

On 08/20/2019, at approximately 0318 hours, I arrived in the area of Alt A1A and Donald Ross Rd, PBG, FL, to assist Ofc Butzbach 507, with a traffic stop. Body worn camera was used.

Ofc Butzbach 507, said he observed the vehicle traveling north bound on Alt A1A just south of Donald Ross Rd. Ofc Butzbach stated the vehicle was failing to maintain a single lane and when it approached Donald Ross Rd, the vehicle made a abrupt left hand turn onto Donald Ross Rd, from the inside through lane, rather than the left turn lane. I made contact with the driver, Luke Flanagan, while he was still in the driver seat of the vehicle while it was on and running. Ofc Butzbach said Flanagan was the driver when he initially stopped the vehicle. Flanagan had a flushed red face, watery bloodshot eyes, slurred speech and had the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. Flanagan said he was coming from his place of employment, "Ale House", and that he had consumed alcoholic beverages prior to driving the vehicle.

Based on my observations, I asked Flanagan to exit the vehicle to participate in Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises, to which he cooperated.

The first exercise I conducted, was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. Flanagan said he did not have any medical conditions which would affect the exercise. The stimulus used, was a Streamlight Stylus with an illuminated red tip. I observed a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes and onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes.

The next exercise attempted, was the Walk and Turn. Flanagan was unable to assume the starting position. Flanagan stepped onto the line, then lost his balance and stumbled off the line. Flanagan then refused to participate in the exercise. I explained Taylor Warning's to Flanagan, he again refused to participate in the exercises. I asked



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Flanagan if there was a medical reason he did not want to participate, to which he responded "I`m sick".

Based on my observations, I placed Flanagan under arrest at 0323 hours. Once Flanagan was cuffed, Ofc Butzbach advised him of his Miranda Warning`s, which he elected to waive. I asked Flanagan what was in the "vape pen" I observed in the cup holder next to his right leg. Initially, Flanagan said he did not know. I said to Flanagan based on my training and experience that appears to be THC in the "vape pen". Flanagan responded that it was in deed THC. Flanagan was later asked if he is a medical marijuana patient, to which he said no.

At the PBSO BAT, Flanagan initially refused to provide a breath sample. I read Florida Implied Consent on camera to Flanagan, to which he agreed to provide a sample of breath for the purpose of determining its alcohol content. At 0422, Flanagan blew .204. Flanagan then refused to provide a second sample, I again read Florida Implied Consent to him, he then agreed to provide a second sample. At 0426 hours, Flanagan blew .195.

Based on the results of my investigation, I have probable cause to show Luke Flanagan operated a motor vehicle in the state of Florida, while under the influence of alcohol, in violation of FSS 316.193(1). Also the degree to which he was impaired put him in violation of FSS 316.193(4). Lastly by knowingly being in possession of a controlled substance, put him in violation of FSS 893.13(6) (A).

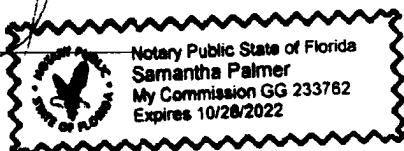

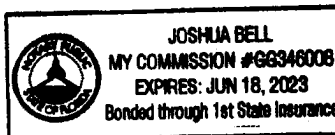

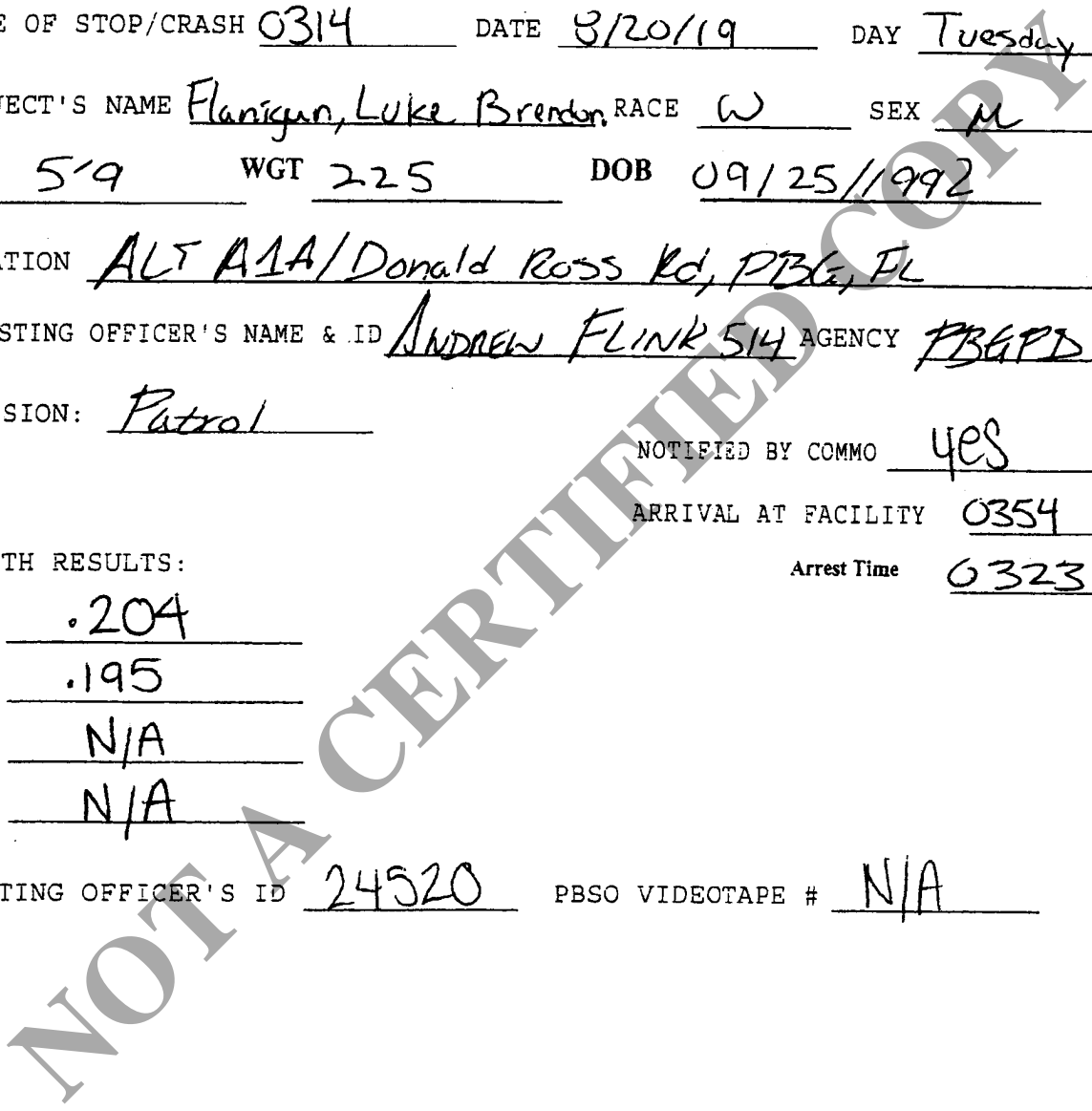
