**Probable Cause**  
On December 23, 2019, I was on routine patrol in my marked patrol vehicle (1125) in Palm Beach County, Florida. At approximately 7:59 pm, I was dispatched to backup Sargent (Sgt) R. Dooley #299 on a traffic stop, northbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9), south of Woolbright Road. Upon my arrival, I observed a black in color Toyota Corolla bearing a Florida plate of (KRJS75) stopped on the

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left shoulder. The Toyota had front end damage. A Hispanic female wearing all black was standing outside of the vehicle speaking with Trooper Leon (#1185). Upon speaking with Sgt R. Dooley, he stated he observed the vehicle in the far-right lane traveling at the high rate of speed, 95 mph in a posted 65 mph. Sgt R. Dooley stated the vehicle then cut across all left lanes of traffic and entered the left paved shoulder. Sgt R. Dooley stated the vehicle then began weaving on and off the shoulder failing to maintain. Sgt R. Dooley then activated his emergency lights and sirens and initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle. Sgt R. Dooley stated the vehicle took a few seconds to react to his emergency lights and sirens but came to a complete stop on the left shoulder.

I identified the driver by her Florida Driver's License (P263-520-90-649-0), as Lorraine Pichardo. Upon speaking with Ms. Pichardo she appeared to be in a daze and not making a lot of sense. When Ms. Pichardo spoke, I detected a faint smell of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath. I asked Ms. Pichardo if she was willing to come with me off the highway to perform some field sobriety exercises, she agreed. As Ms. Pichardo spoke her speech was slurred.

I then placed Ms. Pichardo in the back seat of my patrol vehicle and took her off the highway at Woolbright Road, west of Interstate 95 (State Road 9), in the Home Depot parking lot (SW 8th St, Boynton Beach, FL 33426). On the car ride off the highway I asked Ms. Pichardo about the damage on her car, she didn't give me a clear answer on why her vehicle was damaged and stated it happened earlier. She stated she was coming from Miami and is now going back home to Sunny Isles Beach. Then Ms. Pichardo began to tell me how her ex-boyfriend called her and that she shouldn't have gone to meet up with him.

Upon taking Ms. Pichardo out of my patrol vehicle, I then again asked Ms. Pichardo if she was willingly to perform Field Sobriety Exercises and she agreed. I asked Ms. Pichardo if she had any medical issues, she stated she has been sick for 3 weeks with an unknown issue that she is in the process of finding out. She then stated she has a follow up appointment with her doctor on the 26th to find out more about her illness. She stated she is constantly sick and that she doesn't know what is wrong with her. Ms. Pichardo stated she does not have diabetes. I then asked if she is on any medications and she stated yes, she takes steroids, anti-biotic's, and pain medication. I then asked her when was the last time she took the pain medication and she stated this morning around 11 AM. Ms. Pichardo stated she takes Vicodin. I advised Ms. Pichardo it was only 8:30 AM and asked if she meant yesterday morning and she stated yes.

The ground was flat and clear of debris.

All exercises were explained and demonstrated. The following exercises are as followed:

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus: (Streamlight red LED pen was used). I checked for resting Nystagmus, in which none was observed. I then checked for equal pupil size and equal tracking, in which both eyes were equal in size and both eyes were able to track equally. I Had to tell Ms. Pichardo several times to look at my pen and stop moving her head. Ms. Pichardo began to stare blankly into the parking lot

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away from my pen. Ms. Pichardo stated she thought she was looking at the pen.

- Left Eye - Lack of Smooth Pursuit
- Right Eye- Lack of Smooth Pursuit
- Left Eye- Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation
- Right Eye- Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation
- Left Eye- Onset of Nystagmus Prior to 45 Degrees
- Right Eye- Onset of Nystagmus Prior to 45 Degrees

Before starting the Walk and Turn exercise, I asked Ms. Richardo if she wanted to take her black heels off and she stated yes and took her shoes off. I then began to ask Ms. Richardo is she had issues with balancing and medical issues with her legs, she stated she has Arthritis and pain throughout her body constantly. I asked if that would prevent her from doing the exercises and she stated she will try.

Walk and Turn: A white painted line in the parking lot was utilized.

- Unable to keep balance in starting position.
- Missed heel to toe on each step.
- Wrong number of steps.
- Improper turn.
- Stopped while walking.

Ms. Pichardo didn't count steps out loud and swayed while in starting position. Ms. Pichardo asked after turn if I wanted her to go back and I advised her to do as I instructed.

One Leg Stand: Raised her right leg.

- Sways while balancing.
- Put foot down.
- Used arms for balance.

Ms. Pichardo didn't look at her raised foot. Ms. Pichardo raised her foot approximately 3 inches off the ground.

Trooper Leon began to asking Ms. Pichardo about the damage to her vehicle, she stated someone hit her. When Trooper Leon asked her if she spoke with authorities she states no one was around. Due to the Totality of the circumstances, at approximately 8:42 AM, Ms. Pichardo was placed under arrest for DUI pursuant to Florida Statue 316.193.1. Ms. Pichardo was read her Miranda Warnings from my state issued print out, where she states she understood and agreed to speak with me. I asked Ms. Pichardo if the crash was on the interstate or off the interstate and she stated it was today before she got in her vehicle. I asked Ms. Pichardo where she was coming from and she stated Miami. I then asked Ms. Pichardo what she was doing in Miami and she stated working at a Greek restaurant called Mandolin. I asked if she worked yesterday or today and she stated yesterday. I asked at what time did she start work and she stated 1 PM till 9:30 PM. After work she stated she had a work Christmas party.

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I asked if she had consumed any alcohol at the party and she stated yes that she had a few glasses of wine and a sip of tequila. She stated the Christmas party ended around 1 AM and after her and a couple co workers went out to a bar. She stated she stayed at the bar for approximately an hour. I then asked her what she was doing for the other six hours before the traffic stop and she stated she was on her way to her Ex boyfriends house off Forest Hill Blvd but never made it. Ms. Pichardo stated she took half a Vicodin before she began drinking at approximately 10 PM. I then began to ask Ms. Pichardo if she believes she was under the influence and she stated not from the Vicodin but from the alcohol. I then asked on a scale from 1 to 10, 1 not feeling any effects to 10 feeling the effects of the Vicodin and or alcohol what would she say she was at and she stated a "4".

Ms. Pichardo was searched and placed into my patrol vehicle. Ms. Pichardo was then transported to the Palm Beach County Jail's Breath Alcohol Facility (BAT). Once I arrived at the Palm Beach County Jail's BAT facility, Ms. Pichardo began a 20-minute observation, during this time she did not regurgitate or take anything by mouth. Ms. Pichardo was asked to provide a lawful sample of her breath and she agreed. Ms. Pichardo was unable to follow the breath tech instructions and provide 3 samples of her breath. At approximately 10:10 AM, I counted Ms. Pichardo inability to provide a breath sample as a refusal to submit. Ms. Pichardo was given a citation for the speed along with a citation for failure to maintain a single lane.

Ms. Pichardo was then booked into the Palm Beach County Jail.

My patrol vehicle is equipped with in car video and audio recording that is available upon request.

The above incident occurred in Palm Beach County.




