PROBABLE CAUSE

On Wednesday 07/26/2017 at 11:18 PM, Trooper Petti was running laser on the left shoulder on Interstate 95 southbound just north of Woolbright Road, when Trooper Petti observed a silver mini cooper with a FL license plate of IJ237, in the inside center lane. She visually estimated the speed of the vehicle at approximately 80 mph. At that point Trooper Petti activated her state issued laser and pointed it at the vehicle and got a speed reading of 83 mph. Trooper Petti initiated the lights and sirens and conducted the traffic stop on the right shoulder. The driver identified herself by her FL DL. When Trooper Petti asked the driver, identified as Kerri E. Simson, date of birth of 04/18/1975, where she was coming from tonight she told her from a bar and that she just was listening to a good song and just got into a fight with her boyfriend. Trooper Petti identified an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle, at this point Trooper Petti asked her how many drinks she had tonight, she replied none. Trooper Petti then went to her patrol car to run her license and registration. I introduced myself and she began to be very apologetic. I then again asked her if she had consumed any alcoholic beverage tonight and she replied no. I advised her that I could smell an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle and as she spoke, from her breath. Her eyes were blood shot and glossy and slurred speech was present. After I made her aware that I could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage, she then admitted to having one glass of vodka on ice. I then asked her to exit her vehicle to perform roadside exercises. Defendant agreed to roadside exercises. Trooper Petti asked the defendant if she wore glasses or contact lenses, she replied no. FSTs were preformed on the right shoulder as followed:

HGN: Trooper Petti first checked for equal pupil size and equal tracking. Trooper Petti observed the defendant to have equal pupil size and equal tracking. The defendant showed lack of smooth pursuit, onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degree and distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes. I confirmed what Trooper Petti had seen. The defendant had to be reminded not move her head only her eyes. The defendant swayed to maintain balance.

I informed her that she could take off her heals to perform the next two exercises, where she wished to do.

Walk and Turn: This exercise was demonstrated to the defendant by Trooper Petti. The defendant during the exercise used her arms to balance along with pivoted her feet when walking. The defendant made an improper turn and began to pivot her feet on the second set of steps. I asked defendant if she understood Trooper Petti's instructions and she said yes, at that point I re-demonstrated the exercise and instructions in which she understood. She once again used her arms for balance and pivoted her feet when walking and did not look down at her feet when walking. The defendant made a statement that the ground was not level enough. I offered her to relocate the roadside exercise just south of our location, which she agreed. I made her aware she was not being arrested, but that I would conduct a pat down for weapons. I asked her if she understood that she was not under arrest and she stated yes. I placed her in Trooper Petti's patrol car to relocate her to another location that was level on the right shoulder about two hundred feet south of where the first set of exercises were performed. Trooper Parent stayed with the defendant's vehicle while we relocated. Trooper Petti re-instructed the instructions and demonstrated the exercise. The defendant once again used her arms for balance and still pivoted her feet when walking and stepped off the line. (The offense report will give further details when the video is reviewed).

One Leg Stand: This exercise was demonstrated to the defendant. I asked her if she had any questions and she stated she did not. The defendant swayed while standing. The defendant used her arms for balance along with putting her foot down several times to maintain balance. (The offense report will give further details when video is reviewed).

The defendant was placed under arrest at 11:37 PM for the violation of the Florida Statute 316.193(1) and was transported to the county jail for booking. On the way to the jail, the defendant had several mood swings varying from being upset, to apologetic, to cursing at myself and Trooper Petti. She kept insisting that we take her back to her vehicle or just call her a ride. She told us that she was going to sue us and that she hopes karma catches up to us. During our time in the jail, myself and Trooper Petti preformed a twenty minute observation time on the defendant. During this time the defendant did not regurgitate or place anything in her mouth. I began to ask her to state basic answers to the questions I was giving about herself, she began to curse at me after every question. During the time at the jail, when asked to submit to a breath test, the defendant stated that she was not going to. I then read her implied consent where she interrupted me and agreed to submit. The defendant failed to keep a steady breath and got aggravated and then decided she was not going to comply anymore. I again read the implied consent, which she understood. She still refused to submit to the breath test. I read her constitutional rights, which she understood. She then refused to answer questions.

The vehicle was towed by Priority Towing.
