I noted that Adams was sitting in the driver seat of tan Nissan Altima (FL Tag JN025N). Dingle stated that her vehicle was rear ended by Adams vehicle on E Palmetto Park Rd just west of the Ocean Blvd. While speaking to Adams, I immediately noticed a strong odor of alcohol coming from her person. Officer Anjos (ID 820) arrived on scene and conducted the crash investigation. Once Officer Anjos completed the crash investigation, I explained to Adams that I was conducting a DUI investigation. I read Adams her Constitutional Warnings from a department issued pre-printed card. Adams advised that she understood what was read to her. Adams then stated the following: Adams stated that she went to Tap 42, located around Town Center Mall, around 1100 hours to have food and drinks with her employees. While at Tap 42, Adams stated that she had a sandwich and three mimosa drinks. Adams stated that the mimosa did consist of alcohol and that she stopped drinking them sometime between 1400 and 1500 hours. Once she was done drinking, she got into her vehicle and made a right turn onto Military Trail. Adams said that she began driving eastbound on Military Trail when she then made another right onto Dixie Hwy. After driving on Dixie Hwy, Adams stated that she turned right onto Federal Hwy to drive southbound towards her residence in Lighthouse Point, FL. Adams stated that her vehicle came to a final stop on Federal Hwy where she encountered me. After Adams provided her statement, I explained to her that I could smell an odor of alcohol coming from her person and that her statement of her driving was inconsistent

with the cardinal direction of roadway (Military Trail) that she mentioned. It should be known that Military Trail travels north and south. I asked Adams if she would perform a series of standardized field sobriety tasks to dispel my alarm that she was driving under the influence. Adams agreed to perform the tasks. I explained and demonstrated each task to Adams before she performed them. The first task was the Walk and Turn. Adams was unable to maintain the starting position while I read the instructions. Adams started the task several times prior to me completing the instructions and without being told to start. Once Adams began the task, she was unable to maintain her balance and did not touch heel to toe while performing the task. Adams did not count her steps aloud as instructed. Once I ended the task, she started the task again without being instructed to. The second task was the One Leg Stand. Adams began the task three times prior to me completing my instructions. Adams did not raise her right foot approximately six inches nor did she count aloud as instructed. Adams dropped her right foot several times and was unable to maintain her balance during the duration of the task. Once I ended the task, Adams walked to her vehicle and placed her left hand onto the front driver door and began the task again while using her vehicle for balance. I did not instruct Adams to restart the task at any time. The third task was the Finger to Nose. On the second sequence of "right", Adams initially raised her left hand before properly raising her right finger and placing it on the tip of her nose. On the third sequence of "right", Adams initially raised her left hand before properly raising her right finger and placing it on the tip of her nose. Adams performed the remaining task without any further discrepancies. The forth task was the Romberg Alphabet. Adams stated she has education level is at a Master's Degree and that she was familiar with the English alphabet. Adams performed the task without any discrepancies. At 1739 hours, I placed Jennifer Adams under arrest for DUI per 316.193(1). She was transported to Boca Raton Police Department for processing. Officer Howard (ID 826) arrived on scene and conducted a female search of Adams. Officer Lauckner (ID 801) conducted the Intoxilyzer 8000. I then asked Adams to provide a breath sample, which she consented to. His breath results were .251, .243,. I then read Adams her Constitutional Warnings. Adams agreed to answering the questions in the DUI influence report. Refer to the DUI influence report for further. Officer Anjos issued Adams a citation for following too closely per F.S.S. 316.0895. Once at the Boca Raton booking facility, Officer Lauckner located a small white pill within a contact lens holder. The pill did not have any markings on it and it was

resting in a small amount of white powder. I showed Adams a grey shoulder bag retrieved out of her vehicle and she stated it was hers. Adams stated that the contact lenses holder would be located within a small purple purse inside of the grey bag. Adams stated that she did not take any medication and that there should be no pills located within the bag. I explained to Adams that I located a single pill within the contact lenses container which she stated that it was a medication she was prescribed two years ago for anxiety. Adams could not provide the name of the medication or the prescription for the medication. The pill and powder was weighed (.2 grams) and tested positive for Oxycodone/Hydrocodone by turning yellow by using a Sirchie NARK Special Opiates Reagent test kit. Adams was additionally charged with possession of Oxycodone per F.S.S. 893.13(6A). The pill and powder was submitted into BRPD evidence.

Officer Anjos conducted a vehicle inventory before the vehicle was towed to Emerald Towing. Adams was transported to BRRH to be medically cleared and then to the Palm Beach County jail for final disposition.

Rights of suspects prior to custodial questioning.
Identify yourself and state:

I am required to warn you before you make any statement that you have the following Constitutional rights:

- (1) You have the right to remain silent and not answer any questions. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means.*
(You do not have to talk to me or answer any questions about this offense. You can be quiet if you want.)
- (2) Any statement you make must be freely and voluntarily given. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means.*
(If you do talk to me it has to be because you want to and not because anyone is forcing you to speak.)
- (3) You have a right to the presence and representation of a lawyer of your choice before you make any statement and during any questioning. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means.*
(You can talk to a lawyer before we ask you any questions and you can have him/her with you now, during our questioning.)
- (4) If you cannot afford a lawyer, you are entitled to the presence and representation of a court appointed lawyer before you make any statement and during any questioning. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means*
(If you do not have money for a lawyer and you want one, a lawyer will be given to you for free.)
- (5) If at any time during the interview you do not wish to answer any questions, you are privileged to remain silent. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means.*
(If you decide to talk to me then change your mind, you can stop answering my questions at any time.)
- (6) I can make no threats or promises to induce you to make a statement. This must be of your own free will. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means*
(I am not allowed to threaten you or make you any promises to get you to talk to me. If you decide to talk, it must be because you want to.)
- (7) Any statement can be and will be used against you in a court of law. *Tell me in your own words what you think this means*
(Anything you say to me can and will be told to the judge or a jury in court. A judge is a person who decides if you have done something wrong. Sometimes a group of people called a jury decide this, but the Judge is the person who decides what punishment you get.)
- (8) Do you understand these rights as I have read them to you, and do you wish to speak to me?
