On the **22** day of **February**, **2019** at **11:57** (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 12/06/2018 I responded to the lobby of the Police Department in reference to a theft. Upon arrival I made contact with the victim Sara Jones. Jones advised that she has been visiting family in Maryland intermittently since approximately the beginning of July (unsure when the first trip was). Jones stated that when she returned home from her last trip at the end of October, she noticed that items were missing from her residence. She advised that the initial item that she noticed that was missing was change from a large bottle that was kept in her living room. Jones advised that the bottle was about half full of quarters, nickels, and dimes and was now completely empty. Jones estimated that there was a few hundred dollars in coins in the bottle.

Jones stated when she began checking she noticed that her gold and silver jewelry was missing along with "rolled coins" which were kept in a plastic box under her bed, (3) 100 dollar bills that were hidden underneath her sewing machine, a green Taurus PT22 firearm (serial #Z053644) which was in a cabinet in the living room, JVC movie camera and a Panasonic underwater camera which were in her closet.

When asked if anyone else had access to her property Jones replied that her neighbor's daughter, Lara Jackson, had the key to her residence. Jones advised that Jackson would stay at her residence while she was away to make it look like someone was home. I later ran Jackson's name through R.A.P.I.D Pawn system and it revealed multiple hits on 06/26/2018, 06/28/2018, 07/10/2018, 07/24/2018, 09/27/2018, and 10/03/2018. All the items that were pawned by Jackson were jewelry. Jackson utilized two separate pawn stores for her transactions which are Delray Pawn Buy/Sell located at 2409 N Federal Hwy Delray Beach, and G&C Pawn Buy/Sell located at 109 E Boynton Beach Blvd Boynton Beach.

I contacted Delray Pawn Buy/Sell to see if they still had any items that had been pawned by Jackson. I was advised by an employee that they still had two pendants in the store. I provided them with a pawn hold form for those two items. I also contacted G&C Pawn

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SUPPLEMENT

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Buy/Sell via telephone and was advised that they no longer had any of the items which were pawned by Jackson.

On 12/10/2018 I made contact with Jones at Delray Pawn Buy/Sell to see if she would be able identify the items pawned by Jackson. Jones was able to positively identify the car pendant (pawn slip 201801688) and a sailfish pendant (pawn slip 201801724) as her late husband's jewelry. On pawn slip 20181688 it should be noted that the car pendant was pawned along with a rope chain, and on pawn slip 20181724 the sailfish pendant was sold to the pawn shop along with an anchor pendant and a men's ring. Jones paid \$45 for the car pendant and \$22 for the sailfish pendant to be returned to her.

On 01/27/2019 I was contacted by Jones who advised that she had received a letter from Jackson along with a vase she had given to Jackson as a gift previously. Jones advised that in the letter Jackson stated that she was sorry and "no matter what happens, I hope that you can still love my mom as a sister and kids like a part of your family. And if there is any way I can repay you for your heart ache, I would like to try no matter what". It continues to state that she doesn't want her family to have to suffer for her actions.

Based on the above stated facts Probable Cause exists to charge Lara Jackson with one count of grand theft pursuant to F.S.S 812.014(2C1), two counts of dealing in stolen property pursuant to F.S.S 812.019(1), and two counts of false verification of ownership 538.04(4)(B).
