Probable Cause

***ROUGH ARREST REPORT (Note: A more detailed probable cause affidavit will be submitted to the SAO at a later point in time).

On 8/2/2018 I was dispatched to a possible vehicle crash in the area of the Interstate 95 southbound entrance ramp from Indiantown Road. I traveled to the Interstate 95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Indiantown Road and observed a black Mercedes passenger vehicle (FL tag: JMIAH88) parked on the right shoulder of the entrance ramp. There was damage to the front of the vehicle and the left rear tire was flat. There was a white male and a white female standing next to the black Mercedes leaning against the concrete traffic barrier of the right shoulder. I approached both individuals and asked if there were any injuries from the collision. Both stated that they were not injured. I asked the white male what had occurred and he stated that as he was negotiating the curve of the

entrance ramp when he lost control of the vehicle and struck the concrete barrier of the left shoulder. The damage to the left front and front of the vehicle was consistent with a vehicle collision of that nature. The white male had possession of the keys which were on a key ring along with a fabric lanyard. He asked if I could call roadside assistance so they could change the left rear tire. He showed me a broken tire iron that was in two pieces. I stated that I would call a road ranger to assist with the tire change. I asked the white male for his license, registration and proof of insurance. He was able to provide a Florida drivers license (FL DL: H200424894011) which was used to identify him as Jonathan Daniel Hicks. The front right passenger was identified by her Florida ID card (FL ID: K123540887880) as Melissa Kapusta. Mr. Hicks provided an up to date insurance card and registration which showed that he was the registered owner of the black Mercedes. As I spoke to Mr. Hicks I smelled the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath as he spoke. His speech was noticeably slurred and he repeatedly asked if I would sent roadside service to help seeming to forget that I had already told him I would request their assistance. I returned to my patrol vehicle and began to initiate the crash report for the incident. A search with FCIC/NCIC showed that Mr. Hick's license was valid and the registration on the vehicle was up to date. I then spoke to Mr. Hicks again and asked for his telephone number for the crash report. He seemed to become irritated and was unwilling to provide his telephone number for the crash report. I informed him that I had ended my crash investigation and that I was starting a criminal investigation for DUI based upon all my observations. I read him his Miranda Rights from my Florida Highway Miranda Rights warning card. As I was reading him his rights midway through the document Mr. Hicks appeared to be in a daze not responding to my voice and looking in the distance with a vacant stare. As I continued to read the document he interrupted me and attempted to walk off. I told him to come back and stay where I asked him to stay. As I attempted to continue reading the document Mr. Hicks stated that "it was an accident, it was an accident on my part, it's my car". As I read the document he attempted to walk off again to retrieve a shirt. Mr. Hicks was uncooperative and was unwilling to answer any of my questions. I informed him that based upon all my observations up till that point in time I asked him to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSEs). He refused multiple times when asked. I informed him that if he refused to do the exercises I would have to determine what to do based upon what I had observed. He attempted to walk away as I was explaining him this. He refused to do the exercises. Based upon the totality of the circumstances I determined that there was probable cause to believe that Jonathan Daniel Hicks committed teh offense of driving under the influence by being in actual physical control/operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or any controlled substance per Chapter 892 of the Florida State Statutes, while their normal faculties were impaired. I subsequently placed him under arrest and handcuffed him behind his back. After being searched he was placed in the backseat of my marked patrol vehicle. A road ranger was dispatched to the scene to change the tire of the vehicle. Mr. Hicks made arrangements to have a licensed driver come pick up the vehicle after the tire was changed. I placed the seatbelt on Mr. Hicks prior to driving him to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing facility. On two occassions Mr. Hicks removed his seatbelt and rested his entire body along the rear of my patrol vehicle. At some instances he appeared to fall asleep. There was a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the rear passenger compartment that was not present prior to placing Mr. Hicks in the backseat. After arriving at the BAT facility a 20 minute observation period was conducted where he did not ingest anything by mouth (nothing was inside his mouth prior to the beginning of the timed observation period). I then asked Mr. Hicks to provide a breath test sample to test for the alcoholic content of his breath. He refused to provide a breath test sample. After reading him the Florida Implied Consent drivers license suspension warning he again refused to provide a breath test sample. He was uncooperative and yelled out several expletives. The question and answer portion was not conducted


