





## DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On Saturday August 26, 2017 at approximately 01:50 hours, I responded to a traffic stop at the intersection of Crestwood Boulevard and Southern Boulevard to investigate for a possible impaired driver. Upon my arrival, I observed several Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office vehicles with their emergency lights activated and a gray Chevrolet Trailblazer bearing Florida tag "ESQ-C19". I exited my patrol car and made contact with Deputy Palmer #25514 who told me the following, " I observed a gray in color Chevrolet Trailblazer bearing FL Tag(ESQC19) traveling Eastbound on State Road 80 passing Big Blue Trace, in the Village of Wellington, Palm Beach County , Florida. I further observed the Trailblazer drift from the 3 lane to the 4 lane and then back to the 3 lane failing to maintain a single lane. The Trailblazer that was now approaching Forest Hill Blvd, went from the 3 lane into the left turn lane right before the light skipping over the solid white line. I conducted a traffic stop using my fully marked PBSO emergency vehicle with emergency lights for reasonable suspicion of DUI."

Upon my approach of the vehicle I met with Lynn Moore (D.O.B. 08-15-1960). I introduced myself to Lynn and stated that I stopped her because it appeared that she was having trouble maintaining a single lane. I then asked Lynn if she had anything to drink tonight. ## OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I walked up the driver side to the Chevrolet Trailblazer and observed the driver Lynn Moore who was wearing blue jean pants and a black shirt. While questioning Moore, I observed that she seemed to be confused by my questions. When I asked her if Deputy Palmer explained the reason she had been stopped, Moore stated "no." Deputy Palmer told me he explained to her why she had been stopped and while doing so he received a blank stare. I re-explained to Moore why she had been stopped and also informed her that Deputy Palmer was under the suspicion that she may have consumed an unspecified amount of an unknown alcoholic beverage which would have impaired her ability to operate a motor vehicle safely. I observed Moore eyes appeared red and glassy. I observed that she was slurring her words. Moore was asked to exit the vehicle to perform field sobriety tasks which she agreed to. While exiting the vehicle, Moore appeared to be shaky on her feet. Moore had difficulty walking maintaining her balance and reclined against her vehicle until told to do otherwise.

## DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

I asked if Moore if she had been drinking or used any drugs. Moore stated she drank three bud light beers at Boonie's and stated she does not take any drugs. I asked Moore if she has any medical problems and if so what were they. Moore stated she does not take any medication.



Other Observations:

Once positioned in the front of my vehicle, I continued my investigation. I instructed Moore to keep her hands by her side, stand with her feet together, and follow a red light stimulus with her eyes not turning her head. I asked her if she understood my instructions. Moore verbally stated she understood my instructions. While doing so I observed Moore swayed forward and backwards. I observed both eyes to be red, bloodshot, and glossy. Her left and right eye displayed equal pupil size, equal tracking, and a lack of smooth. I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus was present in both her left and right eye at maximum deviation during two separate four second evaluations. The onset of nystagmus was prior to a 45 degree angle in both her left and right eye during two separate four second evaluations. Vertical nystagmus was present in both the left and right eye during two separate four second evaluations. While conducting the task I had to remind her to keep hands by her side, not turn her head and follow the stimulus multiple times.

WALK & TURN:

I positioned Moore on a painted white line which was on a smooth and level surface, free of any debris and well lit by the headlights on my vehicle and (nearby street lighting). I instructed Moore to place her left foot on the line and her right foot in front of the left touching heel to toe. I instructed her that she was to keep her hands at her side and stay in this position until I instructed her to do otherwise. I instructed her to walk nine heel to toe steps counting out loud, while watching her feet. On the ninth step she was to keep her front foot on the line and use her back foot, in a series of small steps, to turn around before walking nine heel to toe steps the opposite direction counting out loud and watching her feet. I demonstrated the task while I was verbally instructing her in the proper way to complete the task. During the task, I observed Moore had a difficult time maintaining the instructed position so I told her if she wanted to she could take off her high heels if it would better her platform for walking. Moore took off her shoes and while standing in the instructed position, I observed she swayed while balancing, started too soon, stops walking to steady self, did not touch heel to toe, stepped off the line three times. Used arms to maintain balance (+6"), did not turn properly and while doing so lost her balance and staggered.

ONE LEG STAND:

I placed Moore with her feet together and arms at her side. I demonstrated the task as I verbally instructed her to raise one of her feet approximately six inches off of the ground, point her toe towards my patrol car, look at the raised foot, and count out loud 1001, 1002, 1003 and so on until told to stop. I asked her if she understood the instructions and demonstration I provided. After Moore stated she understood my instructions, the task was performed. While Moore stood in the instructional position, I observed she swayed while standing stationary. While raising her foot she swayed while balancing, was shaky on her feet and placed her foot down three times (within 30 seconds).

FINGER TO NOSE:

I instructed Moore to stand with her feet together, make each hand into a fist keeping, extended her index fingers and to place her palms facing up. She was instructed to lower her arms by her side. I instructed and demonstrated the proper hand and arm position and for her to remain in this position while I demonstrated the rest of the task. I instructed and demonstrated her to tilt her head back approximately 45 degrees and close her eyes while waiting for a verbal command of left or right. On the command of "left" or "right", she would raise the requested hand, touch the tip of her finger to the tip of her nose, then bring her hand immediately back down to her side. During the instruction and demonstration of the task she swayed while standing in the instructional position. Also while attempting to position her in the instructional stance she had difficulty with manual dexterity and struggled to extend her index fingers without using her other fingers. I asked her if she understood the instructions I provided and she verbally stated she understood. I instructed her to start the task as explained. During the task, I observed Moore did not keep eyes closed, failed to return arms to side, correct finger did not touch tip of nose on all right commands and used wrong hand once.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

I verbally inquired Moore could recite the entire English alphabet. She stated she was able to recite the English alphabet and I instructed her to place her feet together with her arms at her side and stay in this position until told to do otherwise. I instructed her that upon starting she was to tilt her head back approximately 45 degrees and close her eyes. She would begin to state the alphabet in a slow and methodical manner without singing or rhyming it. I asked her if she understood the instructions and she verbally replied she understood. I instructed Moore to start the task as explained. During the task, I observed Moore did not recite alphabet as instructed and instead sung the alphabet in rhythm. Moore did not keep eyes closed.


