On the 5 day of July, 2017 at 05:40 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 07/05/17 at approximately 0501 hours, I was dispatched to 108 Paradise Harbour Blvd apt 311 NPB, FL 33408 in reference to a disturbance. On arrival I observed an unknown w/f sitting on the ground in front of the apartment door. When I attempted to speak to the unknown w/f she attempted to walk past me in frustration. I saw damage to the window next to the door and that's when I detained the unknown w/f who was later identified as Karina A. Sasaki (w/f 07/22/96).

Sasaki began to resist detention by flailing her arms and pulling herself away from Officer G. Lew #9841 and I. Sasaki continued to pull away from officers while we tried to detain her safely in handcuffs, which were subsequently checked for tightness and double locked. I then made contact with Jessika R. Harvey (w/f 06/12/89) who told me that when Sasaki arrived at the apartment she grabbed her hair and dragged her to the floor making her knees bleed. Harvey refused medical attention even though her knees were bleeding.

Sasaki told me that she arrived to the apartment because her boyfriend (Ahmad R. Ahmad w/f 12/28/84) was cheating on her. Ahmad lives at the apartment. Sasaki was very uncooperative and continued to resist officers until she was placed inside a marked patrol vehicle. Sasaki was then transported to the North Palm Beach Police Department for processing. Harvey filled out an affidavit of prosecution and was issued a victims rights and remedies brochure. Although Sasaki damaged the window with an unknown object, Ahmad did not want to prosecute for the damages.

While inventorying Susaki's property, I found an Illinois D/L (K560-5169-4808) with the name Katherine R. Kimura (w/f 07/22/94). Also, there was a Chase Credit Card with the same name on it.

Sasaki was read her constitutional warnings from a card I keep on my person and signed the card acknowledging her rights. Sasaki agreed to talk to me and post Miranda admitted
