On the 4 day of August, 2019 at 00:52 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 8/4/2019 at approximately 0052 hrs, I was on routine patrol when I observed a silver Dodge Avenger (VEHICLE-1), bearing FL tag BSU-U77 traveling at a noticeably high rate of speed through the plaza located on the northeast corner of US 1 and Alternate A1A. I observed the vehicle disregard multiple private stop signs inside of the plaza, at which time it exited the plaza southbound onto SR-706, but failed to yield to the south facing stop sign, by crossing over the stop bar to the extent that the vehicle's rear wheels were astride the stop bar. I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle on US 1 just south of SR-706 and made contact with the driver, Michael Butler (DEFENDANT).

During my initial contact with Butler he had glassy bloodshot eyes and spoke with slurred speech. I did not detect an accent. Butler was initially somewhat confrontational about the violation that I observed and believed that he had done nothing wrong. As I spoke to Butler I detected the odor of alcoholic beverage emitting from his person, which intensified as he spoke. I asked him how many drinks he had consumed and he stated a couple. I asked him on a scale from 1-10 with 1 being sober and 10 being highly intoxicated, where would he rate himself? he advised that he was a 1. I asked him to participate in field sobriety exercises and he agreed. The results of the exercises are below.

HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS (HGN)

- No resting nystagmus and equal pupil size. Equal tracking.
- Lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes.
- Distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both yes.
- Onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes.
- No vertical nystagmus.

LACK OF CONVERGENCE

- Lack of convergence without rebound was observed in both eyes twice

Based on my observations and the totality of the circumstances, I have probable cause to believe that Butler was operating a motor vehicle while impaired by an alcoholic beverage or chemical or controlled substance to the point where his normal faculties were impaired. I placed him under arrest a 0106 hrs and transported him to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing Center, arriving at 0133 hrs, where I placed him under the 20 minute observation period, during which I did not observe him consume nor regurgitate anything. We then went on video with BAT Technician Leahy (#19183) and I requested a breath sample, which Butler did not consent to. I then read him implied consent and he still refused to provide a breath sample, with his refusal time marked at 0157 hrs. I read him his Miranda rights and he agreed to speak to me without an attorney present. He once again advised he was a 1 out of 10 on a self-reflection scale. I then placed him in a holding cell and finished my paperwork. I then booked him into the Palm Beach County jail for one count of DUI. BWC utilized.

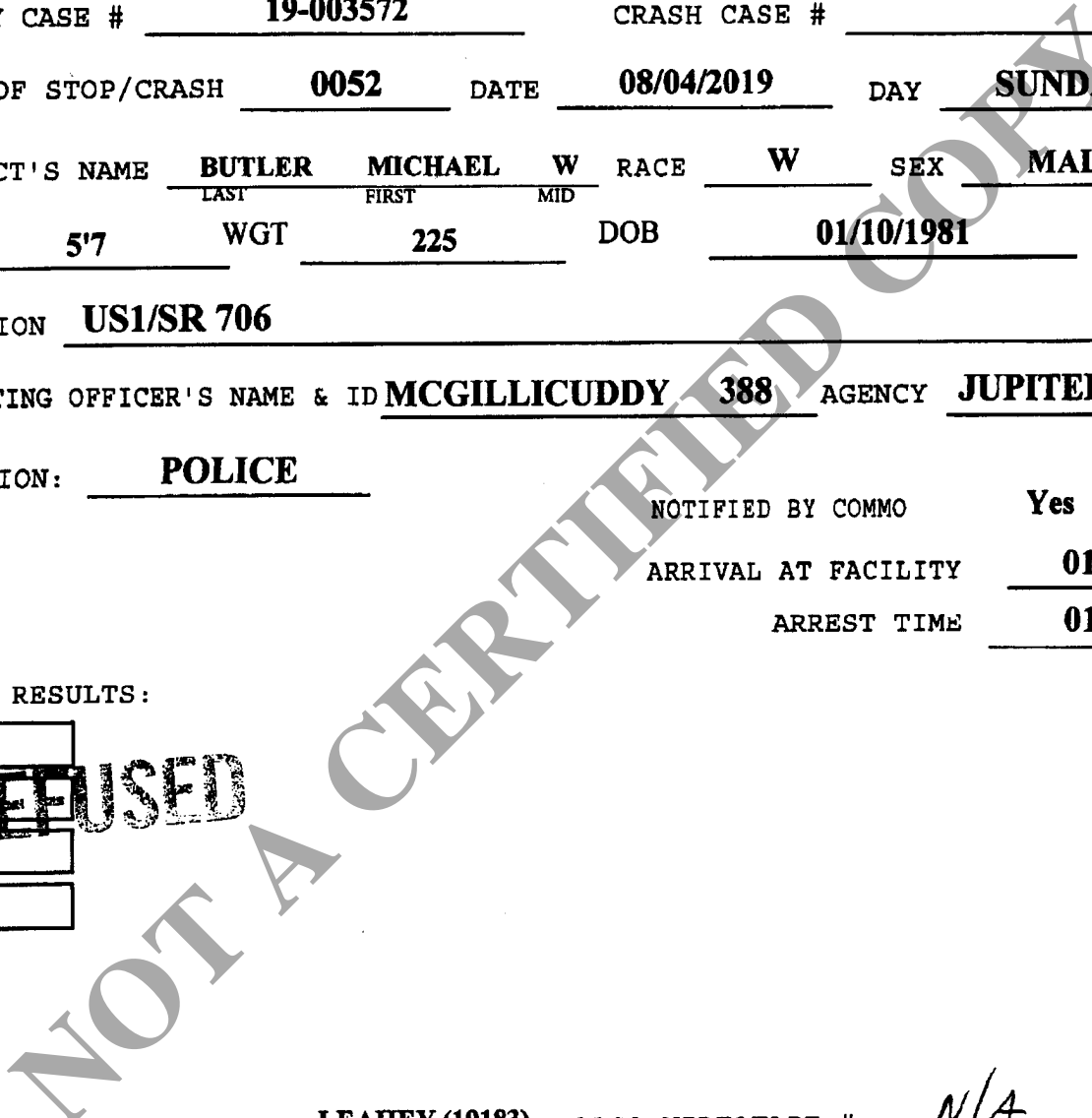
