I was traveling south on S. Jog Rd approaching Lake Worth Rd in the City of Greenacres, FL when I noticed a white Maserati driving north in the southbound lanes. The vehicle turned into the parking lot of the Firestone Tires 3180 S. Jog Rd where it turned around to exit the parking lot. I activated the emergency lights on my patrol vehicle and conducted a traffic stop. The vehicle was bearing Florida tag KBNK34. I approached and identified the driver as Jhenifer T. Goularte by her Florida drivers license. Jhenifer stated that she was driving too fast to make the turn at the intersection. I could smell the odor of alcoholic beverages coming from her person and asked if she had been drinking. Jhenifer claimed that she only had one drink and knew that she shouldn't be drinking because she was only 19 years old. While speaking with her I also noticed that her eyes were very glossy, but were not bloodshot. I then requested Cpl Soriano and D/S Bundrick to the location of the stop. When they arrived, I noticed that Jhenifer's eyes were now bloodshot. D/S Bundrick assumed the investigation. It should be noted that I issued Jhenifer a uniform traffic citation A8DXNEE for driving on the wrong side of a divided highway 316.081(1).

On the above date and time I was conducting a DUI Investigation which W/F Jhenifer Goularte (DOB 5/8/2000) was placed under arrest for DUI. An inventory search of Goularte's 2014 White Maserati Ghibli bearing FL Tag KBNK34 was then conducted due to the vehicle being towed. A clear bag containing a green leafy substance inside, which through my training and experience appeared to be suspect marijuana inside was located in Goularte's purse on the passenger seat. Also located inside was her wallet containing credit cards belonging to her.

CPL. Soriano (9418) conducted a field test of the suspect marijuana utilizing a Duquenois Levine Reagent test kit #5. The test kit turned purple confirming the presence of THC, the active ingredient in marijuana. The marijuana was later weighed at (4.0 grams).

Based on the above facts, I find probable cause to charge defendant Goularte with 1M count of DUI pursuant with F.S.S. 316.193.1, and 1M count of possession of marijuana under 20 grams pursuant to FSS 893.13(6)(B).

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On May 23rd 2019, at approximately 0023 hours I responded to Firestone, 3810 S JOG RD, Greenacres FL, 33467, in reference to a traffic stop on a potentially impaired driver, conducted by SGT. M. Lopez (6680). Upon arrival I made contact with SGT. Lopez who advised he observed a 2014 White Maserati Ghibli bearing FL Tag KBNK34 traveling northbound in the southbound lanes of S. Jog Rd. The vehicle then pulled into Firestone where he conducted a traffic stop. SGT. Lopez advised he made contact with the driver and sole occupant W/F Jhenifer Goularte (DOB 5/8/2000). While speaking with Goularte he detected the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage while speaking with her.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I approached the vehicle on the driver side and met with Goularte. I observed the driver was a female who was wearing blue pants and red shirt. While speaking with Goularte, I explained to Goulart why she was stopped by SGT. Lopez and asked why she was traveling in the wrong lanes of travel. Goularte advised because she was driving too fast. I detected a strong odor of an unknown Alcoholic beverage emitting from Goularte's breath. I observed Goularte's eyes appeared red and glossy. I also observed that her speech was slurred, slow, and she mumbled at times. Goulart was asked to exit the vehicle to perform field sobriety tasks which she agreed to.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

I asked Goulart if she had been drinking. Goulart advised she drank one beer earlier. I asked Goulart what medical problems and/or previous injuries she had. Goulart stated none. I asked Goulart if she wore any glasses or contacts to correct her vision. Goulart stated she dose wear glasses but was fine without them. I asked Goulart if she takes any medications? Which she advised no.

Obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage

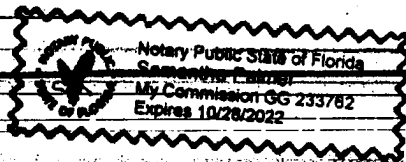

Other Observations:

BGN - Once positioned in the front of my vehicle, I continued my investigation. I instructed Goularte to keep her hands by her side, stand with her feet together, and follow a red light stimulus with her eyes not turning her head. I asked her if she understood my instructions. Goularte verbally stated she understood my instructions. I observed both eyes to be red, bloodshot, and glossy. Her left and right eye displayed equal pupil size, equal tracking, and a lack of smooth pursuit. I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus was present in both her left and right eye at maximum deviation during two separate four second evaluations. The onset of nystagmus was prior to a 45 degree angle in both her left and right eye during two separate four second evaluations. Vertical nystagmus was present in both the left and right eye during two separate four second evaluations. While conducting the task I had to remind her not turn her head and follow the stimulus multiple times.

WALK & TURN:

I positioned Goulart on a painted white parking lot line, which was on a smooth and level surface, free of any debris and well lit by the headlights on my vehicle. I instructed the Goulart to place her left foot on the line and her right foot in front of the left touching heel to toe. I instructed her that she was to keep her hands at her side and stay in this position until I instructed her to do otherwise. Once placed into the instructed position, I explained and demonstrated the rest of the task. During the instructions I observed Goulart fail to keep her arms at her side. During the task, I observed Goulart did not touch heel to toe, took the incorrect amount of steps (10), then made an incorrect turn, used arms to maintain balance (+6"), and took an incorrect number of steps back as well.

ONE LEG STAND:

I placed Goulart with her feet together and arms at her side. Once Goulart was placed into the instructed position, I explained and demonstrated the rest of the task. Once the Goulart stated she understood, the task was performed. During the task, while raising her foot she swayed while balancing, and while counting stated "17 one thousands" two times in a row and also incorrectly counted.

FINGER TO NOSE:

FINGER TO NOSE - I instructed Goularte to stand with her feet together, make each hand into a fist keeping, extended her index fingers and to place his palms facing up. She was instructed to lower her arms by her side. I instructed and demonstrated the proper hand and arm position and for her to remain in this position while I demonstrated the rest of the task. I instructed and demonstrated her to tilt her head back approximately 45 degrees and close her eyes while waiting for a verbal command of left or right. On the command of "left" or "right", she would raise the requested hand, touch the tip of her finger to the tip of her nose, then bring her hand immediately back down to her side. I asked her if she understood the instructions I provided and he verbally stated he understood. I instructed him to start the task as explained. During the task, I observed Goulart failed to return her arms to side, did not touch the tip of her nose with the tip of her finger, and began using the wrong hand once.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

ROMBERG ALPHABET - I verbally inquired if Goularte could recite the entire English alphabet. She stated she was able to recite the English alphabet and I instructed her to place their feet together with her arms at their side and stay in this position until told to do otherwise. I instructed her that upon starting she was to tilt her head back approximately 45 degrees and close their eyes. She would begin to state the alphabet in a slow and methodical manner without singing or rhyming it. I asked her if she understood the instructions and she verbally replied she understood. I instructed Goularte to start the task as explained. During the task, I observed the driver swayed from side to side, began rhyming the alphabet, and was unable to complete the alphabet, repeating some of the same letters.
