I continued to flicker my high beams head light to get the driver's attention. The vehicle finally pulled into the old I Hop restaurant located at 2300 45th Street, West Palm Beach Florida 33407. The driver W/F exited from the driver's seat and began to approach my vehicle. I could immediately detect an unknown odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her person. The W/F was the sole occupant of the the vehicle. I told the female to return to her vehicle and have a seat. I used my PBSO radio and advised PBSO dispatch that I was involve in a hit and run accident and the vehicle was now stopped at 45th Street, east of I95. PBSO dispatch advised me that the same vehicle was reported earlier as a vehicle driving recklessly. Moments later Deputies arrived on scene and conducted a DUI investigation.

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 6/9/19 I responded to 2300 45th St, in Palm Beach County, in reference to a hit and run crash with a possibly impaired driver. Upon arrival I met with Agent Nandlal ID 8483, who was involved in the crash.

Agent Nandlal advised that he was driving east bound on Southern Blvd. As he was turning onto the north bound on ramp to I95, in the number 1 lane, a Nissan car bearing Florida tag INGV21 side swipes, same direction, his front passenger fender and then proceeded to drive north bound on I95. The vehicle failed to maintain a single lane and kept on crossing of the center dividing lanes as it continued to travel north bound on Interstate 95. Agent Nandlal attempted to gain the driver's attention by utilizing my high beam lights with negative result. The vehicle exited at 45th Street and proceeded to travel east bound on 45th Street. Agent Nandlal continued to flicker his high beam head lights to get the driver's attention. The vehicle finally pulled into the old I Hop restaurant located at 2300 45th Street, West Palm Beach Florida 33407. The driver, Katie Dorcas, the sole occupant of the vehicle, exited from the driver's seat and began to approach his vehicle. Agent Nandlal immediately detected an unknown odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her person.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I made contact with Dorcas, who was sitting in the driver seat of her car. I had Dorcas exit her car and stand in front of my patrol car. I advised Dorcas that the crash investigation was complete and I was going to conduct a criminal DUI investigation, which she advised she understood. I advised Dorcas of Miranda warnings, which she advised she understood. I observed Dorcas's eyes to be glassy and there was an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath, which got stronger when she spoke. While standing still, Dorcas exhibited a slight orbital sway. Post Miranda Dorcas advised that while she was turning onto I95 she struck the truck. Dorcas advised she was not injured and did not need any medical attention. Dorcas did not strike her head or lose consciousness at any time. Dorcas advised that she did take Lexapro for anxiety and depression. Dorcas denied drinking anything that night and advised she did drink at approximately 2:00pm and had not drank since. Based on my observations I asked Dorcas to perform standard field sobriety tasks.

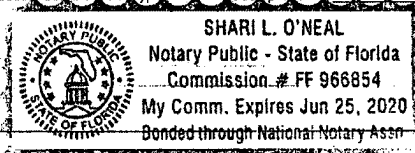

Other Observations:

Dorcas was asked to stand with her feet together and place her hands by her sides. Dorcas was asked to focus on the stimulus and follow it with her eyes. Dorcas was told not to move her head to assist in following the stimulus. Dorcas showed equal pupil size that tracked equally. Both eyes lacked a smooth pursuit. I saw distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation and onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. I observed vertical nystagmus in both of Dorcas's eyes. Dorcas swayed while performing this task and had to be reminded not to move her head.

WALK & TURN:

I performed the walk and turn task. I utilized yellow duct tape to make a straight level line, free of debris, that Dorcas advised she could see. Dorcas also confirmed the line was straight and level. I explained and demonstrated the task to Dorcas. During the instructions Dorcas was unable to maintain the instructional position and stepped out of the position, several times. After completing the instructions Dorcas advised she understood and had no questions. During the task Dorcas did not walk heel-to-toe. Dorcas walked slowly, pausing on each step to steady herself and used her arms for balance. Dorcas did not turn as instructed.

ONE LEG STAND:

I performed the one leg stand task. I explained and demonstrated the task to Dorcas. After completing the instructions Dorcas advised she understood and had no questions. During the task Dorcas exhibited a side to side sway.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I performed the finger to nose task. I explained and demonstrated the task to Dorcas. After completing the instructions Dorcas advised she understood and had no questions. During the task Dorcas missed touching the tip of her nose once. Dorcas used the pad of her finger to touch the tip of her nose several times. On the third right command Dorcas flinched her left hand first. Throughout the task Dorcas exhibited a sway.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

I performed the Romberg alphabet task. I explained and demonstrated the task to Dorcas. After completing the instructions Dorcas advised he understood and had no questions. During the task Dorcas swayed, more than 2 inches.

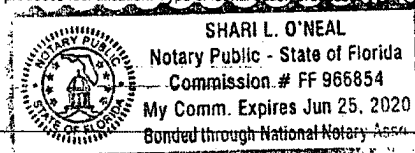
