On the **6** day of **July**, **2018** at **00:40** (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 07/05/2018 at approximately 2228 hours, I responded to the area of 5444 Parkside Dr. in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, FL, in reference to a single motor vehicle crash. At the time, I was driving a fully-marked Jupiter Police Department patrol vehicle (vehicle 1413), I was wearing a JPD uniform clearly identifying myself as a Jupiter Police Officer, and I was wearing my department-issued Axon body camera.


Prior to my arrival, NorthCom advised the vehicle occupant had walked away from the crash. NorthCom advised the male was walking northbound and possibly wearing dark clothing. Officer Turner made contact with a white male, later identified to be Kyle Murphy (w/m; 10/08/1996), approximately 200 yards north of the crash scene who matched the description provided (see supplement from Officer Turner).


Upon arrival, I observed Officer Turner standing on the west side of Parkside Dr., with Murphy sitting on the curb on the west side of the road. I observed Murphy was wearing a black shirt and dark blue jeans, matching the description given by dispatch. Murphy also appeared to be the only pedestrian in the immediate vicinity of the crash, with the exception of the caller. I observed a white 2006 Lincoln Town Car bearing FL tag # 989QKG with heavy front-end damage, facing south, with the front driver airbag deployed, and the front passenger tire detached from the vehicle. The Lincoln was stopped with the front end of the vehicle on the west side curb, and the rear of the vehicle partially obstructing the southbound lane of travel on Parkside Dr. I observed the airbag dust in the vehicle was still settling inside the vehicle. I also observed the keys to the vehicle were still in the ignition but there were no occupants inside.

I made contact with the caller, Mitchell McLaren (w/m; 12/23/1961), who advised he drove up on the Lincoln but there were no occupants in the vehicle when he arrived. McLaren advised he observed a male wearing dark clothing walking northbound on the sidewalk, on the west side of Parkside Dr., talking on the phone but could not see the male's face

<p>and would not be able to identify him. McLaren advised the male walking away from the crash was approximately 6 trees north of the location of the crash (towards the location of Murphy and Officer Turner). It should be noted that the trees are spaced approximately 10 yards from each other.</p> <p>Officers on scene ran the tag number for the aforementioned vehicle and determined that it was registered to Kyle Murphy (the male Officer Turner was out with). I took pictures of the damaged vehicle and drove to Officer Turner's location. I also took pictures of two trees (located on the west side of the road) that were damaged in the crash.</p> <p>When I arrived, Murphy was already in the rear of the ambulance and paramedics were readying him for transport to the hospital (PBCFR Run # 18-071496). I followed the ambulance with Officer Turner and made contact with Murphy in Jupiter Medical Center Exam Room # 2.</p> <p>I observed Murphy had extremely bloodshot, glassy eyes. Murphy had very slurred speech and the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage, which intensified as he spoke. I observed Murphy had burn marks from the driver side airbag on both his forearms and his forehead. I also observed an angular red mark on Murphy's left shoulder (witness mark from driver seatbelt) which was consistent with how the seat belt of a vehicle lays over the driver's shoulder.</p> <p>I advised Murphy the crash investigation was over and I was beginning a criminal DUI investigation. I read Murphy his Miranda Warnings and confirmed he understood each one. I conducted a post-Miranda interview with Murphy in which he admitted to driving his vehicle, being involved in a crash, and stated this would have never happened if he was not drunk. Murphy further advised that he had consumed 4 cocktails at Stadium Grill (local bar/restaurant in Abacoa) prior to driving his vehicle. Murphy attempted to advise which route he normally takes home, stating he takes Donald Ross Rd. (which was consistent with the direction the vehicle was facing and street the vehicle was on at the scene of the crash). I took pictures of Murphy's injuries which were later submitted to JPD Evidence.</p> <p>I advised medical staff to contact me with an approximate length of stay for Murphy shortly after my arrival at the hospital around 2306 hours. When the doctor arrived in the room at approximately 0045 hours for his initial examination, I was advised by Dr. Allison that Murphy's length of stay at the hospital was going to be more than a few hours, rendering a breath test impossible or impractical to perform.</p> <p>At this point, due to the fact that Murphy was the registered owner of the crashed vehicle, the fact that Murphy was within the immediate vicinity of his crashed vehicle immediately after the crash, the fact that Murphy was the only pedestrian in the immediate area of the crash (other than the caller), the burn marks from the driver</p>

P R O B A B L E C A U S E S T A T E M E N T	<p>airbag on both Murphy's forearms and forehead, the witness marks of the driver side seat belt from the vehicle, and Murphy's admission post-Miranda that he was drunk and driving his vehicle, I advised Murphy that he was under arrest for DUI - Damage to Property and Leaving the Scene of a Crash involving Property Damage. I placed a handcuff on Murphy's left wrist and secured it to the hospital bed. I requested Murphy provide a lawful sample of his blood for the purpose of determining the alcohol content and/or the presence of chemical or controlled substances. Murphy consented immediately.</p> <p>I notified medical staff that a blood draw needed to be conducted and Murphy's blood was drawn at 0051 and 0052 hours by Joe Robinson (JMC ER tech). I immediately took custody of the vials, sealed both vials, placed them in the provided plastic container, and sealed the plastic container with the provided blue evidence tape. The sealed, completed blood kit was ultimately placed into JPD Evidence and a PBSO Laboratory Request was completed to determine the presence of alcohol and/or chemical or controlled substances.</p> <p>After being handcuffed, Murphy began having mood swings, going from being completely compliant and polite to crying and irate. Murphy began using profanity and raising his voice louder and louder. Murphy was advised by JMC staff to keep his voice down and to stop using profanity, as there were children and other sick patients in the emergency room that he was disturbing. Murphy continued swearing and being verbally aggressive and JMC staff advised that his actions were bothering them and the other patients in the hospital. Murphy removed the IV from his right hand and began bleeding on himself and all over his hospital gown and bed. Hospital staff was immediately notified, Murphy was attended to, and a new IV was started in Murphy's arm. Murphy eventually began screaming in his room, stating that I never read him his Miranda Warnings and demanding that I re-read his Miranda Warnings.</p> <p>Due to Murphy's behavior, he was administered 10 milliliters of Haldol and he fell asleep shortly after. Due to Murphy's disruptiveness, hospital staff was forced to move him from Exam Room 2 and relocated him to Exam Room 11.</p> <p>Due to the above stated facts, I believe Probable Cause exists to charge Kyle Murphy with DUI - Damage to Property because he did drive a vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic beverages, or chemical substances as set forth in Florida Statute 877.111, or any substance controlled under Chapter 893 or any combination thereof, to the extent that his normal faculties were impaired, and, during the course of operating a vehicle, and by reason of such operation, did cause or contribute to causing damage to the person or property of the Town of Jupiter, contrary to Florida Statute 316.193(3)(c)(1).</p> <p>I believe Probable Cause exists to charge Kyle Murphy with Leaving the Scene of a Crash involving Property Damage because he did drive a vehicle involved in a crash resulting only in damage to other property, and did fail to immediately stop such vehicle at the scene of such crash or as close thereto as possible and forthwith return to the scene</p>
