyes, and to not move their head. I asked subject if they understood the instructions I gave to them. They stated yes. I asked if they had any questions they stated no.

The following was observed during Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

The subject did have dilated pupils.

Subject could not follow the red pen light with their eyes. Subject was not following the red pen light, he was staring

straight ahead. I had to instruct subject multiple times to keep their head straight and follow the red pen light with their eyes. While standing within close proximity of the subject, I could detect a strong and distinct odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage, and their eyes were bloodshot and watery. Subject was swaying.

The following was observed during Vertical Gaze Nystagmus:

- Subject had Vertical Nystagmus.

Lack of Convergence:

-Subject did not have lack of convergence. Subject was swaying.

Walk and Turn Exercise:

Interaction Phase:

The area for the following roadside exercises was level and free of debris. We used a white in color traffic line.

I advised the subject to place their left foot on the white in color line and their right foot directly in front of it, touching heel to toe. I advised the subject to keep their arms down by their side and to stay in that position until I advise them to begin the exercise. This exercise was first explained to the subject then was demonstrated by myself. Subject advised that they would be able to perform the exercise. Subject advised that they had no injuries that would affect the exercise. Subject advised me that they understood instructions and did not have any questions.

- The following was observed during the instructional phase of the exercise:

The subject could not keep balance while in the starting position, stepped out.

- The following was observed during the walking phase of the exercise:

The subject missed heel to toe on multiple steps. The subject performed an improper turn (not as instructed). Subject stopped after the turn. Subject used hands for balance.

One Leg Stand Exercise:

The area for the following roadside exercises was level and free of debris.

I instructed the subject to stand with their feet together and keep their arms down by his side. I instructed the subject to stay in that position until I tell them to start the exercise. This exercise was first explained to the subject then was demonstrated by myself. Subject advised that they will be able to perform the exercise. Subject advised me that they had no injuries that would affect the exercise. Subject advised that they understood instructions and did not have any questions

- The following was observed during the exercise:

Subject did not raise his foot, used his arms for balance, did not look at raised foot as instructed, and did not count as instructed.

Based upon my observations and the totality of circumstances, Mr. Vanderloo was placed under arrest for DUI pursuant to Florida Statute 316.193.1 at 12:13 AM. Mr. Vanderloo was then searched and placed in my patrol vehicle, and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail. While in transport to the Palm Beach County Jail there was an obvious strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage within my vehicle that was not present prior to placing the defendant in the vehicle.

The defendant arrived at the Palm Beach County Jail at 12:40 AM. After the defendant's 20min observation, the defendant was then given the opportunity to provide a sample of their breath which they consented to provide (On Video). The defendant's first breath was given at 01:06 AM and resulted in a .191. The defendant's second breath was given at 01:09 AM and resulted in a .173.

Inside Mr. Vanderloo's vehicle was found two clear cups that contained a yellow liquid. The liquid had a very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage. The cups were located in the front two cup holders near the driver's seat and passenger.

Mr. Vanderloo was also issued a uniform traffic citations for Open container under FL Statute: 316.613(1)(a), failure to maintain a single lane under FL Statute: 316.089, and driving without headlights under FL Statute 316.217.

Video of the traffic stop, roadsides and transport are available through the FHP custodian. The above incident did occur in Palm Beach County, Florida.
