PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT	On December 5th, 2019 at approximately 2140 hours while investigating a disturbance at 10616 Forest Hill Blvd. which is located in the Village of Wellington, Palm Beach County, Florida. I was informed that the suspect related to the disturbance had left the scene in her vehicle and was going to get something from Walgreens. The male employee at the front desk informed me that a white female had been acting erratic and was showing signs of intoxication. The employee described the female as being white with blonde hair, wearing a bright pink and blue leggings. With the information provided I made my way to the closest Walgreens located at 10520 Forest Hill Blvd. and waited for any signs of the suspect. Shortly after my arrival, I observed a white Toyota Highlander bearing FL Tag LBJJ46 pull into a parking space and a white female matching the description exited the vehicle from the drivers seat appearing to almost stumble. The female was the sole occupant of the vehicle. I then observed the female subject enter the Walgreens and purchase alcohol and cigarettes. The female then exited the store without the items reentered her vehicle from the passenger side front seat and pulled out what appeared to be a debit card. During the process of getting the items from the front seat the female appeared off balance and almost fell again when she opened the door. She then went back into the store and finished her purchase. She then exited the store again and sat on the ground next to her vehicle. A female then approached her and was checking on her well being when I decided to make contact with her, who I would later identify as Kara Frazier from her FL DL. Upon making contact with the Frazier, I immediately detected an obvious and strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her person and face area. This odor intensified as I spoke to her. she had glassy, glazed, and blood shot eyes. her speech was slurred, slow, thick, and at times difficult to understand. her movements were slow, deliberate, lethargic with poor coordination. Kara Frazier showed signs of possible impairment so I requested a DUI Unit to conduct an assessment. This affidavit is for supplemental purposes only.

Other Observations:

Frazier would sway roughly in a side to side front to back pattern throughout the task. She did not touch the tip of the pen as directed to positively identify the point to be tracked. She was reminded numerous times to track the pen with her eyes only. She failed to keep her head still while tracking the stimulus.

WALK & TURN:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Walk & Turn" to Frazier who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed her to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. She could not maintain her balance while listening to instructions. She stepped out of the instructional stance during the demonstration to catch her balance. She would stop walking to steady herself. Frazier missed heel-to-toe steps. Frazier performed an improper turn. Frazier then stopped the task on her own and did not complete the second set of steps.

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "One Leg Stand" to Frazier who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed her to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. She continued to sway while balancing on one leg. She used her arms to balance raising them more than 6 inches from her sides. Frazier failed to count out loud. Frazier put her foot down to regain balance numerous times before the 30 seconds had elapsed. She put her foot down three times all before counting to 30 seconds, thusly not being able to complete the task.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Finger to Nose" task to Frazier who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed her to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Frazier's index finger did not touch the tip of the nose on 3 of 6 attempts. Frazier searched for the tip of her nose using the finger to find their nose prior to touching the tip. She used the hand other than that which was called before self-correcting. The sequence used for this task was L, R, L, R, L, R, L.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Rhombert Alphabet" task to Frazier who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed her to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Frazier would sway more than 2 inches.

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On the above date and time, I responded to the Walgreens located at 10420 Forest Hill Blvd in reference to a suspected impaired driver. Upon arrival I met with D/S Palmer #25514 who informed me of the following:

D/S Palmer was dispatched to a disturbance at the Fairfield Inn Suites. While en route to the call, he was informed that the subject involved in the disturbance was acting erratic and appeared to be intoxicated. He was told that the subject was leaving and heading to a nearby Walgreens store. D/S Palmer went to the nearest Walgreens and waited for the subject, who was described as a white female wearing bright pink and blue leggings. D/S Palmer then observed a white Toyota SUV bearing FL tag LBJJ46 pull into a parking space at the Walgreens. A white female matching the description exited the vehicle from the driver's seat appeared to stumble while exiting. The female then entered the Walgreens. She exited a short time later and entered the passenger seat of the vehicle. She appeared to be unstable and almost fell again while entering the vehicle. She then went back into the store and completed her purchase. She exited again and sat on the floor next to her vehicle. Another female approached her and appeared to be checking on her well-being when D/S Palmer conducted a consensual encounter to check on the welfare of the subject. D/S Palmer identified the female as Kara Frazier by her FL driver license. While speaking with her, D/S Palmer observed a number of articulable indicators of impairment and called for a DUI unit to respond.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Upon making contact with the driver who was identified by her Florida driver license as Kara Frazier, I immediately detected an obvious and strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her person and breath. This odor intensified as I spoke to her. She had glassy and glazed eyes. Frazier's speech was slurred and slow. Her movements were slow, deliberate, and lethargic with poor coordination. She had an unsteady gait while walking to my patrol vehicle and had extreme difficulty following directions given to her. Frazier was wearing an inside-out jacket, pink and blue leggings, and blue sandals.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Pre-Miranda: Stated that she was staying at the hotel because of an issue with her former employer. She stated that she had 2 glasses wine earlier in the night along with taking her Seraquil, (Sleeping medicine) earlier in the night.

Post-Miranda: Became belligerent and uncooperative during the interview portion. Refused to answer any questions.

ODORS:

A strong and obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage was emitting from her person and breath which intensified as I spoke to her.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Frazier's speech was slurred, slow, and at times difficult to understand.

ATTITUDE: Pleading and later argumentative, belligerent and insulting.

CLOTHING: Inside out blue jacket, blue and pink leggings and blue sandals.

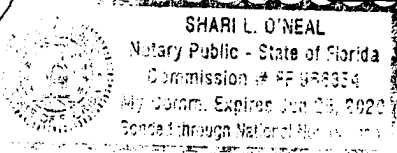
