PROBABLE CAUSE

On July 16th, 2017 I Trooper Lucas M. Tavares (3913/1555) with the Florida Highway Patrol was on active patrol in Palm Beach County, Florida. I was in a marked FHP unit equipped with overhead emergency lights and external siren. At approximately 03:24 a.m. I was traveling northbound on Interstate 95 from Lantana Road. I was in the process of intercepting an unrelated reckless driver traveling northbound on Interstate 95. While attempting to locate this vehicle, I observed a red in pick-up truck traveling northbound on Interstate 95, just south of 10th Avenue North. The vehicle was traveling at a very high rate of speed. I then sped up to intercept the vehicle. I the visually estimated the vehicle to be traveling at 110 miles per hour. I then activated my issued Stalker dual radar, front antenna (STALKER DUAL S/N: DC090655 / ANT:054406). I then got a readout of 110 miles per hour and an audio Doppler sound consistent with the speed of the vehicle.

I then activated my overhead emergency lights and activated my siren, in attempt to initiate a traffic stop upon the vehicle. The vehicle then slowed its speed and pulled over onto the right shoulder. I then approached the driver's side of the vehicle to make contact with the driver of the vehicle.

Suspect vehicle: 2007 Toyota Tundra, Red in Color, with Florida Tag: (RKS673) attached.

I then made contact with the driver who I later identified him to be Nicolas Bogado by his Florida's Drivers License: (B232620793850) and by his Paraguay Passport. I then requested Mr. Bogado's License. He then stated that he did not have one. He stated that it expired. While talking to Mr. Bogado I could detect a odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from within the vehicle. Mr. Bogado's speech was slurred and his eyes were bloodshot and watery. I then requested Mr. Bogado to step out of the vehicle.

While talking to Mr. Bogado, while outside his vehicle, I could detect an unknown alcoholic beverage on Mr. Bogado's breath that grew stronger as he spoke. Mr. Bogado had a slight sway while standing. Mr. Bogado's answers to my questions were not consistent.

Based upon my observations of Mr. Bogado, I then requested that he perform field sobriety exercises. Mr. Bogado stated that he would perform the exercise.

Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE):

The area for the following roadside exercises was level hard surface and was free of debris. The weather was clear.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

I advised the subject to stand straight with their feet together and arms down by their side. I asked subject if they wear any glasses or contacts, they advised they do not. For the exercise I used my issued red pen light and illuminated it with a Streamlight white in color flash light. I asked the subject if they could see the red pen light, they stated yes. The subject was asked about any current medical conditions, they stated that they did not have. I advised the subject to follow the red pen light with their eyes and eyes only, and to not move their head. I asked subject if they understood the instructions I gave to them. They stated yes. I asked if they had any questions they stated no.

While performing the exercise, the subject was moving his head (not as instructed).

The following was observed during Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

The subject did have resting Nystagmus and dilated pupils.

- LT EYE-LACK OF SMOOTH PURSUIT

The following was observed during Vertical Gaze Nystagmus:

Subject did not have Vertical Gaze Nystagmus

The following was observed during Lack of Convergence:

Subject could not follow the stimulus. Subject's both eyes did converge onto the stimulus.

Walk and Turn Exercise:

Interaction Phase:

The area for the following roadside exercises was level and free of debris. Subject agreed to use an imaginary straight line to perform the walk and turn. I advised the subject to place their left foot on the imaginary line and their right foot directly in front of it, touching heel to toe. I advised the subject to keep their arms down by their side and to stay in that position until I advise them to begin the exercise. This exercise was first explained to the subject then was demonstrated by myself. Subject advised that they would be able to perform the exercise. Subject advised that they had no injuries that would affect the exercise. Subject advised me that they understood instructions and did not have any questions.

- The following was observed during the instructional phase of the exercise:

The subject could not keep balance while in the starting position. Subject kept stepping out of the starting position. I had to repeat the instructions multiple times to the subject.

- The following was observed during the walking phase of the exercise:

The subject missed heel to toe on multiple steps. The subject performed an improper turn (not as instructed). Subject stopped after the turn. Subject lost balance.

One Leg Stand Exercise:

I instructed the subject to stand with their feet together and keep their arms down by his side. I instructed the subject to stay in that position until I tell them to start the exercise. This exercise was first explained to the subject then was demonstrated by myself. Subject advised that they will be able to perform the exercise. Subject advised me that they had no injuries that would affect the exercise. Subject advised that they understood instructions and did not have any questions.

Subject was swaying in the starting position. Subject put his foot down multiple times. Subject miscounted multiple times.

Finger to Nose:

I instructed the subject to stand with his feet together and his hands down by his side. I then explained the exercise to the subject then demonstrated it. Subject stated that he understood the directions.

Subject was swaying during the exercise. Subject missed to touch the tip of his nose one time.

Based on the totality of circumstances, Mr. Bogado was placed under arrest for DUI pursuant to Florida Statute 316.193.1 at 03:43 AM. Mr. Bogado was then searched and placed in Tpr. Todd's (1729) patrol vehicle and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail in which he arrived at 04:20 AM. After the defendant's 20min observation, the defendant was then given the opportunity to provide a sample of his breath which he did not consent to provide. I then read the implied consent warning to Mr. Bogado, in which he again refused.

Mr. Bogado was also issued two uniform traffic citations for speed pursuant to Florida Statute: 316.187(2)(c) and for operating a vehicle while driver's license canceled under Florida Statute 322.34(2)(a).

Video of the traffic stop, roadsides and transport are available through the FHP custodian. The above incident did occur in Palm Beach County, Florida.

Additionally, if you refuse to submit to the test I have requested of you and if your driving privilege has been previously suspended for a prior refusal to submit to a lawful test of your breath, urine or blood, you will be committing a misdemeanor. Refusal to submit to the test I have requested of you is admissible into evidence in any criminal proceeding.
