Federal Hwy and E. Glades Rd. in reference to a two vehicle accident. As I was responding to the call, BRPD Dispatch advised that a W/F, later identified as Lisa Clarke, was passed out in the roadway and a witness was performing CPR on her.</p> <p>Prior to my arrival, BRFD was already on scene and was treating Clarke for possible injuries (BRFD Run#18-7503). A short time later, BRFD transported Clarke to Boca Regional Hospital for a further medical evaluation.</p> <p>Upon my arrival, I spoke with the witness to the accident. Veronica Silver. Silver advised that she was stopped with a solid redlight facing northbound at the intersection of N. Federal Hwy and E. Glades Rd. to turn westbound. Silver stated she was in the inside turn lane. Silver advised that as she was stopped as the traffic signal, she observed a Silver Volvo bearing Fl Tag#840QRC (V1) collide with the rear of a Black Honda vehicle bearing Fl Tag#Y21EAP (V2) as it was stopped at the same intersection but in the outside turn lane. Silver advised that after observing the accident, she exited her car and saw that the driver of V1, Clarke, appeared to be unconscious. Concerned for Clarke's welfare, Clarke began performing CPR on her. BRFD arrived on scene a short time later and provided Clarke with medical attention. Silver completed a written statement detailing the above mentioned incident. Silver was able to identify Clarke while on scene.</p> <p>I then spoke with the occupants of V2. D2 Carolina Padilla Calhoun and P1 Mercy Aleman Romero. Both occupants advised that they were stopped at the intersection of N. Federal Hwy and E. Glades Rd. with a solid redlight. They advised that as they were stopped, they were collided from behind by V1, causing severe damage to their vehicle. Both occupants of V2 were transported to Boca ER for possible injuries.</p>

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Both vehicles had a severe amount of damage and were towed from the scene.

After completing my accident investigation on scene, I responded to the Boca Regional Hospital to make contact with Clarke. Clarke was being medically treated by Boca ER staff. I began questioning Clarke about the accident. Clarke advised she was with a friend and driving on N. Federal Hwy to take him to a "shop" somewhere in Boca Raton, Fl. She advised that as she was driving, she looked up and collided with the rear of another vehicle. Clarke stated that she was coming from a bar in Delray Beach and had consumed 4 glasses of wine. She stated that she also takes Tramadol for pain. It should be noted that Tramadol is not supposed to be ingested while consuming alcohol. As I was speaking with Clarke I detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from her person and red/glossy eyes. Clarke continued to "twitch" during our interaction and advised that she was in a severe amount of pain.

Based on my observations, I informed Clarke that I was now done with my accident investigation and conducting a DUI investigation. I read Clarke her constitutional rights, she stated she understood and would speak to me. Clarke again stated she consumed four glasses of wine tonight while out with a friend. She advised she was driving her passenger to an unknown location in Boca Raton and seemed very confused about what happened with the accident. Clarke remembers being on the roadway and someone performing CPR, even though she never lost consciousness.

I then asked Clarke if she would consent to the standard field sobriety tasks to dispel my alarm that she was driving impaired. Clarke provided consent but was in a severe amount of pain and advised she would not be able to leave her hospital bed.

The first task was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. While observing HGN, lack of smooth pursuit was present in both eyes. Each eye had a constant jerking while at maximum deviation. Onset prior to 45 degrees was present in both eyes.

The second task was the Rhomberg Alphabet. She did not follow instructions and recited the alphabet in a quick manner instead of in a slow non-rhythmic manner. We attempted the exercise again, she recited the alphabet correctly but said it at a fast pace and kept her eyes open during the task.

The third task was the Rhomberg Number Sequence (30-60). She counted the numbers correctly but had her eyes open throughout the task.

At 2130 hours, I placed Clarke under arrest for Driving under the Influence 316.193(1). Due to the extended amount of time spent at the hospital, and the fact that I was still waiting on the results of her medical evaluation, asking Clarke to provide a breath sample became impracticable. Therefore, in the presence of Ofc. Fong, I requested that Clarke that he provide a legal sample of her blood to determine its alcohol content.

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Clarke said it was going to have alcohol but provided consent.

Boca Raton Regional Hospital Nurse Jean Alcimeus responded and legally withdrew blood from Clarke at 2150 hours. The blood was withdrawn from the left arm. After the blood was withdrawn, the viles were inverted several times. All of the necessary paperwork was completed and the blood was collected. The blood kit was later placed in the evidence refrigerator at the police department. A PBSO Laboratory Analysis Request was sent to the lab for the blood to determine its' alcohol content.

Clarke was later taken to the Boca Raton Police Dept. for processing and later taken to the Palm Beach County Jail without incident.
