The Person taken into custody... committed the below acts in my presence. was observed by who told that he/she saw the arrested person commit the below acts. confessed to admitting to the below facts. was found to have committed the below acts, resulting from my (described) investigation. On the 5 day of April 20 18 at 1500 P.M. (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT On Thursday April 5, 2018 while assigned to Palm Beach Central High School located at 8499 W. Forest Hill Blvd. Wellington, Fl. 33411 I, Police Officer Schnaderbeck did assist the School Administration with a Traffic Complaint. Details are as follows. At approximately 1455 hours, my Partner Officer Longo and myself received a radio transmission via school based radio, from Palm Beach Central High School Assistant Principal Nereyda Garcia to respond to the front of the school for a situation. Upon our arrival Mrs. Garcia stated that the vehicle that was stopped in front of the school was blocking traffic, and refusing to move. I did observe a grey Ford Escape stopped in front of the school approximately 30 feet into the traffic cones, making it not possible for any vehicles to go around him. I also observed the vehicles backed up in a long line going out to Forest Hill Blvd. This is the time of the day when we are dismissing all students and staff. I approached the vehicle and spoke to a man later identified to me as Mitchell Feller. I asked the male to move his vehicle up to the other side of the cones so we could maintain a flow of traffic. The male stated "No I am picking my daughter up and I am staying here"! I asked the male four more times to please move his vehicle forward so we could maintain a flow of traffic. The male continued to refuse my requests/commands, each time he was getting louder stating "I AM NOT MOVING I AM PICKING UP MY DAUGHTER"! I explained to the male that everyone is here to pick up their child, all he has to do is move up to the other side of the cones, because he was causing a major delay in the whole process. I asked the male again to move the vehicle up. I then saw the male put the vehicle in drive as if he was going to move forward, at that point I began to drive away on the golf cart. Less than a minute later Ofc. Longo and myself received another radio transmission from Mrs. Garcia that the car only moved up a little bit, and is still blocking traffic. Upon our arrival back to the front of the school, I observed that the male moved up approximately twenty feet still blocking our dismissal process, and not where I instructed him to move to. This time my partner Officer Longo spoke to the male. Continued on page 2

I observed Officer Longo ask the male to move his vehicle up due to him blocking traffic. I heard the male yell at Officer Longo stating "I AM NOT MOVING"! Officer Longo asked the male several more times to move his vehicle. each time the male became more hostile. For Officer Longo's safety I did walk over to him due to the male's aggressive demeanor. Officer Longo then asked the male to hand him his driver's license, vehicle registration, and insurance card. the male stated "FUCK YOU I DON'T HAVE ONE"! I then asked the male for his driver's license, vehicle registration, and insurance card. He again stated "FUCK YOU I DON'T HAVE ONE"! Officer Longo then gave the male a command to turn his vehicle off. The male stated "FUCK YOU"! I then observed the male put his vehicle in drive, jerk his steering wheel to the left, and speed off at a high rate of speed. When the male sped off due to him cutting his wheel to the left and the close proximity that Officer Longo and myself where to the vehicle, Officer Longo jumped out of the way, I was almost struck by the vehicle which also almost ran over my right foot. In a reactionary reflex I was forced to extend my arms and push myself off of the vehicle, if I had not reacted in a quick manner I do believe I would have been either struck by the vehicle or my foot would have been run over. I then got on the golf cart in an attempt to stop the male who was driving off at a high rate of speed through the parking lot where there were numerous students walking and other vehicles driving. The male did not obey pavement markings, he cut across marked parking spots, marked traffic lanes, and drove through a stop sign not even slowing down. Also cutting off other vehicles attempting to exit the parking lot, in an attempt to flee from Officer Longo and myself. The male put the students/pedestrians along with other drivers at risk of serious injury. Due to the reckless manner he was driving in an attempt to flee. I was unable to stop the male due to his high rate of speed, he did exit the campus on to Forest Hill Blvd heading westbound. I was able to obtain the License plate number (JNM C57) from his Grey Ford Escape which is an SUV. I did check the security cameras in the front of the school, none of the cameras cover that area of the school. The only one that does is a panning camera for the whole parking lot, this camera did not aid in this investigation.


Upon responding back to my office I did run the License plate number, along with a DAVID on the owner of the vehicle. The Owner of the vehicle was not the driver that I encountered based upon the DAVID check conducted. I was able to determine the student of the male who I encountered. The Palm Beach Central students name is Mercedes Lillie Anne Feller-Tremmel.

On Friday 4/6/18 I did interview student Feller-Tremmel who identified the male driving the vehicle yesterday was her father, Mitchell Feller.

I was also able to identify Mr. Feller through him coming into the school on 4/6/18 between 1446 to 1502 hours, to sign papers for the school. I was able to view video of him in the front office where he identified himself as Mitchell Feller. I was determined that without a doubt he was the male driving the vehicle on the day before.

