D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

ON THE 06 DAY OF May 2018 AT 0210 A.M P.M.

PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

On the above date and time, while traveling westbound in the 200 block of E. Woolbright Rd I observed an unknown vehicle at the time (later identified as a 2016 White Lincoln MKZ bearing Florida tag JNEA95) traveling eastbound in the 300 block of W. Woolbright Rd at a high rate of speed. Let it be noted that this incident occurred within the City of Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida. I estimated the vehicle to be traveling 75mph in a posted 40mph speed zone. Utilizing my in car stalker radar system (serial number DB007751, front antenna KC122791) I received a reading of 80mph. The Lincoln was the only vehicle traveling eastbound at the time. As the vehicle passed me traveling the opposite direction I quickly made a u-turn and pursued behind the vehicle. The vehicle continued eastbound on Woolbright, crossing over the railroad tracks at a high rate of speed. As the vehicle approached the red traffic control device at the intersection of Woolbright Rd and S. Federal Highway (S. SR 5) it slowly entered the intersection then failed to stop. The vehicle rolled through the intersection and made a left (northbound) turn onto S. SR 5. The vehicle then continued north at a high rate of speed. As I got closer behind the vehicle I observed the vehicle swerving in and out of its lane, onto the bicycle lane a couple of times. Utilizing my in car stalker radar I received a reading from the Lincoln to be traveling 60mph in a 35mph zone. As we both approached the 400 block of S. SR 5 I activated my emergency lights and sirens and initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle at Ocean Ave and SR 5.

I then made contact with the driver, sole occupant of the vehicle W/F White, Jessica (01/02/91). While checking on White's welfare and questioning her speed, White advised that she was texting a friend. White advised that she was on her way to Banana Boat to pick up a friend. While speaking with White I quickly noticed that her eyes were bloodshot/glassy and his speech was slurred. I also detected the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from White's breath and from within the vehicle. Due to White's appearance and odor I requested White to exit the vehicle, which she did. As White was exiting her vehicle I noticed that her black yoga pants were a darker black in the front and back inner thigh area. I then also noticed that the front driver's seat was wet and the odor of urine arose. Outside the vehicle, I still detected the odor of the unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from White's breath. White advised that she went to Miller's Ale House in Boynton Beach to eat and while there she consumed 2 beers. After explaining to White he driving pattern, she became argumentative and denied speeding

and failing to stop for the red traffic light. White story became to change slightly, as she first stated that she was heading to pick up a friend from Banana Boat then later stated that she was on her way home. Based on my investigation at this point I repositioned my fully marked patrol vehicle so that I continued my investigation. I then requested White to walk to the front of my patrol vehicle, which she agreed to. While walking toward the front of my patrol vehicle, White swayed side to side and was unstable on her feet. Once in front of my vehicle I advised White that the investigation was being audio and video recorded, which she stated that she understood. I questioned White if she accidental urinated herself, which she denied. Based on the above facts I requested White to Submit to a Series of Roadside Sobriety Task, which she agreed to. Prior to starting I asked White if she had any disabilities and/or injuries I should be aware of, which she stated no. See the following:

During the pen exercise, White swayed side to side and had a difficult time not moving her head. During the exercise White advised that she was currently sick and has been taking over the counter medications.

WALK AND TURN:

The exercise was explained and demonstrated to White, which she advised that she understood. During the instructional stage, White started the task too soon. White was swaying during the instructional position. During the walking stage, White took 9 steps forward in a normal walking manner, missing ever heel to toe step. On the returning 9 steps, White walked in a normal manner, missing ever heel to toe step. On her 3rd step, White lost her balance and stepped off the line towards the left.

ONE LEG STAND:

The exercise was explained and demonstrated to White, which she advised that she understood. During the instructional stage, White swayed side to side. During the exercise stage, White used her arms for balance and swayed.

FINGER TO NOSE:

The exercise was explained and demonstrated to White, which she advised that she understood. During the instructional stage, White swayed side to side. During the exercise stage, White missed the tip of her nose with her finger on every command besides the 2nd left arm command. White failed to return her arm to her side after ever command.

ROMBERG/ALPHABET:

The exercise was explained and demonstrated to White, which she advised that she understood. During the instructional stage, White swayed side to side. During the exercise stage, White recited "D,F,G,J,I,J,I". White's eyes were opened during the task.

Based on the above facts, White was placed into custody under suspicion of DUI. White was placed into handcuff (D/L and Spaced) and placed in the back seat of my patrol vehicle (#4734). I then transported White to the Boynton Beach Police Department so that I could continue my investigation. We arrived at BBPD at 0238hrs, started my 20 minutes observation at 0239hrs and completed at 0259hrs. Upon completion I requested White to provide a sample of her breath to determine the alcohol content, which she agreed to. The proper way to provide a breath sample was explained to White, which she stated that she understood. While attempting to obtain the first breath sample, White continued to cough due to his sickness. White then became uncooperative and advised that the breath sample could not be used in court due to the fact that she was sick. I advised White that if she failed to provide the breath sample overall that it would be consider a refusal. White asked what would happen if she did not provide a breath sample, at which point I read her Implied Consent. White advised that she understood. While attempting to obtain the first sample on the second attempt, White provided a sample of .205 at 0316hrs. While attempting to obtain the second breath sample, White began to cough again but was able to provide a 2nd breath sample of .181 at 0321hrs. Due to the fact both samples do not meet the .020 agreement, a second 20 minute observation period would have to be completed again. While doing so I read White her Miranda Warnings, which she stated that she understood. White completed the Q &A that is attached to this packet. While completely the second 20 minutes, White's coughing condition was not getting any better. Due to the fact that breath is being impractical due to White's coughing, I requested White to provide a sample of her blood; which she agreed to. Boynton Beach Firefighter Franiois (#258) responded to the Boynton Beach Police Holding Facility and removed two vails of blood from White's left arm, utilizing the two vail from the Florida State approved blood kit. All the proper documents were completed, to include White's signature on the withdraw consent form.

Based on the above facts I've established Probable Cause to arrest White with 1M count of DUI pursuant with F.S.S. 316.193.1. White was processed and later TOT to PBCJ.

Copy of the SFST and BAT video were later entered into the Boynton Beach Police Evidence Department. Incident was captured via BWC as well. White's vehicle was removed from scene by Blake's Towing. White was given numerous citations for her driving pattern prior to the traffic stop.



IMPLIED CONSENT FOR DUI IN A MOTOR VEHICLE

Note: Read only the paragraph applicable to the type of test you are requesting.

I am now requesting that you submit to a lawful test of your BREATH for the purpose of determining its alcohol content.

I am OFFICER CASTRO #905 of the Boynton Beach Police Department

If you fail to submit to the test I have requested of you, your privilege to operate a motor vehicle will be suspended for a period of one (1) year for a first refusal, or eighteen (18) months if your privilege has been previously suspended as a result of a refusal to submit to a lawful test of your breath, urine or blood. Additionally, if you refuse to submit to the test I have requested of you and if your driving privilege has been previously suspended for a prior refusal to submit to a lawful test of your breath, urine or blood, you will be committing a misdemeanor. Refusal to submit to the test I have requested of you is admissible into evidence in any criminal proceeding.

CONSTITUTIONAL WARNINGS

I AM REQUIRED TO WARN YOU BEFORE YOU MAKE ANY STATEMENTS THAT YOU HAVE THE FOLLOWING RIGHTS:
