On 07/03/2019 at approximately 2315 hours, I responded to 850 SW 12th Terrace in reference to a traffic stop being conducted by Officers Galazka and Tyson. Upon arrival I spoke with Officer Tyson who advised that Officer Galazka conducted a traffic stop on a Silver 2013 Hyundai bearing FL tag 970YHJ for a stop sign violation at SW 13th St and SW 12th Ter. When officers attempted to stop the vehicle at 1100 SW 12th Ter, the vehicle accelerated and eventually stopped at the above address. See their supplements for further. I approached the vehicle on the driver's side and came into contact with W/F driver Jennifer Maser. I immediately could smell the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her person. Her eyes were red and glassy and she was stumbling over her words while speaking to me. Maser stated that she was coming from her friend's house and was driving home. Maser advised that she had not consumed any alcohol at her friend's house or any time throughout the night. It should be noted that when Officer Murphy told Maser that she was also able to smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her person, she nodded her head up and down. I then requested Maser to step out of the vehicle and she complied. Once in front of my marked unit, I requested Maser to submit to voluntary field sobriety exercises and she stated no. I then explained my observations to Maser and advised her of her Taylor Warnings. I then asked her a second time if she would be willing to submit to some road side exercises to dispel my alarm that she was driving under the influence and she stated she would. The first task was the horizontal gaze nystagmus. I explained the instructions and she stated she understood. While observing her eyes, I noticed a lack of smooth pursuit that was present in both eyes, each eye had a constant jerking while at maximum deviation, and onset prior to 45 degrees was present in both eyes.

The second task was the walk and turn. I explained the instructions, demonstrated it, and she stated she understood. It should be noted that while explaining the task to Maser, she started the exercise multiple times before being advised to begin. She was unable to maintain the starting position and used her hands to keep her balance. She didn't touch heel to toe on any step or count out loud. She didn't look down at her feet throughout the exercise and walked thirteen steps down and then ten back. She used her arms throughout the task for balance, stepped off the line, and was unsteady on her feet. The third task was the one leg stand. I explained the instructions, demonstrated it, and she stated she understood. She then began the task. She lifted up her right foot, had her knee bent, and placed it down multiple times throughout the exercise. She did not count aloud, she used her hands for balance, and she did not look at her raised foot throughout the task. I then went onto the next task. The fourth task was the Romberg alphabet. I explained the instructions and she stated she understood. She then began saying the alphabet. She said A-K and then H-I-J and so on until she completed the alphabet. The fifth task I instructed her to put her feet together and arms at her side. I explained to place her head back and eyes shut and count to 30 seconds in her head. When she shut her eyes, I would begin my timer and when she opened her eyes, I would end the timer. She counted to 30 seconds in about 25 seconds. The sixth task was the finger to nose. I explained the instructions and she stated she understood. She then began the task (R-L-R-L-L-L-R). Multiple times throughout the exercise, Maser lifted the incorrect finger, put it down, and touched her nose with the correct finger. The first and second R, she touched under her nose. She was unsteady on her feet and swaying back and forth throughout the task. Maser was then placed under arrest for DUI under FSS 316.193(1). Search incident to arrest, Officer Murphy located a clear baggie containing a white powdery substance in the right side of her bra. The powdery substance was later tested and tested positive for Cocaine by turning blue. Maser was additionally charged for possession of cocaine under FSS 893.13(6a). I then transported Maser to BRPD booking for processing. Once inside booking, Officer Deen conducted the twenty minute observation period and the Intoxilyzer 8000. I asked Maser if she would submit to a test of her breath and she stated no. I then read her implied consent and asked again if she would submit to a test of her breath and she stated no. She was issued a refusal at 0220 hours. Maser was then TOT CJ.
