


Details of the call stated that people in a neighboring apartment were having a loud argument and were discussing possibly shooting someone. Upon my arrival, I could hear a loud active disturbance coming from apartment #3909 and could hear multiple adult males screaming at each other. I along with PFC Flesch banged on the door at which point it opened, revealing two male subjects, now identified as Jason Nunnery and Thomas Nunnery. I observed that Thomas had a bloodied lip and looked like he had swollen cheeks, as if he had been struck. Due to the mention of weapons and visible signs of a physical confrontation, we ordered both male subjects to exit the apartment and get on their knees. As I went to handcuff Thomas, Johnny Nunnery (DEFENDANT), the father of both Thomas and Jason, intervened and asked me why he was being handcuffed. I advised him to be quiet and he took two steps toward me. I ordered Johnny to exit the apartment by pointing directly at him and saying "come out here". It should be noted I was wearing a full blue Jupiter police uniform with badge. He ignored my commands and I had to order him to more times to come out. As I grabbed his left hand to put it behind his back, Johnny braced and tensed his arm and attempted to pull it away from me. PFC Flesch assisted me in handcuff Johnny.</p> <p>After all three subjects were detained, I was given conflicting stories about the disturbance that took place. Thomas advised that the argument was between Johnny and Jason, and that the injuries he sustained were from falling. Jason advised the argument was between Thomas and Johnny and stated he saw no physical contact made. Johnny advised me that the family was just "horsing around" and that no physical altercation took place. Based on my investigation, I have probable cause to believe that Johnny Nunnery did unlawfully obstruct and oppose me in the performance of my duties by disobeying direct lawful orders and by bracing/attempting to pull his arms away from me, without violence to my person, in violation of F.S.S. 843.02. 
