	<p>On 09/07/2019 0020 hour, I responded to 3300 Block S Military Trail, Unincorporated West Palm Beach, Florida 33463 in reference to a backup on a car crash (Ref 19-112275).</p> <p>Deputies on scene advised there was a crowd forming and needed more deputies for crowd control, as the crowd was about to engage in a fight with one another. Upon arrival, I assisted with blocking the southbound lanes of S Military Trail from 10th Ave N.</p> <p>There were about 25-35 people in the crowd running across S Military Trail, disrupting the flow of traffic and yelling at each other. I began to tell the crowd to leave the area if they were not involved in the vehicle crash.</p> <p>I then approached a crowd, later identified as half of the party involved (Mitzl M Buffaloe and her family), and told them specifically "if they were not part of the car crash they had to get out of the road and wait by their cars." To which a white female wearing a burgundy shirt and blue shorts standing next to the road holding a small child, later identified as Lexi Briana Buffaloe (W/F, 01/13/1998), told me: "My sister was in the crash. I'm not moving anywhere."</p> <p>I proceeded to explain that she needed to get out of the scene, as she was causing a disturbance and impeding the flow of traffic and the deputies' investigation. L. Buffaloe advised that she was not leaving and that I had to make her leave.</p> <p>L. Buffaloe then began to yell at me with an enraged expression and say, " That's all the badge talking. Watch, I'll catch you outside of uniform and we'll see."</p> <p>I asked L. Buffaloe if that was a threat to me as a person. L. Buffaloe began yelling obscenities and acting belligerent, enraging other family members on scene.</p> <p>L. Buffaloe then began walking away with the baby, as she kept yelling about fighting me when I was not working and wearing a uniform. I advised L. Buffaloe to come back and she refused and kept walking away. It should be noted that L. Buffaloe refused to follow my lawful commands while wearing PBSO issued uniform.</p> <p>Based on the facts and circumstances provided to me at this time, I determined that Lexi B Buffaloe did commit the act(s) of Corruption by threat against public servant; by unlawfully threatening harm to any public servant (D/S J Falcon) or to any other person with whose welfare the public servant; contrary to F.S.S 838.021(3)(b).</p>
