PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 03Feb18 0240hrs I arrived at the intersection of Palmetto Park Rd and State Rd 7 (US 441), Boca Raton, in unincorporated Palm Beach County in reference to a person passed out at the wheel.

Upon arrival I observed a white Chevy Silverado (FL tag RQN2U) stopped facing westbound on Palmetto Park Rd at the intersection. I stopped my marked patrol vehicle behind the vehicle and activated my emergency lights. As I approached the vehicle I could hear the vehicle running. In the driver's seat was a white male with no shirt on. He was slumped over forward between the driver's door and steering wheel. The vehicle was in drive and his foot was lightly on the accelerator. All the doors were locked and windows were closed. D/S McDonough arrived on scene as a backup deputy. He positioned his vehicle in front of the Silverado to prevent it rolling into traffic and possible causing a traffic crash. Both of us banged and knocked on the windows and were unable to get a reaction out of the driver. I then activated the air horn from my patrol vehicle for approximately 15 seconds and still was unable to get a reaction from the driver. We then again attempted to bang and knock on the windows and still was unable to get a reaction from the driver. It appeared the driver may be suffer from a possible emergency medical condition. Based on this I made the decision to break the passenger's side rear window in order to get aid to the driver. Sgt. R. Ugalde was notified prior to breaking the window. I still did not get a reaction out of the driver when I broke the window. I was able to unlock the passenger's side rear door and then unlock the passenger's side front door. D/S McDonough entered the passenger's side front door, placed the vehicle in park, and turned off the ignition. During this time we still did not get a reaction out of the driver. I then went to the driver's side door and opened it. The driver began to fall out of the vehicle and woke up in the process.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

As he woke up he appeared to very confused and dazed. He had line marks on his face from leaning against the steering wheel. His speech was mumbled and raspy. His eyes were watery, red, and his pupils were dilated. He had no shirt on. His pants were wet and disorderly. He had a green paper wristband on his arm. Palm Beach County Fire Rescue arrived on scene and evaluated the driver. The identified himself verbally as Noah Appleman; this was verified through the Driver and Vehicle Information Database (DAVID). He told me he had "Whompers". He couldn't explain to me what he meant by it. He said he was on "Indiantown Rd". I asked if he had his driver's license and he stated it was at his home just down the road. He told me Silverado belonged to a friend. He became very excited and was very talkative. He was constantly interrupting me. He had difficulty following directions from the deputies and paramedics at the scene. As he exited the vehicle I could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his breath.

After he was evaluated by Palm Beach County Fire Rescue I asked him for his driver's license. He began to fumble around the driver's side interior door panel. He then reached into the center console and began fumble through papers and throwing them around the front of the vehicle. He retrieved an empty envelope and attempted to hand it to me.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

He stated several times that he was either on Indiantown Rd or Pratt Whitney.

ODORS:

The odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his breath.

SPEECH: mumbled, raspy, excessive spitting, confusing speech

ATTITUDE: mood changes, emotional (crying), confused, paranoia, talkative, excited, cocky, tense, restless

Other Observations:

He had difficulty following instructions and was constantly interrupting. He had to move his feet apart for balance and his body swayed. His eyes were watery, red, and pupils were dilated. He kept trying to use his peripheral vision to follow the stylus. He had Vertical Gaze Nystagmus (VGN) in both eyes but did not have Lack Of Convergence (LOC).

WALK & TURN:

I instructed and demonstrated the walk and turn. He interrupted the instructions constantly but eventually acknowledged he understood. He could not stand as instructed and stepped off the line. He raised his arms from his side for balance. He took one step prior to the start of the task. He walked 9 steps forward. He failed to maintain heel to toe on several steps and lifted his arms from his side for balance. He turned incorrectly (spun). He walked 14 steps back lifting his arms from his side for balance. He failed to maintain heel to toe on several steps and stepped off the line several times. The task was completed on a lightly wet and level surface using a white painted line.

ONE LEG STAND:

I instructed and demonstrated the one leg stand. He interrupted the instructions constantly but eventually acknowledged he understood. He also attempted to assume the directions and preform the task prior to the instructions. He lifted his left foot off the ground approximately 2 feet. He hopped on his right foot. At first he hopped in place then he hopped approximately 20 ft forward. He lifted his arms from his side to maintain balance. The task was completed on a lightly wet and level surface.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I instructed and demonstrated the finger to nose. He interrupted the instructions constantly but eventually acknowledged he understood. He mimicked my movements as I demonstrated the task. On the first command I had to remind him to place his hand back down at his side. On each command he either touched the bottom of his nose or the bridge of his nose. His body swayed during the task. The task was completed on a lightly wet and level surface.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

He told me he had approximately 2 years of college and English was his primary language. He acknowledged he understood the instructions. His body swayed during the task. The Task was complete on a lightly wet and level surface.

He acknowledged he could estimate 30 seconds. His estimate of 30 seconds was approximately 50 seconds. His body swayed during the task. When he counted, several numbers were skipped or repeated. The task was completed on a lightly wet and level surface.
