On the 21 day of October, 2019 at 05:48 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.) On 10/20/19 I was dispatched to 6851 NE 7th Ave in reference to a delayed battery. Upon arrival, I made contact with the caller, Martin Wigderson. Wigderson advised he was at this house for the homeowner's annual employee party when a large fight broke out between multiple partygoers. Wigderson advised the fight involved two unknown subjects, later identified as W/M Jonathon Hopson and W/M Donnie Brawley, against Wigderson and his members of his family who were in attendance. Wigderson stated the party was going well for the first few hours but as time went on, everyone at the party became intoxicated and began "playfully" throwing each other into the pool. Wigderson advised his wife, Karin Larson, was tossed into the pool on multiple occasions throughout the night by another partygoer, Donnie Brawley. Larson's two sons, Cole Larson and Ryan Larson were also at the party and observed their mom, Karin, keep getting thrown in the pool by Brawley. Wigderson advised they told Brawley to stop but he continued. It was after Brawley tossed Karin in the pool for the third time when Cole Larson confronted Brawley. Wigderson stated that Brawley became upset and punched Cole in the face. Cole retaliated by pushing Brawley backwards causing a "brawl" to break out. Wigderson advised the rest of the incident was kind of a blur but at some point, Brawley and Hopson were throwing punches towards everyone striking Wigderson and Cole Larson in the face. He also stated that either Brawley or Hopson struck W/F Victoria Bessent in the face, knocking her unconscious. The "brawl" began in the backyard but continued to the side yard and then ended up in the front yard where it was eventually broken up. Another injury sustained during the fight was by W/F Kristina Papagno who advised she was "bit" on the finger by Brawley at some point during the altercation. Wigderson advised he couldn't describe every detail of the incident because "it happened so fast" but the homeowner should have video of the incident on their home surveillance. Wigderson sustained a minor laceration just below his eye. He drove Victoria Bessent, Cole Larson, and Kristina Papagno to Boca Raton Regional Hospital for their injuries.

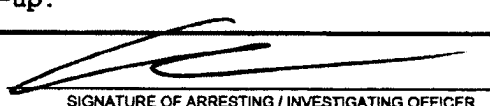

P R O B A B L E C A U S E S T A T E M E N T	I then spoke to the homeowner, Eugene Lavin, who advised he was unable to see how the fight started and who was the primary aggressor. He only observed multiple punches being thrown by all parties involved. He showed me video surveillance of the incident. The video showed Karin Larson being tossed in the pool by Donnie Brawley and Cole Larson confronting him. Both Cole and Donnie get very close to one another and both parties first begin pushing each other and then throwing punches at each other. The video suggests that both parties were mutual combatants and I was unable to determine a primary aggressor. While those two subjects are fighting, video shows Jonathon Hopson run over to the subjects until he is stopped by Victoria Bessent who is standing in his way. The video shows Bessent begin to yell at him when suddenly Hopson squares his stance, rotates his shoulders, and punches Bessent with closed fist striking the left side of her jaw, just below her lip. Due to the force of the punch, it knocked Bessent completely unconscious and her body falls to the ground. Wigderson sees the punch being throw and immediately runs over to Bessent's assistance. Video shows him grabbing Hopson by his shoulders and pushing him to the ground in an attempt to prevent Hopson from hitting Bessent again. Once he is pushed to the ground, Donnie Brawley and Cole Larson come over to Wigderson and Hopson's location and the four of them continue pushing and striking each other. All subjects end up being pushed out to the front yard where the fighting stops and Brawley and Hopson leave the area. Larson stated he was unable to download the video at that time but would be able to burn it to a DVD and give it to me tomorrow. I went to Boca Raton Regional Hospital and spoke to hospital staff who advised Bessent sustained a large laceration to her chin which would require medical glue and possibly plastic surgery. She received a CAT Scan for a possibly head injury she sustained while being knocked unconscious. I was unable to make contact with Hopson or Brawley as both subjects live in Delray Beach and wouldn't answer any phone calls. I was later able to contact Hopson over the phone who advised me that he wanted to come and speak to me in person because he was innocent. Hours passed and he never showed up. I then called Hopson back who advised he was no longer coming to the police department because I had no evidence that he was guilty. I explained to him what I observed on the video surveillance and he stated that the female struck him first and he only punched her out of self-defense. I again asked him to come and speak to me so I could get his side of the story but he advised I didn't have a warrant for his arrest and that I could talk to his lawyer if I wanted to speak to anyone. He then advised me to never call his phone number again and hung-up.
