PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT	<p>Florida State Statutes define child abuse as :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Intentional infliction of physical or mental injury upon a child; 2. An intentional act that could reasonably be expected to result in physical or mental injury to a child; <p>Above date at 1456 hrs dispatch received a call about a toddler left inside of a parked vehicle in the parking lot of El Bodegon grocery store, 4704 Forest Hill Blvd. I was in the area and responded to the parking while driving my marked patrol car. I was flagged down by a group of females who pointed to a tan color mini van with FL tag DCKX98. The two front windows on the van were down a few inches. The engine was not running. I saw a small girl inside of the van standing up and crying. Her hair was wet from sweating, her face and forehead were wet with sweat, and the back of her shirt was also wet. Her skin was bright red in color. I found all doors on the van unlocked, and opened the door. The child immediately came to me with out stretched arms looking to be picked up. I could feel the air inside the van was much warmer than the ambient air temperature. I felt the child's skin and she was very warm to the touch. EMS was directed to respond to the scene. An employee walked up to me and asked if he could help. I asked him to go inside and look for [REDACTED]. EMS arrived and looked over the child. At this point all doors on the van were opened and had been opened for around 10 minutes. EMS used a infra-red thermometer to check the interior temp of the van and found the plastic dash board showed a temp of 110 degrees Fahrenheit, while the air temperature inside was still at 90 degrees Fahrenheit. We were unable to determine the temperature of the child due to the EMS patient thermometer not operating, but she was given water and once outside in the cooler air, she returned to her normal color and appeared fine.</p> <p>[REDACTED] was found inside the store and identified as Leonila Soto Gonzalez by her alien work permit card, and an ID card listed in DAVID. She was asked by a spanish interpreter, D/S Palacio, what happened. She stated her 9 year old son wanted some candy, so she came to the store to purchase some for him. He accompanied her inside the store. She decided to leave the girl in the van because she was sleeping and did not "want to wake her". She claimed she had been inside the store "for a few minutes." Surveillance cameras from the grocery store showed [REDACTED] entered the store 1443 hrs. She did not walk out until 1505 hrs, when she was directed to come outside by law enforcement. The child was left alone in the hot, unlocked van for a minimum of 22 minutes. [REDACTED] verbally identified the child as [REDACTED] DOB 2/5/2014. The Bodegon parking lot was completely full with all parking spots taken and multiple individuals walking in and out of the building.</p> <p>At the time of completing this probable cause, the Palm Beach Post web site shows the temperature for West Palm Beach at 81 degrees Fahrenheit. Any reasonable [REDACTED] should know leaving a two year old child inside of an unlocked vehicle, in a busy parking lot of a grocery store, with the outside temperature at 81 degrees, could reasonable be expected to result in physical or mental injury to the child. Probable cause therefore exists for the arrest of Leonila Soto Gonzalez for violation of FSS 827.03.2c, child abuse.</p> <p>An in custody arrest was not made at the time due to Leonila advising the father [REDACTED] is deceased and she claimed there was no one else who would be able to watch [REDACTED] if she was taken in to custody. Case will be turned over to the SAO for disposition.</p>
