PROBABLE CAUSE

On the above date and time I was in service in Palm Beach County, FL. I was traveling northbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) south of 45th St. when I was dispatched to a call located on the northbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9) exit ramp to Indiantown Rd. (State Road 706). The call involved a vehicle that was described to be all over the roadway unable to maintain a single lane. An off duty police officer was the caller and witness to the reckless vehicle (See Witness Statement). When I arrived on scene I observed a marked patrol car and a grey in color vehicle on the right paved emergency shoulder just north of Indiantown Rd (State Road 706). I approached the witness who was identified to be Sgt. Farrell #837 of Palm Beach County School Board and explained to me what she witnessed and observed when she conducted the traffic stop. I then approached the grey in color vehicle on its passenger side and observed a white male in the driver seat who was later identified, through his Florida Drivers License as Matthew Jason Wohlleb 08/04/1983. I advised Mr. Wohlleb who I was and the reason I was on scene. I asked Mr. Wohlleb if there was a reason behind his driving pattern. I then observed Mr. Wohlleb's eyes to be glossy and red in color. Mr. Wohlleb then advised me that he thinks it was because he was on his phone and does not recall not being able to not maintain a single lane. I then asked Mr. Wohlleb where he was coming from and where he was heading to. Mr. Wohlleb then advised me that he was hanging out with some friends at the Twisted Trunk (a Brewing Company in Palm Beach Gardens). Mr. Wohlleb then advised that he was heading home to Boynton Beach. I then asked Mr. Wohlleb if he knew where he was now and he responded that he was in Boynton Beach. I then acknowledged Mr. Wohlleb that he was traveling northbound and is currently in Jupiter, FL. Mr. Wohlleb then stated that he was an uber driver and was going to pick up some drivers. I questioned Mr. Wohlleb on why he would be going to pick up drivers, he then stated that they all needed a ride. I then requested Mr. Wohlleb to remove the keys from the ignition and to please step out of the vehicle. When I met with Mr. Wohlleb outside of the vehicle I advised him the reasoning of why I requested him to step out. Mr. Wohlleb then advised me that he understood. It was then when I could smell the odor commonly associated with the smell of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath as he spoke. I then asked Mr. Wohlleb what he had to drink prior to driving. Mr. Wohlleb then advised me that he had a couple of beers. I then asked Mr. Wohlleb when his last beer was consumed, he then advised me that he last had a drink two hours ago. I then advised Mr. Wohlleb that I would now, with his consent, be requesting him to perform a series of roadside exercises. Mr. Wohlleb then advised me that he is normally wobbly on days other than now that he's been drinking. Mr. Wohlleb then agreed and consented to perform the exercises that I have requested of him to perform. (See Roadside Tasks Sheet).

The area for the following roadside exercises was level and free of debris. Subject agreed to use a straight solid white line on the roadway to perform the Walk and Turn.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

- LT EYE-LACK OF SMOOTH PURSUIT
- RT EYE-LACK OF SMOOTH PURSUIT
- LT EYE-DISTINCT & SUSTAINED NYSTAGMUS AT MAX. DEVIATION
- RT EYE-DISTINCT & SUSTAINED NYSTAGMUS AT MAX. DEVIATION
- LT- EYE-ONSET OF NYSTAGMUS PRIOR TO 45 DEGREES
- RT- EYE-ONSET OF NYSTAGMUS PRIOR TO 45 DEGREES

Walk and Turn Exercise:

Interaction Phase:

- Subject advised he did not feel comfortable doing walk and turn.

One Leg Stand Exercise:

Interaction Phase:

- This exercise was demonstrated to the subject. Subject advised that he will be able to perform the exercise. Subject advised he understood instructions and did not have any questions. Subject did not perform exercise as instructed. Subject continued to touch the floor and lose balance during exercise.

Finger to Nose:

- This exercise was demonstrated to the Subject. Subject advised that he will be able to perform the exercise. Subject did not bring finger down immediately as instructed. Subject touched lip instead of nose several times.

Romberg Balance:

- This exercise was demonstrated to the Subject. Subject advised that he will be able to perform the exercise. Subject swayed throughout exercise. Subject exceeded 30 secs.

Based on the totality of circumstances, Mr. Wohlleb was placed under arrest for DUI pursuant to Florida Statute 316.193.1 at 12:41 AM. Mr. Wohlleb then

searched and placed in my patrol vehicle and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail in which he arrived at 01:09 AM. After the defendant's 20 min. observation, the defendant was then given the opportunity to provide a sample of his breath in which he consented to provide. The defendant provided his first breath sample at 01:30 AM in which resulted to be a .130. The defendant's second breath sample was then provided at 01:34 AM and resulted to be a .127.

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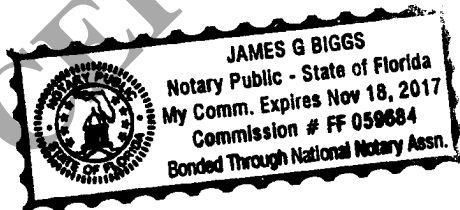

Refusal to submit to the test I have requested of you is admissible into evidence in any criminal proceeding.
