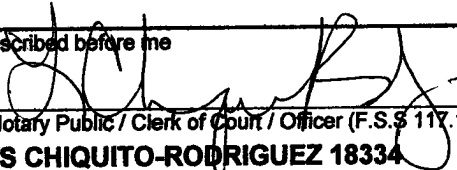

	I advised the defendant that I concluded my DUI investigation and, based on the observational clues on the SFST's and the defendant's admission of consuming alcohol, determined that she was too impaired to operate a motor vehicle and placed the defendant under arrest for DUI. The defendant verbally stated that she understood. I placed the defendant in handcuffs that were checked for proper fit and tightness and double locked and placed defendant in the rear of my PBSO marked patrol vehicle and transported the defendant to the B.A.T. (Breath Alcohol Testing) facility. On the way to the breath testing facility the defendant begged and pleaded with me to forget the incident and release her that she "learned her lesson" and that she did not want to lose custody of her daughter to her mother because of the arrest. Once at the B.A.T. the defendant was observed for a period of twenty minutes, during which time the defendant did not ingest anything, place anything in her mouth regurgitate or vomit. The defendant provided conflicting information to the breath test operator about her medical conditions and medications that she was taking from what she provided me with at the scene of the investigation. After the twenty minute observation period the defendant was placed on camera and asked if she would submit a breath sample for the purpose of determining its alcohol content and the defendant initially consented. While the breath test operator prepared the instrument for the breath sample the defendant requested an attorney at which point I read her Florida Implied consent. The defendant verbally stated that she understood implied consent and I again asked if she would submit a breath sample and she consented. When asked by the breath test operator to submit the breath sample, the defendant stated that she "could not breath" and began making herself cough although she did not cough at any time during transport or the twenty minute observation period. The defendant provided two breath samples and the results were .092 and .095. The results were given, and explained to the defendant and the defendant verbally stated that she understood. I read the defendant her Constitutional warnings on camera and the defendant verbally stated that she understood her rights. The defendant cooperated with Q&A and again gave conflicting responses in reference to her medical conditions, medications and how her medications are prescribed. I issued the defendant a citation for DUI and transported the defendant to the main detention center, without incident, for booking and processing.

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 6/30/2016, at approximately 0003 hours, I responded to the entrance of the Greystone development, located off of Hagen Ranch Road in Boynton Beach, located within Palm Beach County, Florida at the request of Deputy Iraheta #20325 to conduct a DUI investigation. Upon my arrival on scene I made contact with D/S Iraheta who stated the following, "On Wednesday 06/29/16 at approximately 2335 hours, I responded to a "Mobil Eyes" (PBCFR observed a vehicle driving erratic and were concerned that the driver may be experiencing a medical emergency) call at the 11000 block of White Water Lily Way, unincorporated Boynton Beach, FL 33437, Palm Beach County, in the Greystone community. Upon arrival, I observed the Palm Beach County Fire Rescue, Ladder 47 on scene. I met and spoke with Capt. Perez, who stated the following. They were on Boynton Beach Blvd. and Hagen Ranch Road. They observed a red Volkswagen traveling southbound on Hagen Ranch Road swerving in and out of traffic. They followed the vehicle and observed it at a slow rate of speed with its hazards/flashers on and a flat tire. They then turned their emergency lights and siren to try and stop the vehicle to conduct a welfare check on the driver. The vehicle came to a final stop at the entrance of Greystone community. Fire Rescue noticed the driver, a white female behind the wheel to be crying and very emotional. This ruled out it was a medical crisis at that point. In my observations, I observed a red Volkswagen/ Jetta facing west on the left entrance gate with a female driver in the front seat with engine still running. The female driver was identified by her Florida Driver's License as Megan Alyse Rodriguez (defendant) DOB:2/10/1988. When speaking to Megan, she slurred her words. The Florida Tag 866THZ was run through dispatch and came back to a red, 2007, Volkswagen, Jetta Registered to Megan. Her Driver's License came back valid. A DUI unit was called due to Megan appearing to have signs of impairment. This concludes my involvement in this case, no further. D/S Iraheta gave a sworn probable cause affidavit. Fire Rescue personnel, Reynaldo Perez, gave a sworn written witness statement.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

