PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On the aforementioned date at approximately 2114 hours, I responded to the parking lot of 6671 W Indiantown Rd. (Uncle Mick's) in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, FL as a backup unit for MPO Banegas, who had conducted a traffic stop on a black 2012 Hyundai sedan bearing FL tag # Y59JGT. At the time, I was driving an unmarked Jupiter Police Department patrol vehicle (vehicle 1916), I was wearing a JPD uniform clearly identifying myself as a Jupiter Police Officer, and I was wearing my department-issued Axon body camera.

Upon arrival, I made contact with MPO Banegas who advised the following: He was traveling westbound on S.R. 706 (E Indiantown Rd.) in the area of Palm Ave. He observed the aforementioned vehicle almost strike a light pole on the north side of the roadway and quickly jerk back into its lane, traveling westbound. MPO Banegas followed the vehicle westbound on S.R. 706 and ultimately northbound onto N Central Blvd. He stated the vehicle traveled into the painted gore area of N Central Blvd., just south of the parking lot of Uncle Mick's (6771 W Indiantown Rd.). MPO Banegas stated the vehicle turned left into the aforementioned parking lot from the painted gore area of N Central Blvd. A traffic stop was conducted and the driver, later identified to be Jennifer Veit (w/f; 03/19/1965), was identified as the registered owner. MPO Banegas stated he observed Veit had glassy eyes, she was unable to locate her driver's license, forgot to provide her insurance documents, had slurred speech, and the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on her breath. See supplement from MPO Banegas.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I approached the vehicle on the driver side, which had been parked (facing east) on the east side of the aforementioned parking lot. The driver door was open and Veit was sitting in the driver seat. I observed Veit had bloodshot/glassy eyes, slurred speech, and the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on her breath which intensified as she spoke. When Veit exited her vehicle, I observed she was unsteady on her feet.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Veit repeatedly advised she was not driving her vehicle. She stated she should not be driving and that she had been drinking, but would not advise how much she consumed. At one point during my interaction with Veit, she asked permission to turn her vehicle off. Veit's vehicle was already off. When asked to complete Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks, Veit advised she didn't want to. I advised Veit of her Taylor Warnings and again requested she perform SFSTs. After asking again, Veit agreed.

ODORS:

Odor of unknown alcoholic beverage coming from Veit's breath which intensified as she spoke.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Slurred

ATTITUDE: Arrogant, Disinterested, Easily Distracted, Carefree, Indifferent

CLOTHING: Yellow shirt, Blue jeans, Black high-heels

MEDICAL/OTHER: Veit advised she did not have any medical conditions or taking any medications. Veit allegedly forgot she had a right hip replacement until the start of the Walk and Turn Task. Veit stated, however, that the replacement did not compromise her ability to walk.

Other Observations:

I am a certified Drug Recognition Expert (IACP # 32395) and this task was conducted in accordance with my training. I observed Veit had pupils of equal approximate size, no resting nystagmus, and was able to track a moving stimulus equally. Veit was swaying throughout the duration of the task. Veit would anticipate the location of the stimulus as it moved from side to side. Veit was unable to follow instructions and had to be reminded to keep her eyes on the light, as she would frequently snap her eyes back to mine.

WALK & TURN:

Due to the fact that Veit was wearing high-heels, I requested she remove her shoes prior to beginning the task. Veit complied and had to lean on a parked vehicle to maintain her balance. Veit had extreme difficulty standing in the starting position during the Instructions Stage. Veit lost her balance several times during the Instructions Stage both to the left and to the right of the line. On the first part of the walk, Veit missed heel-to-toe on every step. Veit stepped off the line, to the right on steps 5 and 6. Veit took a total of 11 steps down the line. Veit turned improperly by taking steps with both her feet. Veit then paused, apparently finished with the task, for approximately 30 seconds before walking back down the line. On the return walk, Veit took a total of 10 steps back down the line again missing heel-to-toe on every step. Veit failed to walk heel-to-toe and walked with at an apparently normal pace.

ONE LEG STAND:

Veit advised she understood the task and was unable to lift her leg off the ground for more than a few seconds without losing her balance. After a very short period of time, Veit stood with her feet side by side for the remainder of the timed 30 second period and apparently was disinterested with finishing the remainder of the task.

FINGER TO NOSE:

Veit demonstrated knowledge of her left and right prior to administering the task. The task was fully explained to Veit and, when told to begin, she tilted her head back and closed her eyes. When I called left, Veit turned her head to the left, apparently forgetting the instructions entirely. I advised Veit that SFSTs were not a game and should be taken seriously. There was a brief back and forth between Veit and I about if she wanted to continue, as she would not provide a yes/no answer. Veit ultimately advised she wished to continue. I explained the instructions to Veit again and confirmed her understanding. On every call of the aforementioned task, Veit touched the pad of her finger to the tip of her nose and failed to return her arm to her side. On the final call of right, Veit opened her eyes, initially raised her left hand but corrected and touched the pad of her right finger to the tip of her nose.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Although Veit advised she had some type of unknown collegiate degree, she advised she unable to recite the alphabet. Veit was asked if she could count from 6 to 32 and she asked if I could do it, as if she was offended at the question. Veit was provided the instructions for this task and indicated her understanding. Veit appropriately counted from 6 to 32 and remembered to stop at 32.
