


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


(The Shoppes at Jupiter) in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, FL as a backup unit to Officer Kolenich and Officer Gaines. Both officers had conducted a traffic stop on a white, 2001 Chrysler Sebring bearing FL tag # M667US (see supplement from Officer Kolenich and Officer Gaines).</p> <p>Upon arrival, I observed the white Chrysler stopped behind the plaza, on the east side of the building. The driver side door was open and Officer Gaines was standing outside the driver side door. Officer Kolenich advised that he observed this vehicle, while on an unrelated call, driving erratically before leaving the area, through an occupied parking lot. Officer Kolenich further advised he located the vehicle straddling a curb on the east side of the plaza while responding to another call for service and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle (see supplement from Officer Kolenich).</p> <p>Officer Kolenich handed me the driver's Florida Driver License and keys to the vehicle, which I secured inside my vehicle. Officer Kolenich further advised me that the driver, later identified as Michael Matson (DOB 12/29/1952), believed that his vehicle was running and appeared to be intoxicated.</p> <p>I approached the vehicle and observed Matson sitting behind the wheel in the driver seat. I observed that Matson was the sole occupant of the vehicle and confirmed that his vehicle was not running, due to the fact that no sound was coming from the vehicle. I introduced myself to Matson and identified myself as a Jupiter Police Officer. I began to ask Matson questions about where he was coming from and where he was going. Matson advised he was coming from dinner at Duffy's restaurant and was heading home before he was stopped. Matson admitted to having a few alcoholic beverages at Duffy's earlier in the evening before driving his vehicle away from the restaurant, but was unable to advise what he was drinking or how many drinks he had prior to leaving.</p>

<p>As I spoke to Matson, I observed that his eyes were red and glassy. Matson was slurring his speech and I noted the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his person and from inside the vehicle. I also noted that the odor intensified when Matson spoke.</p> <p>After initially speaking with Matson, I began to look for a suitable place to conduct standardized field sobriety tasks. I located a suitable area to conduct a DUI investigation which was approximately 200 feet to the southwest of Matson's vehicle. The area selected was away from passing traffic and was a series of secluded, empty parking spaces on the south side of the plaza. Additionally, to prevent any traffic from interfering with the DUI investigation, Officer Gaines relocated his vehicle and blocked all traffic traveling east from the west side of the parking lot.</p> <p>I repositioned my vehicle to the selected area and returned to Matson's vehicle. I advised Matson that I had a series of roadside tasks I would like him to perform and Matson agreed to relocate to the selected area. Matson attempted to exit his vehicle but it appeared as if he was having trouble standing up. Matson attempted several times to stand up from his vehicle, but almost immediately sat back down while trying to stand up. I asked Matson if he had any medical issues relating to his knees and he stated that he has bad knees which makes it difficult for him to stand. I offered my assistance to help Matson out of the vehicle but Matson refused.</p> <p>Matson eventually exited his vehicle and we both began to walk southwest, towards the aforementioned parking area. While Matson was walking, his knees and back were bent, he was hunched over, and he was taking very small steps. Matson would occasionally sway back and forth while walking and it appeared as if he was having trouble walking. I asked if Matson needed assistance walking to the area, but Matson refused.</p> <p>Matson and I arrived at the area to conduct field sobriety tasks. I instructed Matson to stand at the south end of a white painted parking line. At this time, I began to conduct a criminal DUI investigation. Matson complied and stood with his feet about shoulder-length apart and his hands behind his back prior to me administering any instructions. Matson stood in this position for approximately seven seconds before looking over his right shoulder towards where Officer Gaines was standing. After looking over his shoulder, Matson lost his footing, to the left, took several steps in an apparent attempt to regain control of his balance, and fell to the ground.</p> <p>I recognized that Matson was losing his balance and attempted to grab him to prevent him from falling to the ground. I put my right hand on Matson's chest and ultimately grabbed his left arm but I was unable to prevent Matson from falling. I asked if Matson was OK and if he would like an ambulance to respond. Matson refused medical evaluation and Officer Gaines and I helped Matson back to his feet.</p>

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

After Matson was back on his feet, I again asked if he was alright and he stated he was. I then asked if Matson would be able to complete the tasks and he provided an affirmative response. I instructed Matson to return to a standing position on the south side of the painted parking line. I also instructed Matson to stand with his arms down to his sides instead of behind his back.

Matson returned to the line for a short time before stumbling backwards, to his left, and returning to a standing position at the line. I asked if Matson had any medical conditions or was taking any medications. Matson advised he takes medications for blood pressure and cholesterol but was unable to provide the names of the medications he takes.

After answering, Matson stretched both of his arms to his side and stumbled backwards but did not fall completely to the ground, as he did before. At this time, I began to check for horizontal gaze nystagmus. I read instructions from a prepared text and began the task. While checking for nystagmus, I observed Matson sway back and forth on several occasions. Matson did not maintain his stance and stepped, with his right foot, to the rear, returned his right foot, and then stumbled to the rear several steps. During the task, I observed Matson had lack of smooth pursuit in both his left and right eye, he had distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, but I was unable to check for onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees due to how badly Matson was swaying back and forth. Due to the fact that Matson continued to stumble to his rear, I was in fear that Matson would fall to the ground again; I terminated the task.

At this time, I began to read instructions for the Walk & Turn task, from a prepared text. Matson placed his left foot on the line and attempted to place his right foot in front, as I instructed. Matson placed his right foot in front of his left, picked up his right foot, stepped approximately one foot to his left with his right foot, and began stumbling to the rear. Officer Gaines stepped forward in an attempt to catch Matson but Matson had already fallen to the ground for the second time.

Fearing that completing the tasks would cause serious physical injury to Matson due to the behavior he was exhibiting, I terminated the standardized field sobriety tasks and Palm Beach County Fire Rescue was called to respond to check on any injuries Matson may have sustained from both falls. Prior to the arrival of Fire Rescue, I placed Matson under arrest for Driving Under the Influence pursuant to FSS 316.193(1).

Palm Beach County Fire Rescue Engine 19 responded (Run # 17-3089) and evaluated Matson at the scene but Matson did not complain of any injuries at the time. Fire Rescue personnel advised that since Matson did not report any injuries to them, he did not require transport to the hospital and Fire Rescue left the scene.

Matson's handcuffs were originally placed to his rear and double-locked to prevent tightening but he was complaining of extreme pain in his wrists when sitting. I placed a second pair of handcuffs on Matson (also in the rear and double-locked), in an attempt to relieve any pressure caused from his body pressing against the handcuffs. After closing the rear doors to my patrol vehicle, Matson began screaming that his right arm was broken due to the handcuff. I opened the rear door to my vehicle and observed that Matson's body was pressing the right handcuff into his right wrist. Due to Matson's age and the fact that Matson's skin appeared to tear easily due to red marks and small cuts on both his arms, I removed the handcuffs from Matson's wrists and used one pair of handcuffs (which were also double-locked) with Matson's arms in front of him.

I left the scene with Matson in my rear seat and proceeded to drive to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Breath Alcohol Testing Facility. Upon arrival, I conducted a twenty minute observation period and Matson consented to provide a sample of his breath to determine its alcohol content. A breath test was conducted by Breath Test Operator Jeanette Cain. Matson provided samples of 0.263 and 0.272, both over the legal limit of 0.08.

I completed the necessary DUI paperwork and subsequently booked Matson into the Palm Beach County Jail for Driving Under the Influence.

Due to the above stated facts, I believe probable cause exists to charge Michael Matson with DUI pursuant to FSS 316.193(1) because he was found driving a vehicle within this state and did have a breath alcohol level above 0.08.