When I arrived on scene the defendant was standing outside of her vehicle, a red 4 door Volkswagen Jetta bearing Florida tag 866THZ, towards the rear, and the vehicle was stopped within the entrance of Greystone development in Boynton Beach, Florida off of Hagen Ranch Road, just beyond the manned guard gate but just before the arm gates. I made contact with the defendant and verified her identity by her Florida issued driver's license. The defendant was talkative and her speech was slurred and I observed that she lost her balance as she stood stationary speaking with me. I smelled a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage as she spoke with me. I instructed the defendant to relocate to the front of my patrol vehicle. Once in front of my patrol vehicle, and with my in car video activated, I advised the defendant that I was initiating a DUI investigation to determine if she was too impaired to operate a motor vehicle and she verbally stated that she understood. When I asked the defendant if she lived in the community she gave conflicting responses and stated that she did and then that it was her boyfriend that lived in the community. I asked her where she was coming from and she stated that she was returning from Ruby Tuesday, where she works, and that she went to pick up something to eat and was on her way back. She stated that she was a server and a bartender at the restaurant. I then asked if she consumed any alcohol while she was at work and she stated that she had one vodka and pineapple juice, approximately two ounces, with her boyfriend approximately four to five hours prior.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

I asked the defendant if she would submit to voluntary SFST's and she verbally consented. She stated that she had multiple medical problems (Stage 5 Ewing's carcinoma T4 to T8 on her spine, Asthma, Lupus ankles dislocate) and was on multiple medications (Neurontin 200mg BID, Vicodin, Xanax, Anti malaria medications, morphine pump). I pointed out to the defendant that I observed her walk from her vehicle to my patrol car without difficulty and asked if she was currently experiencing any pain, discomfort and inability to perform the tasks that I was requesting of her and briefly described what they entailed and she verbally stated that other than her ankles dislocating from time to time, that she would not have a problem performing the tasks. I used a white pre painted line to the west of the guard gate, where the surface was level and dry, there was ambient lighting and was away from any through traffic.

ODORS:

Strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from defendant's breath that became stronger as the defendant spoke to me

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Slow, slurred, kept repeating herself, whispered and then yelled

ATTITUDE: Extreme mood swings, uncooperative, combative, crying, apologetic

CLOTHING: Black shirt, Black skirt, Black boots (Hair disheveled and makeup smeared all over her face like the "joker")

MEDICAL/OTHER: Stated she had stage 5 Ewing's carcinoma (T4-T8), Lupus, & Asthma and currently takes Neurontin 200mg BID, Vicodin, Xanax, Morphine and antimalaria meds. Ankles dislocate from time to time but no current pain and/or problems.

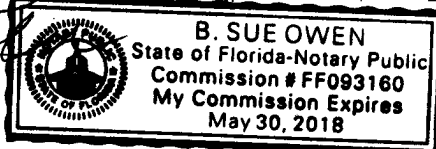

She returned twelve steps and stated, "There, I gave you an extra two steps since I messed up earlier".

ONE LEG STAND:

Instructed and demonstrated. Defendant verbally stated she understood the instructions. She stated that she could not physically perform this task and this task was not completed.

FINGER TO NOSE:

Instructed and demonstrated. Defendant verbally stated she understood the instructions. Defendant missed the tip of her nose and had to reposition her finger atleast twice. Her moves were slow and deliberate and her finger hovered over a nose for a brief period at times. She had to be instructed during the task to maintain her head tilted back and with her eyes closed. She swayed in a circular motion.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Instructed and demonstrated. Defendant verbally stated she understood the instructions. She swayed in a resting position. She recited the alphabet in a non-rhythmic manner and when she reached the letter "Y" she said, "Y is sometimes a vowel" and continued the rest of the alphabet until the letter "Z".

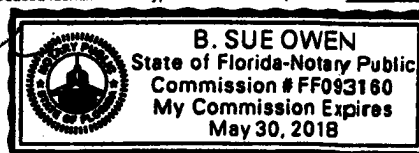
