On 10-3-2019 at 1223 hours, I responded to the intersection of NW 20th St. and NW 2nd Avenue in reference to a two-vehicle crash investigation. Upon my arrival, I met with CSO Boylston who advised that the accident investigation was complete. CSO Boylston stated that V-2 was stopped in the inside through lane on NW 20th St. facing westbound at a solid red light. As V-2 was stopped, V-1 collided with the rear of V-2, causing moderate damage to both vehicles. The driver's side and passenger side curtain air bag were deployed in the collision. CSO Boylston stated that he observed signs of impairment coming from D-1, later identified as Jenna Malhot. At this point I walked over to Ofc. J. Cohen who was speaking with Malhot. I then began speaking with Malhot who informed me that she had just left her place of work located at 2300 N. Dixie Hwy. Malhot stated that she was driving her boss, identified as Samantha Kahlenberg, to her home. As I was speaking with Malhot I saw that her pupils were pin point, she had dry/cotton mouth, she was swaying, she displayed slurred speech and she looked drowsy. I then spoke with Kahlenberg. Kahlenberg stated that she was sitting in the passenger seat of V-1 when Malhot collided with the rear of V-2. Kahlenberg said that it looked as if Malhot was looking down at her phone and not paying attention when the crash occurred. Kahlenberg said that Malhot was driving her to Home Depot, and not driving her home. I walked to my police vehicle (unit#381) and set it up in front of a solid white line in the roadway. The weather was clear and there were not obstructions on the road. Malhot walked to the front of my vehicle where I informed her that the crash investigation was complete, and I was now conducting a DUI Investigation. As I was attempting to read her Miranda rights, she kept interrupting me and saying that she "already knew them" and she "was going to be an attorney." Malhot did this several

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times before I was able to get through reading her rights in its entirety. Eventually, she stated she understood and would speak without an attorney present. Malhot immediately asked me if I was "going to take her in for 24 hours." She continued to display signs of impairment during our interaction and make irrational statements. I asked Malhot why she told me that she was driving Kahlenberg home when I was informed that they were going to Home Depot. Malhot changed her story and said that she wanted to "go home" and that is why she told me that.

Malhot again informed me that she was not paying attention and slammed into the back of a stopped vehicle at the intersection. Malhot stated that she was on "20th Ave" instead of NW 20th St.

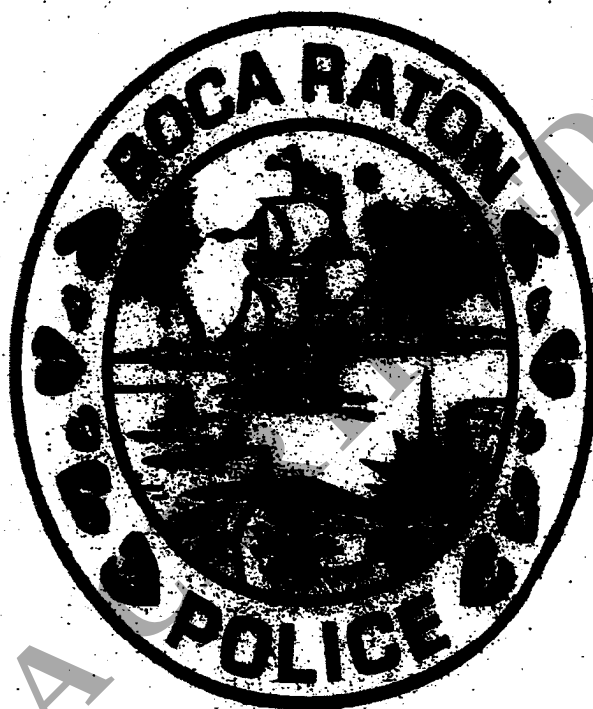
I asked her if she would consent to the standard roadside exercises to dispel my alarm, she was driving impaired. She interrupted me and said she "couldn't do the Alphabet while walking" and she can't even do "exercises sober." She also mentioned that her friends have been arrested for DUI for doing the exercises and not even being impaired. Malhot said that she did not want to attempt the tasks. I told her that if she decided to not attempt the tasks, I would be forced to make a decision based on my decisions thus far. Malhot again refused the tasks and she was subsequently placed under arrest for DUI per F.S.S. 316.193(1).

I transported Malhot to the Boca Raton Police Department for processing. Ofc. Rosenthal responded to conduct the Intoxilyzer 8000. While in the DUI room, Malhot refused to provide a breath sample. I read her implied consent and again she refused.

Malhot was later taken to the Palm Beach County Jail without incident.
