## PROBABLE CAUSE

On the above date and approximate time, I was in service in Palm Beach county. While traveling southbound on Interstate 95 north of Okeechobee BLVD (SR-704) I observed a black two door Ford mustang on the HOV lane passing other vehicles traveling at a high rated speed, driving aggressively and following too closely other vehicles. I then paced the vehicle in my marked patrol car at approximately 111 miles per hour in a posted 65 miles per hour zone for approximately 1 mile. After passing the exit to Belvedere road, I observed the vehicle to switch into the outside center lane from the outside lane still traveling at a high rated speed driving aggressively and following too closely into other vehicles. I then proceeded to overtake the vehicle. I then activated my emergency equipment in my mark patrol vehicle. The vehicle then pulled over on Interstate 95 southbound exit ramp to Forest Hill BLVD in the right paved shoulder. I then approached the vehicle by the passenger's side and observed four white males in the vehicle. I then asked the driver if he knew the reason why I stopped him, the driver advised "I was going a little fast". I then asked the driver for his driver's license, registration and proof of insurance. The driver provided me with his Florida driver's license, the vehicles title, and insurance. I identified the driver by his Florida drivers license as Logan McAdam Steele. I asked the driver where he was coming from and the driver advised he was going back home from City Place. I then observed an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the inside of the subject vehicle. I went back in my patrol car to write the subject the speeding citation. I then approached the subjects vehicle again and asked the driver to step out. When the subject stepped out of his vehicle, I observed he leaned into the vehicle with his left arm to keep his balance. I then proceeded to explain the subject the speeding citation when I observed an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth area and breath. I also observed his eyes to be red and bloodshot While explaining then subjects speeding citation I also observed the subject leaning on the back of his vehicle to keep his balance. I then advised the subject to stand without leaning on the car. I then asked the subject if he felt ok to drive his vehicle. Subject advised me "yes". I then asked the subject to perform some sobriety exercises. The subject avoided the question by asking for his lawyer to be present. TI asked the driver again to perform some sobriety exercises and the subject advised me he was just heading home. Tpr. Escaran and I continued to ask the driver to perform the sobriety exercises and the subject kept advising he wanted his lawyer present. The subject then asked me if he could call his father to drive him home. Tpr Escaran asked the driver if he couldn't drive himself. Subject advised he just didn't want to get in trouble. Tpr. Escaran advised the subject that failing to perform the roadside exercises could be used against him in a court of law. The subject asked again for his lawyer to be present. The subject kept being uncooperative and was placed under arrest at approximately 4:25pm. Subject was searched and was advised to spit out his gum. I also observed a discolored tongue with a yellow film. The subject was advised he was being placed under arrest for DUI and was placed in the back seat of my marked patrol vehicle. prior to leaving to the Palm Beach county jail, the subjects parents then arrived on scene and were advised of the arrest. Driver then was transported to the Palm Beach county jail. Upon arrival the driver was taken to the breath testing center and a 20 minute observation was conducted to insure the driver did not take anything by mouth. During the 20 minute observation the driver became emotional and began to cry. After the 20 minute observation was completed the driver was taken into the testing room and was requested to submit to a lawful test of his breath. The subject advised he wanted to call his attorney. The driver was advised he couldn't have an attorney at that time and was advised of the implied consent. The driver advised that he understood and asked again to call his attorney. The driver was requested to submit to a test of his breath again and he advised he wanted to speak to his attorney several times. The driver was asked again if he was willing to submit and continually advised to speak to his attorney. This was ultimately taken as a refusal to submit to a test of his breath at approximately 5:34 PM. The driver was then advised of his constitutional warnings and advised he understood.
