On 07/04/2019 at 2049hrs, I responded to 4100 NW Broken Sound Blvd in the City of Boca Raton in reference to assisting Sgt. Smith (ID #558) with an intoxicated driver. Upon arrival, I met with Sgt. Smith, who explained that he was on an off-duty detail when he observed a green Kia bearing Texas license plate LBZ4312 driving recklessly westbound on NW 40th St. Sgt. Smith stated that he observed the vehicle failing to maintain a single lane, knock over a traffic cone, and almost strike a vehicle. Sgt. Smith initiated a traffic stop on the above vehicle which came to a stop in the 4100 block of NW Broken Sound Blvd. Sgt. Smith made contact with the driver, who was identified by his Florida driver's license as Michael Lawrence-Muniz (08/21/1992). Sgt. Smith stated that he immediately detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from Michael's breath, observed his eyes as glassy and blood shot, and an open 1.75 bottle of Jack Daniels whisky in the front passenger's seat within Michael's immediate control. See Sgt. Smith's supplement report for further. After speaking with Sgt. Smith, I made contact with Michael, who was in the driver's seat of the above vehicle which was running. When I began speaking to Michael, I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath and clothing. I observed an open container of Jack Daniels whiskey in the front passenger seat next to Michael. Michael's eyes were glassy and bloodshot. I then asked Michael if he was willing to perform Standardized Field Sobriety tasks to eliminate my concern that he may be under the influence of alcohol while operating a vehicle. Michael stated that he would perform the tasks and later stated that he had no medical conditions that would prevent him from performing the sobriety tasks. I then escorted Michael to the front of my vehicle and in view of my patrol vehicle's in-car video. I began my explaining Michael the instructions for the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus verbatim from a printed DUI instructions card. Michael stated that he understood the

instructions. It should be noted that while explaining the instructions to Michael, his balance was unsteady and continuously swayed from side to side. When instructed to begin, Michael was unable to keep his head still and turned his head to the left and right uncontrollably when turning his eyes. Additionally, there was distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in each eye after 45 degrees. While Michael's eyes were moving from front to left/right, both eyes displayed lack of smooth pursuit.

I then explained and demonstrated to Michael the instructions for the Walk and Turn task verbatim from a printed DUI instructions card. Michael stated that he understood the instructions. It should be noted that while explaining the instructions to Michael, his balance was unsteady and continuously swayed from side to side. I repeatedly asked Michael to keep his hands down at his sides while explaining the instructions. When instructed to begin, Michael did eight (8) steps forward, none of which were heel to toe. Michael did not perform the turn as instructed and as I demonstrated. On the first set of steps, Michael did not keep his arms at his side as instructed. Following the turn, Michael then performed nine (9) steps, none of which were heel to toe, back to where he began, where he used his arms for balance and did not keep them at his sides.

I then explained and demonstrated to Michael the instructions for the One Leg Stand task verbatim from a printed DUI instructions card. Michael stated that he understood the instructions. It should be noted that while explaining the instructions to Michael, his balance was unsteady and continuously swayed from side to side. When explaining the instructions, Michael almost fell, causing Officer Hood (#814) to assist him to prevent a fall. Once Michael began, he ended at "1009" without being instructed to stop.

Based on my observations and Michael's performance of the Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks, I placed Michael under arrest for Driving Under the Influence. I placed Michael in handcuffs, checking for tightness, and then double locking. I then transported Michael to the BRPD booking facility in my marked patrol vehicle with in-car camera activated.

Officer Lauckner (#801) responded to BRPD as my Breath Test Operator. Upon my arrival, I began the 20-minute observation at 2004 to 2024hrs, and then Michael was escorted to the BAT room. Michael consented and provided a breath sample. The results of the testing were .156 and .167 respectively. See DUI Influence Report.

Based on the above investigation, probable cause exists to charge Michael Lawrence-Muniz (08/21/1992) for one (1) count of Driving Under the Influence pursuant to F.S.S. 316.193(1). Subsequent to processing at BRPD, I transported Michael to the Palm Beach County Jail. No further involvement.
