On the above date and listed time while on acting as a back-up unit for a traffic stop in 1900 Block of 1900 Block of Lake Worth Road which is located in the city of Lake Worth, Palm Beach County, Florida I observed a white Ford four door sedan bearing Florida tag of L85-6QE traveling above the posted speed limit west bound on Lake Worth Road. Once the white car passed, failing to move over for the currently activated emergency lights, it continued to travel at a high rate of speed and was unable to maintain a single lane. The Ford sedan abruptly changed lanes to the left and up into the center. The Ford sedan over corrected itself by turning back to the right back into the far left lane.

I then elected to initiate a traffic stop on the Ford by activating the emergency lights on my marked PBSO patrol vehicle. The driver exited the car to inspect damage to the rear end of her car. The driver looked at my emergency lights, re-entered her car and then continued west bound. The Ford finally came to yield in the 3200 block of Lake Worth Road.

Upon making contact with the driver, who was identified by her Florida driver licenses as Karen Vroman, I immediately detected a strong and obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her face and person. The longer I spoke to Vroman this odor intensified. Vroman's speech was slow and slurred. Her eyes were red, bloodshot and glassy.

Vroman exited the Ford stumbling and unable to walk in a proper manner without tripping. Vroman was asked to sit on a curd located by the rear of her car at which time she fall to her behind and could not sit up without assistance of her arms.

With Vroman showing articulable signs of impairment, I requested a DUI unit to respond to conduct a DUI assessment. Investigation was turned over to Inv. J. Schaefer #8777. This ends my involvement in this case.

D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

I was called to the scene of a traffic stop in the 3200 block of Lake Worth Road, which is located in unincorporated Lake Worth, Palm Beach County, Florida. I arrived at the scene at approximately 03:35hrs. D/S Cody Jacobs #25508 relayed to me, and completed a written signed sworn supplemental Probable Cause Affidavit, that he had stopped the defendant's vehicle, a 2008 beige Ford Fusion bearing FL tag L85-6QE, because the defendant violated the "Move Over Law", failing to move over for emergency vehicles with their emergency lights activated in the 1900 block of Lake Worth Road. D/S Jacobs noticed that the defendant had articulable indicators of impairment, so he called for a DUI unit to conduct a possible DUI investigation. D/S Jacobs identified the defendant, to me, as the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle, at the time of the stop.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Upon making contact with the driver who was identified by her Florida driver license as "KAREN DENEEN VROMAN", I immediately detected an obvious and strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her person and face area. This odor intensified as I spoke to Vroman. Vroman had glassy, glazed, and blood shot eyes. Vroman's speech was slurred, slow, thick, and at times difficult to understand. Vroman's movements were slow and deliberate with poor coordination. Vroman had an unsteady gate and stumbled while walking to my patrol vehicle and had difficulty following directions given to her. Vroman was wearing a blue t-shirt, black jeans, and black shoes. All the clothing appeared dirty and disheveled.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Pre-Miranda: Vroman stated she had 2 drinks consisting of Vodka.

Vroman consented to breath and made post Miranda admissions that she was driving after having 2 drinks and was "at fault". Vroman was extremely emotional and did not want to participate in the Q&A, repeating she was at fault.



Other Observations:

Vroman would sway roughly in a side to side front to back pattern throughout the task. Vroman did not touch the tip of the pen as directed to positively identify the point to be tracked. Vroman was reminded numerous times to track the pen with her eyes only. Vroman failed to keep her head still while tracking the stimulus.

WALK & TURN:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Walk & Turn" to Vroman who stated the she understood. Vroman would sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Vroman could not maintain her balance while listening to instructions. She stepped out of the instructional stance during the demonstration to catch her balance. Vroman started the task before being instructed to do so. She would stop walking to steady herself, with pauses to regain balance. Vroman on missed heel-to-toe steps and stepped off the line. Vroman used her arms for balance by raising them more than six inches. She performed an improper turn. She turned other than which was demonstrated. Additionally, Vroman performed the incorrect number of steps on the second pass, 12 steps because she needed the extra.

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "One Leg Stand" to Vroman who stated that she understood. Vroman would sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Vroman continued to sway while balancing on one leg. Vroman used her arms to balance raising them more than 6 inches from her sides. Vroman started hopping in an attempt to maintain balance. She failed to count out loud as instructed. Vroman put foot down to regain balance numerous times before the 30 seconds had elapsed. Vroman put her foot down three times all before 30 seconds, thusly not being able to complete the task.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Finger to Nose" task to Vroman who stated that she understood. Vroman would sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Vroman did not keep her eyes closed and had to be reminded numerous times. Vroman failed to return her arms down to her sides as instructed after touching her nose. Vroman's index finger did not touch the nose on 6 of 6 attempts. On attempts L1, R1, L2 she touched the bridge, on R2 and L3 she touched under, and on R3 she touched the left nostril. The sequence used for this task was L, R, L, R, R, L.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Rhombert Alphabet" task to Vroman who stated that she understood. Vroman would sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Vroman would sway more than 2 inches. Vroman would use her arms for balance by raising them more than 6 inches. Vroman correctly recited the alphabet to "V" then skipped "W" followed by "X, Y, Z...






