On the **30** day of **December**, **2019** at **22:43** (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 12/30/19 I responded to the Dixie Mobil Gas Station, 1990 N Dixie Hwy, after Sgt. Smith made contact with three subjects, later identified to me as b/m Reache Evans, w/f Mia Ravenson, and w/m Ryan McKewin.

According to Sgt. Smith, he was conducting a crime suppression check at the gas station when he observed a silver Mitsubishi Galant, bearing FL tag # NDG U97, occupied by McKewin (driver) and Raveson (front passenger). He then observed a b/m (Evans) approach the vehicle on the front passenger side and interact with Raveson. Evans then left on his bicycle and yelled, "I'll be right back." Evans rode his bicycle southbound on N. Dixie Hwy to NE 15th Terrace and returned. Evans re-approached Raveson and told them, "I told you I'd be right back." Sgt. Smith then observed what he believed to be a "hand to hand" drug transaction between the two of them. He then approached them and observed several small "rock like" pieces in Evans' left hand that he recognized through his training and experience to be "crack" cocaine. Sgt. Smith also observed Raveson fidgeting with her purse in the front passenger compartment of the vehicle, possibly in an attempt to conceal something. Evans also had cash in his right hand. Evans then put the cash in his left hand on top of the crack cocaine, possibly to conceal the cocaine. Sgt. Smith then detained Evans and took possession of the cocaine. He then placed Evans under arrest once the cocaine was taken from Evans.

Sgt. Smith then observed a clear long glass cylinder, which he recognized to be a "crack pipe" in the front passenger door handle of the vehicle where Raveson was seated in plain view.

Officer Clinard then took possession of Evans, who was in handcuffs, and began walking him back to his marked BRPD patrol vehicle for post arrest transport to BRPD booking. Evans then pulled away from Ofc. Clinard, causing him to fall, and Evans then fled south on foot on N Dixie Hwy. He was then located a short time later hiding in the

bushes on NE 15th Terrace, just east of N Dixie Hwy, by Sgt. Harding and taken back into custody by Ofc. Forbes.

Prior to speaking with Raveson about the "crack pipe", I read her Constitutional Warning (Miranda Rights) to her and she agreed to speak with me.

Post Miranda Raveson initially denied any knowledge of the pipe and said Evans possibly dropped it in there. She was then placed under arrest and her purse in the front seat passenger compartment where she was fidgeting was inventoried.



While checking her purse, I located her wallet. Inside her wallet I observed two small plastic baggies, one clear and one red, which each contained a brown substance that I recognized through my training and experience to be heroin. I also observed a small orange pill which was scored "153" on one side (later identified as Buprenorphine Hydrochlorid) in the wallet. I then located a yellow case inside the purse which contained several small "rock like" substances which I recognized through my training and experience to be "crack" cocaine. There was also a long glass cylinder pipe, also known as a "crack pipe", inside the case.

I then spoke with Raveson again about the items located inside of her purse. Raveson then told me that the brown substances located in the two baggies was heroin and it belonged to her. She then told me that the "rock like" substances located in the yellow container was "crack" cocaine and the cocaine, as well and the pipe located with it, were hers. Raveson claimed that the orange pill located in her wallet was hers and claimed to have a prescription for it but was unable to provide one at this time and advised she knew she is not supposed to carry medication without the prescription.

I later spoke with Evans about the incident and post Miranda Evans stated that the "crack" cocaine found in his possession by Sgt. Smith was his, but he was not trying to sell it. He just keeps it in his hand so he doesn't lose it.

The "crack" cocaine located in Evans' possession was field tested positive by Ofc. Forbes and produced a weight of 0.1gms. It was then submitted into BRPD evidence. The "crack" cocaine located in Raveson's possession was field tested positive by Ofc. Forbes and produced a weight of 0.4gms. It was then submitted into BRPD evidence. The heroin was field tested positive by Ofc. Forbes and produced weights of 0.2gms (clear bag) and 0.9gms (red bag) and he then submitted them into BRPD evidence. Poison Control was contacted by Ofc. Galazka regarding the orange pill and was identified as Buprenorphine Hydrochlorid (schedule 3) by Operator ID # 359978. It produced a weight of 0.4gms and was submitted into BRPD evidence by Ofc. Forbes. The two "crack" pipes were also submitted into BRPD evidence by Ofc. Forbes. See Ofc. Forbes' supplement for further.

Based on the facts of the incident, Evans was charged with possession of cocaine


with the intent to sell in violation of FSS 893.13 (1A), resisting an officer without violence in FSS 843.02, and escape from custody in violation of FSS 944.40. Raveson was charged with possession of cocaine, possession of heroin, and possession of a schedule 3 without a prescription in violation of FSS 893.13 (6A). She was further charged with possession of drug paraphernalia in violation of FSS 893.147. Both subjects were transported to BRPD booking for post arrest processing and later TOT CJ.
