PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On the aforementioned date at approximately 2359 hours, I responded to the parking lot of 75 E Indiantown Rd. (Concourse Plaza) at the request of MPO Banegas, who had made contact with a suspicious vehicle. At the time, I was driving an unmarked Jupiter Police Department patrol vehicle (vehicle 1916), I was wearing a JPD uniform clearly identifying myself as a Jupiter Police Officer, and I was wearing my department-issued Axon body camera. Upon arrival, MPO Banegas advised he observed a blue 2019 Nissan sedan bearing FL tag # GICW46 stopped, facing west, obstructing the through travel lane in the parking lot. He observed a male, later identified by his Arizona driver license to be Nicholas Lombardo (w/m; 06/24/1984), sitting in the driver seat, apparently passed out. MPO Banegas advised he walked around the vehicle to ensure the vehicle was in park and he noticed Lombardo was drooling in his lap. MPO Banegas advised he woke Lombardo and asked if he could open the door. Lombardo voluntarily rolled the window down and made contact with MPO Banegas. MPO Banegas advised me Lombardo had no idea where he was, had bloodshot/glassy eyes, slurred speech, and the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on his breath. See supplement from MPO Banegas.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

When I arrived, I observed one marked Jupiter Police Department patrol vehicle stopped behind Lombardo's vehicle and one marked Jupiter Police Department patrol vehicle stopped in front of Lombardo's vehicle, facing it. It should be noted that this is standard procedure when officers locate drivers asleep or passed out behind the wheel to ensure the person's safety if they suddenly wake and accelerate. Lombardo was sitting in the driver seat of the vehicle (which was turned off), with the front driver door open, and his seat belt fastened. I was standing approximately 30 feet from Lombardo's vehicle and I could smell the odor of alcohol wafting from his vehicle when the wind blew my direction. I approached the vehicle on the driver side and made contact with Lombardo. I immediately noted Lombardo's eyes were glassy and bloodshot and the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his breath, which intensified as he spoke. As Lombardo spoke, his speech was slurred. When I asked Lombardo to exit the vehicle, he complied and I noted he was swaying as he stood still.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Lombardo advised he had been scuba diving earlier in the day. He stated he ate dinner at Castaways (local bar in Jupiter) and would not advise how many alcoholic beverages he consumed. When asked to complete Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks (SFSTs), Lombardo immediately complied. SFSTs were conducted in the same parking lot Lombardo's vehicle was in, approximately 30 feet south of his vehicle.

ODORS:

Strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on Lombardo's breath which intensified as he spoke.

SPEECH: Slurred

ATTITUDE: Cooperative, Polite, Mood swings after arrest (angry to calm)

CLOTHING: Black t-shirt, Tan shorts, Gray deck shoes.

MEDICAL/OTHER: No medical conditions/medications.

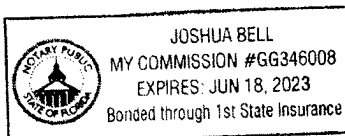

Other Observations:

I am a certified Drug Recognition Expert (IACP # 32395) and I conducted this task in accordance with my training. Lombardo did not display resting nystagmus and had pupils of equal approximate size. Lombardo was able to track a moving stimulus equally with both eyes. I observed all 6 clues of HGN during this task. Vertical Gaze Nystagmus was not present. During the administration of the task, Lombardo was swaying from side to side.

WALK & TURN:

During the Instructions Stage, Lombardo had to be reminded to stand in the starting position, as he took his front foot off the line and stood with his feet side by side. Lombardo advised he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. On the first part of the walk, Lombardo used his arms to balance on steps 2-9. Lombardo stepped off the line, to the right, on step 3. Lombardo took a total of 9 steps before turning. Lombardo turned improperly (to his left) by taking small steps with both his feet and counting out loud. On the return walk, Lombardo used his arms to balance on every step. Lombardo only took a total of 8 steps back down the line.

ONE LEG STAND:

Lombardo chose to raise his right leg off the ground, standing planted on his left. After a few seconds, Lombardo asked how long he was to continue the task for. I advised him to continue until told to stop and Lombardo complied. Lombardo placed his right foot on the ground on his count of 1014, swaying heavily before losing his balance. Lombardo had to be reminded to keep his eyes on his elevated foot. Lombardo counted 1011 and 1017 twice. Lombardo counted slowly and only reached a count of 1019 at the end of the timed 30 second period.

FINGER TO NOSE:

Prior to the administration of this task, Lombardo demonstrated knowledge of his left and right arms. The cadence for this task was: Left, Right, Left, Right, Right, Left. On the first call of left, Lombardo touched the tip of his left finger under his septum, touching his upper lip, did not return his arm to his side, and opened his eyes. On the first call of right, Lombardo appropriately touched finger to nose but did not return his arm to his side and opened his eyes. On the final call of left, Lombardo touched the tip of his left finger to his septum just above his upper lip. For all other calls not mentioned in this paragraph, Lombardo appropriately touched finger-to-nose.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Lombardo advised he was comfortable reciting the alphabet from A to Z. Lombardo swayed throughout the duration of the task and appropriately recited the entire alphabet.

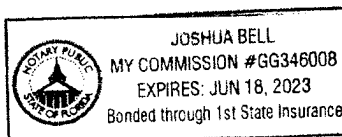

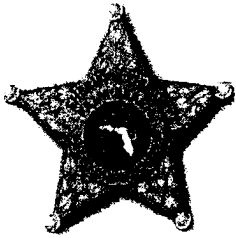
