Upon arrival on scene, I observed Perchalski in the driver seat, lumped over at the wheel with her phone in her left hand. Perchalski appeared to be sleeping with the key in the ignition and the vehicle turned on.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Perchalski appeared to be sleeping in the drivers seat. I knocked on the drivers window 3 times and then I opened the drivers side door and told Perchalski thirteen times (13) to step out of her vehicle. Perchalski seemed startled and confused. When I came into contact with Perchalski, Perchalski had glassy eyes, slurred speech, and I also detected an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage. When Perchalski exited the vehicle, Perchalski was staggering and swaying.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Perchalski stated that she had drank a couple of beers a few hours ago. Perchalski was confused on why I was there.

Other Observations:

While conducting this task, Perchalski moved her head once while conducting the RT Eye- Lack of smooth pursuit.

WALK & TURN:

I read the Walk and turn tasks. I had to explain this task numerous times. Perchalski got out of the starting position when I started the demonstration of the first nine steps forward. I had to explain the instructions to Perchalski once again. Perchalski attempted to start the task while I was explaining the instructions. While conducting this task, Perchalski stumbled once she started to take her first step. Perchalski then took 14 steps missing heel to toe on steps 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9. Perchalski incorrectly conducted the turn that was demonstrated. Perchalski also missed heel to toe on steps 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9.

ONE LEG STAND:

While conducting the instructional portion of the One Legged Stand, Perchalski got out of the starting position and did not return to the starting position. Prior to conducting this task, I had to explain the instructions multiple times. Once the task started, Perchalski did not look at her foot like instructed to do so. Perchalski's arms did not stay at her side. Once Perchalski started counting, after 6 one thousand, she started counting 7-29 regularly.

FINGER TO NOSE:

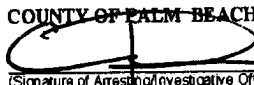
While giving instructions for the Finger to Nose task, Perchalski got out of the starting position. While conducting the task Perchalski asked me if she should put her head back. I stated yes and to close her eyes. On the first left, Perchalski brought her left index finger and touched the top of her hip. On her first right, Perchalski touched the bridge of her nose. Perchalski also anticipated my last right call by briefly lifting her left hand, when right was called.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

When told to begin, Perchalski asked if she should put her head back, and I replied with yes and for her to close her eyes. Perchalski recited the alphabet A-P and then reverted back to H and continued from H-Z.
