On 10/16/17 I was dispatched to the area of 3307 S. Jog Rd in reference to a female lying on the sidewalk. This incident was called in by a concerned citizen driving along Jog Road. Greenacres EMS was also dispatched to the scene for any possible medical needs. Upon arrival with EMS, we made contact with W/F Lisa Bucker (4/12/70) lying on the sidewalk. Brucker was wearing a blue jump suit and had a blue bicycle lying in the grass beside her.

As Greenacres EMS began to lift Brucker from the sidewalk, I approached and immediately detected the odor of marijuana. I recognized this odor based on my experience being an officer for over eleven years, two of which were on the Greenacres Street Crimes Team. Brucker appeared to be highly intoxicated and had difficulty communicating with EMS. I was advised by EMS that she appeared to be intoxicated based on her pin point pupils and inability to stand without assistance. Brucker was also unable to identify herself or be able to tell us where to locate her ID. At that time, I was advised by Greenacres EMS that she would need to be transported to the hospital. I advised EMS that I had detected the marijuana odor, which became stronger when standing next to the light blue backpack Brucker was holding. The other two bags were still on the ground where she was found, not the ambulance which was at the entrance to Kingswood Academy. As not to allow any controlled substances or weapons on to the ambulance, I opened the top of the unsecured blue backpack and immediately observed several plastic packages containing marijuana.

Upon further investigation, a voter registration form was found on the top of one of the other bags in Bucker's possession. This orange bag contained a letter from voter's registration addressed to Lisa Brucker. Brucker eventually acknowledged this is who she is. I also confirmed this through her DAVID photograph. Prior to being transported, D/S Francis checked the water bottle Brucker had next to her bicycle which he advised me had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage.

While at Wellington Hospital, I attempted to determine if Brucker was lucid enough to be read her Miranda Warnings. After asking her name and birthday, I asked for her address. After asking three times, I was only receiving a response of her birth date. Other general questions were answered with nonsensical growling.

During this time, I requested D/S Francis respond and recover the marijuana to be weighed while I completed the arrest paperwork. The plastic bags located inside of the blue backpack were as follows in no particular order:

- Bag 1: Contained 5 smaller plastic bags containing marijuana. One of the bags had a post it note with "Pina Orange Cush" written on it.
- Bag 2: Contained 5 smaller plastic bags containing marijuana. One of the bags had a post it note with "Blue Cheese" written on it.

Bag 3: Contained 6 smaller plastic bags containing marijuana. One of the bags had a post it note with "Best Purple Haze" written on it.

Bag 4: Contained 5 rolled marijuana joints. 3 smaller plastic bags containing marijuana. One of the bags had a post it note with "Pakistan Star Diesel" written on it. An additional small plastic bag with four smaller bags inside containing marijuana.

Bag 5: Contained 5 smaller plastic bags containing marijuana. One of the bags had a post it note with "South African Kwazulu" written on it.

Additionally, a glass marijuana smoking pipe was found inside the bag that contained the marijuana.



These original bags were subsequently weighed and totaled 412 grams of marijuana total package weight. A Sirchie Test Kit #8 was used to test the marijuana which tested positive for the presence of THC. The bags were later consolidated to fit the PBSO drug bags and weighed 384 grams total package weight to be placed into evidence.

Upon returning to District 16 sub station, a audio/video recording interview was made with Brucker. Enough time elapsed at this point that Brucker became capable of communicating effectively. Brucker was read her Miranda Warnings which she acknowledged and advised that she wanted to discuss the marijuana.

Brucker told me that she received the marijuana from her uncle Stewart Hirsch who she resides with. He had given it to her to transport to an unknown location with the intent of calling her during the transport for the location. Additionally, Brucker stated that Hirsch has numerous people come to the residence to purchase and sell marijuana. No other useful information was obtained during the interview. After the video ended, Brucker stated the the alcoholic beverage she had been drinking was grain alcohol, which caused her to fall from her bicycle.

Brucker was arrested, secured with hand cuffs, double locked and checked for tightness before eventually being transported to the Palm Beach County Jail for processing.

Based on my investigation Brucker obtained a sizable amount of marijuana, individually packaged and labeled from who she advised as her uncle. While in possession of the marijuana she began to transport it to an unknown location, which in all probability was her intent to sell to an unknown person.
