Wyatt advised that at he observed Michael to have an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from him and wanted Michael to take a drug/tox screen. Wyatt advised that Michael then drove off and then saw my marked patrol vehicle and advised me of the situation. D/S Swigert 26679, was able to locate the vehicle and observed that the vehicle was heading westbound on Lake Worth Road over the bridge approaching my location. D/S Swigert advised that he observed the driver to not be wearing his seat belt as the vehicle was in motion. 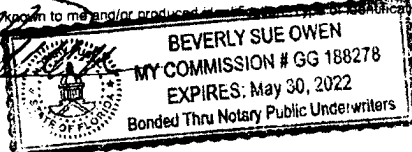