I did obtain a verbal along with a Sworn/Affirmed Written Statement from Mrs. Garcia, who stated she heard car horns going off several times in front of the school. Mrs. Garcia states that when she went to the front of the school she was approached by a lady in front who informed Mrs. Garcia that there was an SUV parked in front of the school blocking her in, and refused to move as she was attempting to leave campus.

Mrs. Garcia then stated that she approached the vehicle and asked the male driver to move forward, but the male would not roll the window down nor would he move forward, despite her telling him several times verbally along with the use of hand signals. Mrs. Garcia stated that she knew the male heard her, she was right next to the SUV and his window was down a little bit and he saw her, she asked numerous times but the male refused to move. Mrs. Garcia then stated that she called for myself and Officer Longo to assist her. Mrs. Garcia stated that she observed me try to tell the driver of the SUV several times to move as he would not comply. Mrs. Garcia then stated that the driver finally began to move but only moved approximately 25 feet and was still blocking dismissal traffic flow and was in a no standing zone. Mrs. Garcia states that she then called for both of us to return, upon our arrival back at the scene she observed both of us continue to plead with the driver to move, but the driver continued to not comply. Mrs. Garcia stated that she heard us ask the driver for his license and registration, and also to turn the car off. Mrs. Garcia stated she heard the driver inform us he did not have a driver's license and proceeded to drive off very fast, as he was driving away she observed the driver brush off of me (Ofc. Schnaderbeck) with his car and that I had to push away from his car to avoid from getting hit. Mrs. Garcia stated that the driver speeded away from the parking lot and out of the school while there was several students and parents still exiting the campus walking and driving.

I did obtain a verbal along with a Sworn/Affirmed Written Statement from Patty Thomas who is the Adult Education Secretary, who stated she heard car horns going off several times in front of the school. Mrs. Thomas stated that when she went outside there were two grey SUV's in the no parking lane in front of the school. Mrs. Thomas stated that Mrs. Garcia came out behind her as she was walking towards the vehicles the lady in the back one came out and was very angry because she was stuck and the male in the forward vehicle was refusing to move. Mrs. Thomas then stated that Mrs. Garcia approached the lead vehicle and the man refused to roll down the window at that time so Mrs. Garcia called for School Police on the radio. Mrs. Thomas states that upon the arrival of Officer Longo and myself we asked the male to move the vehicle to which he refused. Mrs. Thomas then stated that after a while the male moved approximately two car lengths up enabling the one lady to move traffic cones and pull out, but he was still blocking the dismissal traffic. Mrs. Thomas stated that Mrs. Garcia called both of us back to the scene do to him blocking traffic. Mrs. Thomas stated that she observed that the male was getting heated as he continued to refuse to move, when suddenly he put his car in gear and attempted to go around me (Ofc Schnaderbeck) who had to push against the SUV to avoid being hit. Mrs. Thomas then stated that the male proceeded out of the lot at a high rate of speed. Mrs. Thomas through video of the front office on 4/6/18 between 1446 to 1502 hours, did positively identify Mitchell Feller as the male driving the vehicle on 4/5/18, along with confirming his name due to her talking with him on said date where he identified himself in the main office.

I did obtain a verbal along with a Sworn/Affirmed Written Statement from Palm Beach Central High School front desk secretary Lisandra Argudo that on 4/6/18 between 1446 to 1502 hours, the male in the video at the front desk is in fact Mitchell Feller who identified himself with a driver's license.

Based upon the investigation that I, Police Officer Schnaderbeck conducted, along with being a witness to the above listed incident the following actions are going to be performed. The following charges are to be filed with the State Attorney's office.

FLEEING OR ATTEMPTING TO ELUDE: Mitchell Feller did flee and attempt to elude Officer Longo and Officer Schnaderbeck. Feller had been ordered to stop when Officer Longo requested Feller to present driver's license, vehicle registration, and insurance card. After refusing to comply with Officer Longo's request by shouting, "FUCK YOU I DON'T HAVE ONE," Officer Schnaderbeck requested Feller to produce his (Feller's) driver's license, vehicle registration, and insurance card. Feller was ordered to turn the vehicle off by Officer Longo. Instead Feller shouted "FUCK YOU", put his vehicle in drive, jerked the steering wheel to the left, and sped off at a high rate of speed.


RESIST OFFICER WITHOUT VIOLENCE: Mitchell Feller did unlawfully resist, obstruct and oppose Police Officer Schnaderbeck, and Police Officer Longo a law enforcement officer of the Palm Beach County School District Police Department, in the execution of a legal process while in the lawful execution of a legal duty, without offering or doing violence to the person of such officer.

RECKLESS DRIVING: Mitchell Feller did drive a vehicle in willful and wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property. Feller did drive his vehicle at a high rate of speed through the parking lot of Palm Beach Central High School during dismissals, where there were numerous students walking, along with other vehicles driving who were picking up their children. Feller also almost struck the Police Officer's with his vehicle while Officer Long and Officer Schnaderbeck, was conducting a law traffic stop.
