<p>On 08/05/2017 I observed a 2006 gray Volkswagen bearing FL tag#HBGR68 going southbound from Jeffery St and N Federal Hwy driving at a high rate of speed. When the vehicle got to N Federal Hwy and E Yamato Rd, the vehicle made a right turn on a red-light without slowing or coming to a complete stop. I conducted a traffic stop at 351 W Yamato RD and met with driver Nicole Mcclay and front seat passenger Steven Locigno and advised them the reason for the stop. I then asked Mcclay for her driver's license, proof of insurance and registration which she was able to provide. I then asked Locigno for his identification which he was unable to provide any identification. While Locigno was looking for his identification card a yellow plastic bag fell out of the bag that he was looking through. I observed in plain view a bag of marijuana inside the yellow bag. I retrieved the marijuana and Ofc Pare arrived on scene as my backup.</p> <p>I then asked Mcclay to exit the vehicle and asked her where they were coming from and she stated a friend's house. I asked her if there was anything else in the vehicle that I needed to know about because I was going to search the vehicle due to marijuana being inside the vehicle. Mcclay stated that there was Adderall inside the vehicle that belonged to a friend of hers. Mcclay stated that the Adderall had been in her car and she had been trying to return them to her friend for a couple of days but was unsuccessful. Mcclay stated that the pills were in a JUUL box inside the car. I then had Locigno exit the vehicle and searched his person and nothing was located on his person.</p> <p>I then searched the vehicle and located 5 Adderall pills inside of the JUUL box which was inside the center console. Nothing further was located. I then field tested the marijuana with a Quick Check Marijuana test kit (one use only). The field test was positive for THC by turning purple. I then called Poison Control and spoke with Mike Hasyn ID#106190 case#M3566480 and he verified that the pills were Amphetamine Salts generic for Adderall a schedule II narcotic. <p>Constitutional Warnings in the presence of Ofc Pare. They both advised that they understood and would answer my questions without an attorney present.</p> <p>I spoke with Locigno who advised that the marijuana belonged to a friend that put it in his belongings for safe keeping but never retrieved the marijuana. Locigno knew that the friend was placing the marijuana in his bag to hold onto so no one would mess with it. Locigno thought that his friend took the marijuana back and forgot that it was in his possession.</p> <p>I then spoke with Mcclay who stated that the pills belonged to a friend and she was holding onto to them. Mcclay advised that she was trying to return them to her friend for the past couple of days but was unable to give them back to her friend. Mcclay advised that she had no valid prescription for the pills. I gave Mcclay the opportunity to have her friend come to the scene and claim ownership of the pills. I gave her over fifteen minutes to get a hold of her friend but her attempts were unsuccessful.</p> <p>Based on the above information I placed Locigno into custody for possession of marijuana and Mcclay for possession of Adderall. Locigno was issued an NTA and released from the scene. I then transported Mcclay to BRPD to be processed.</p> <p>Steven Locigno is being charged under F.S.S 893.13(6b) for possession of 1.8 grams of marijuana. Nicole Mcclay is being charged under F.S.S 893.13(6a) for possession of 1.8 grams of Adderall a schedule II narcotic. I also issued Mcclay a citation for the red-light infraction. The marijuana and the Adderall were placed into evidence at BRPD and the vehicle was towed to Emerald.</p>
