PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 05/11/19 at approximately 0345 hours, I responded to PGA Blvd/I-95 in reference to a male passed out in the driver's seat of his vehicle while stopped in the grassy median after the front bumper made contact with a metal sign. Upon arrival I observed a white Chrysler sedan bearing FL tag (JLBR74) stopped in the grassy median on PGA Blvd to the West of I-95. I observed a white male, later identified as Matthew Strahl, sitting in the driver's seat with the vehicle running, doors locked, and the transmission in the "Drive" position. Several attempts to awake Matthew were not effective. Due to the possible medical emergency Ofc. Barker began banging with his department issued baton on the front passenger window to unlock the vehicle. The loud impact of the baton breaking the window did not awake Matthew. Ofc. Barker unlocked the doors at which point I opened the driver door at which point Matthew woke up and began staring off in the distance and appeared disoriented.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I observed Matthew's pupils to be dilated more than a normal persons, the sclera of his eyes to be reddened, his eyes to be watery, his face to be flushed, and his speech to be slow and slurred. During the encounter I requested Matthew's driver's license, at which he began counting his money from his wallet and had a blank stare. Palm Beach Gardens Fire Rescue arrived on scene and began treating Matthew. PBGFR released Matthew to my custody for the administration of field sobriety exercises. Due to my observations on scene, I requested Matthew perform several field sobriety exercises. Matthew agreed and stood up from the stretcher and walked behind the ambulance. During this encounter I noticed Matthew had an unsteady walk.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Matthew stated he did not know where he was coming from but knew he was going to his residence in West Palm Beach. Matthew did not know where he was or what happened causing Police and Fire/Rescue response. Matthew stated he did consume some alcohol but did not remember how much or what type. Matthew does take medication for his his shoulder pain.

ODORS:

Strong odor of the additives of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath from a conversational distance.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Slow, low, mumbled

ATTITUDE: Passive, Unwilling to talk

CLOTHING: Messed, ruffled

MEDICAL/OTHER: Matthew stated he did not have any ailments that would prohibit him from being able to operate a vehicle or perform daily tasks. Matthew did state he has back, shoulder, and knee pain, however he is still able to perform daily tasks without assistance.

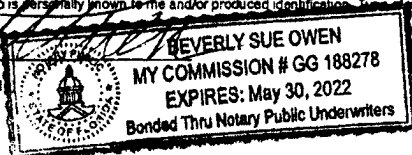

Other Observations:

Vertical Gaze Nystagmus as well as a lack of convergence was observed with the left eye coming toward center and stopping, and the right eye not moving. Matthew needed to be reminded several times to keep his head still and to follow the stimulus.

WALK & TURN:

During the instruction stage, Matthew failed to maintain the position and stepped off line, placing his feet shoulder width apart. During the first set of steps, Matthew took 11 steps and utilized my patrol vehicle for balance. Each step was not touching heel to toe and they were not counted aloud. Steps 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, and 10 were not on the line. Matthew did not perform the turn as instructed by stepping backward and spinning on his feet. On the return set of steps Matthew took 12 steps all of which were not touching heel to toe and they were also not counted aloud. After his 12th step, Matthew turned around with his feet shoulder width apart and placed his hands in his pockets.

ONE LEG STAND:

During the instructions, Matthew stated he could not perform the exercise because he needs both knees replaced. He attempted the exercise and elevated his right leg approximately 2-3 inches off the ground. After 5 seconds, Matthew placed his right leg down and then elevated his left leg. Matthew was observed to use his arms for balance and sway during the entirety of this exercise. Matthew elevated his left leg approximately 2-3 inches off the ground for 9 seconds then placed it down and leaned forward grabbing his knees. After the exercise was terminated, he turned around and placed his hands behind his back as if he was being placed under arrest.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Modified Romberg Balance: During the exercise Matthew estimated to 30 seconds in 55 seconds real time. Matthew stated he counted "1, Thousand, 2, Thousand, and so on to 30." During the exercise I observed a 2 inch orbital sway and Matthew's eyes to be open. Matthew tilted his head forward and began looking at Fire/Rescue because he heard someone talking and stated he was supposed to count to 30 seconds, but only got to 25 seconds in the time that had elapsed.

FINGER TO NOSE:

During the first attempt of this exercise, Matthew kept his eyes open and did not remove his finger from his nose. I reminded Matthew of the instructions again and attempted the exercise again.

1. Left— Pad of his left index finger touched the tip of his nose
2. Right— Pad of his right index finger touched the tip of his nose
3. Left— Pad of his left index finger touched the tip of his nose
4. Right— Pad of his right index finger touched the tip of his nose
5. Right— Pad of his right index finger touched the tip of his nose
6. Left— Pad of his left index finger touched the tip of his nose.

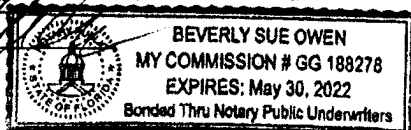
