


I responded to a call regarding a subject asleep at the wheel of a blue pickup truck at 1st. Court and Cherry Road in unincorporated West Palm Beach, Fl 33409. Upon my arrival, I saw a white male, sitting in the driver's seat of a blue truck, who was slumped over and appeared to be unconscious. I approached the driver's door, which had the window rolled down and began talking to the subject to wake him up. After several seconds of talking to him, he opened his eyes and sat upright with a disoriented expression on his face. I asked the subject if he knew where he was, and he responded that he was sleeping in his truck because he was cutting trees all day. I asked him if he was aware that he was parked in the middle of a roadway and he stated that he was in a parking space. I informed him that he was actually stopped at a stop sign in a roadway. I asked the subject to turn the vehicle off and remove the keys from the ignition which took several seconds for him to comprehend. After repeating that I would like him to turn the vehicle off and remove the keys he finally did. The subject provided me with a Florida Driver's License, by which I identified him as Joshua James Wooten. I spoke with Joseph Wright, who was riding in the vehicle with Wooten, and called 911 when he fell asleep behind the wheel, who told me that Wooten used heroin prior to driving the vehicle and that it was still located inside the truck somewhere. He advised that he injected the heroin with a needle. This case was turned over to D/S Scartozzi 21289 for further investigation.

The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe, and does believe that the above named Defendant committed the following violation of law. On the 3RD day of OCTOBER 20 17 at 2349 A.M.

I then elected to perform the modified Romberg Balance task. He was asked to stand with his heels and toes together with his arms down to his side. He was given the following instructions, When I tell you to begin I want you to close your eyes, tilt your head back and estimate the passage of thirty seconds. When you feel thirty seconds has elapsed I want you to tilt your head forward and say the phrase stop. Wootton advised he understood the instructions, I then instructed him tilt his head back, close his eyes and wait for me to instruct him to begin counting. I timed him with my watch beginning as the 40 second mark and ending at the 07 second mark for a total of 27 seconds. While his head was tilted back I noticed his eye lids would tremor slightly which could be an indicator of possible narcotic impairment. When he tilted his head forward and said stop I asked him how long he thought that was and he said 30 seconds. I advised him that it was only 27 seconds which is an indicator that his internal clock is slow and this could be due to narcotic usage. Based on the totality of the circumstance Wootton was placed under arrest for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol and or a controlled substance. He was placed in PBSO issued handcuffs which were checked for proper fit and double locked.

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 10/3/2017 at approximately 2349 hours I was dispatched to investigate a possible injured person in the area of Cherry road and 1st Court, West Palm Beach, FL, 33417 in unincorporated Palm Beach County. I was driving my marked patrol vehicle and wearing my Palm Beach County Sheriff's office issued class B uniform complete with badge, patches and gun belt. Prior to my arrival I was provided with the following information. A person by the name of Joe Wright called 911 from 772-634-2071 to report someone was passed out in a vehicle and this was possibly a heroin overdose. D/S ST Hilaire ID 15070 was the first deputy to arrive on the scene and would later provide me with the attached supplemental probable cause affidavit. D/S St Hilaire advised that when he came in contact with the driver of the vehicle he was passed out and unresponsive. He advised that his movements were very slow and lethargic. D/S St Hilaire spoke with the 911 caller who advised that the driver injected heroin and passed out and was unresponsive, that is why he contacted the Sheriff's office. I later asked the complainant if he wanted to provide a sworn witness statement about what he saw and he advised no because he was afraid the driver might retaliate and hurt him if he found out.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I then went to speak with the driver, later identified by Florida driver's license as Joshua Wootton, who was sitting on the rear tail gate of his truck speaking with Fire Rescue personnel. Immediately upon making contact with Wootton I noticed that his eyes appeared very lazy, he was having difficulty keeping them awake. His movements were very slow and lethargic, his speech was slow, thick and slurred. I asked him what was going on and he advised that he was just sleeping in his vehicle. I then asked him to walk toward the front of my patrol vehicle and he complied. As he was walking he would sway in a side to side back to front manner more than 2 inches. I chose a smooth level portion of the asphalt parking lot, free of debris and obstructions in order to perform roadside tasks. I asked him if he had any medical problems and he advised he had a bad back. I asked him if he had any physical disabilities and he advised no, I asked him if he had any problems with his eyes and he advised that he should probably be wearing glasses but was not prescribed any which did not make sense. I asked him if he had any problems with his eyes and he hesitated

and fumbled over his answer, I never got a clear answer as to what might be wrong with his eyes. I then asked him to stand with his heels and toes together with his arms down to his side. While standing here he would sway in a side to side back to front manner more than 2 inches. He had to be reminded to keep his arms to his sides. I then moved to the lighted pen task. During the horizontal gaze Nystagmus (HGN) task the driver's eyes displayed equal pupil size and equal tracking. The driver's eyes displayed lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation and distinct and sustained Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees.



Other Observations:

During the Vertical gaze Nystagmus (VGN) task the drivers eyes displayed equal pupil size and equal tracking. The driver's eyes displayed lack of smooth pursuit, distinct Nystagmus when looking all the way up. The driver's eyes also displayed onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees when looking all the way up.

WALK & TURN:

I then moved to the Walk and Turn task. He was asked to place his left foot on the ground with his right foot directly in front of it in the heel to toe position, and then place his arms at his sides and stay in this position while I demonstrated this task. He would sway roughly more than 2 inches, in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. He could not maintain his balance while listening to instructions. He was given the standardized instructions for this task after which he advised he understood. He stepped out of the stance during the demonstration to catch his balance. He started the task before being instructed to do begin. He would stop walking to steady himself with pauses to regain his balance. On the first set of heel to toe steps he missed steps one through nine and stepped off the line, using his arms for balance by raising them more than six inches. On the second set of heel to toe steps he missed steps one through nine and stepped off the line, using his arms for balance by raising them more than six inches. He performed the turn other than the way it was demonstrated. He could not perform the task. See dash camera.

ONE LEG STAND:

I then moved to the One Leg Stand task. He was asked to stand with his feet and toes together with his arms at his sides and stay in this position while I demonstrate this task. He would sway roughly more than 2 inches, in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. He could not maintain his balance while listening to instructions. He stepped out of the stance during the demonstration to catch his balance. He was given the standardized instructions for this task after which he advised he understood. He started the task before being instructed. He continued to sway while balancing on one leg. He used his arms to balance by raising them more than six inches from his sides. He put his foot down to regain his balance at numerous times before the thirty seconds had elapsed. He put his foot down three times all before counting to thirty seconds, thusly not being able to complete the task. See dash camera.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I then moved to the Finger to Nose task. He was asked to stand with his feet and toes together. He was then instructed to extend his arms outward so they would be parallel to the ground. He was then instructed to make a fist with both hands, extend his index/pointer finger on both hand, turn both hands toward the sky and then place both arms down at his sides and remain in this position while I gave the instructions. I demonstrated how to do get to this potion by the numbers. He was given the standardized instructions for this task after which he advised he understood. He would sway roughly more than 2 inches in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. His index finger did not touch his nose. The sequence used for this task was L, R, L, R, R, L. He was unable to perform the task.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

I then moved to the Romberg Alphabet task. He was asked to stand with his feet and toes together with his arms at his sides and stay in this position while I demonstrated this task. He chose to recite the alphabet. He would sway roughly more than 2 inches in a side to side, back to front pattern throughout the demonstration phase. He was given the standardized instructions for this task after which he advised he understood. He would not keep his eyes closed and had to be reminded to do so. He recited the alphabet as follows "A B C D E F G H I J K L M N O R S T U V W X Y Z" See dash camera.


