On 12/25/2019 at approximately 6:07PM I responded to a report of an alleged hit and run incident that had occurred on Interstate 95 near PGA Boulevard. I was informed by the Lake Worth Regional Communication (LWRCC) or Dispatch that the victim had followed the hit and run vehicle which was a white Ford pickup truck with an attached Florida tag of Z21AJC that had a piece of the front bumper falling off. It was later determined that the victim was driving a blue Volvo XC-60 with an attached Florida tag of GMVI45. The victim was identified by her Florida drivers license as Christine Cervantes (FL DL: C615100757690). Mrs. Cervantes observed the hit and run vehicle take the Indiantown exit and pull into the McDonald's drive through (Address: 6760 W Indiantown Road, Jupiter, FL 33458). Mrs. Cervantes advised Dispatch that she was waiting in the parking lot of the Shell gas station next to the McDonald's. A short time later I was informed by Dispatch that the Jupiter Police Department had initiated a traffic stop on the alleged hit and run vehicle. I traveled to Indiantown Road and 67th Road North and observed two Jupiter police vehicles with lights activated behind a white Ford pickup truck that had damage to the right front of the vehicle near the KFC parking lot (6700 W Indiantown Road, Jupiter, FL 33458). The damage to the front right of the white Ford pickup truck was consistent with a vehicle collision. I positioned my vehicle behind the marked Jupiter police vehicles and observed that they were speaking to a white male standing near the rear of the white Ford pickup truck which had an attached Florida tag of Z21AJC. The white male appeared to be supporting himself against the rear of the vehicle. This white Ford pickup truck matched the description and Florida tag of the hit and run vehicle described by Mrs. Cervantes. The white male who was driving the white Ford pickup truck was later identified by his Florida drivers license as Paul Egan Shipe (FL DL: S100685711250). I later spoke to Officer Branden Zesut #312 who had performed the traffic stop on the white Ford pickup truck and he informed me that the vehicle was slow to stop and pull over upon initiation of the traffic stop and the driver was possibly impaired. Officer Zesut later provided a sworn witness statement that stated he observed Mr. Shipe stumble out of the pickup truck and appeared to be intoxicated noting that his eyes bloodshot and glassy and he smelled like an unknown alcoholic beverage. Trooper Mark McDonough (#903) traveled to my location and conducted the hit and run investigation. Mrs. Cervantes later provided a sworn witness statement documenting what she had observed. Prior to speaking with Mr. Shipe I patted him down for any weapons for officer safety considerations and had him stand in front of Trooper McDonough's marked patrol vehicle. At times Mr. Shipe appeared to be unsteady on his feet. I observed that Mr. Shipe had red and glassy eyes and had the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his breath as he spoke. At times Mr. Shipe appeared to have difficulty thinking

and remembering what had happened. I later informed Mr. Shipe that the crash investigation had ended and I was beginning a criminal investigation for DUI. I read him his Miranda Rights from a Florida Highway Patrol Miranda warning printout. He stated that he understood his rights and did not wish to answer any questions. I then asked him to perform standardized field sobriety exercises and he refused to do them. I then gave Mr. Shipe a Taylor warning and informed him that his refusal to do the exercises could be used against him and that I would have to make a decision based upon all the observations I have made up till that point in time. He stated that he still refused to perform the exercises. Based upon the above information and the totality of the circumstances I determined that there was probable cause to believe that Paul Egan Shipe committed the offense of driving under the influence by being in actual physical control/operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic beverages, any chemical substance per Florida State Statute 877.111, or any controlled substance per Chapter 893, while their normal faculties were impaired. Mr. Shipe was placed under arrest for the above offense and handcuffed behind his back. During the course of Trooper Mcdonough's crash investigation he determined that there was probable cause to believe that Mr. Shipe committed the offense of hit and run as outlined in Florida State Statute 316.061 by driving the white Ford pickup truck and striking the blue Volvo driven by Mrs. Cervantes and failing to remain at the scene and fulfill the requirements of Statute 316.062. After being searched he was placed in the backseat of my marked patrol vehicle. After placing Mr. Shipe in the backseat of my vehicle I smelled the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the backseat that was not present prior to placing him there. Mr. Shipe was later transported to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing (BAT) facility. At the BAT facility a 20 minute observation period was conducted where he did not ingest anything by mouth or regurgitate (mouth was confirmed to be empty prior to beginning of the observation period). He was then asked to provide a breath test sample to test for the alcoholic content of his breath. He initially agreed to provide the breath test sample and then later refused to provide the breath test sample. He was then read the Florida Implied Consent drivers license suspension warning and he still refused to provide a breath test sample repeatedly asking to speak with a lawyer. A refusal time of 7:40PM was notated. The Constitutional Warning and Question and Answer document was not read due to Mr. Shipe's uncooperative behavior. Mr. Shipe was then placed in a holding cell and the handcuffs were later removed. After I finished my rough arrest report he was taken from the holding cell and handcuffed behind his back again and transported to Wellington Regional Medical center for a medical clearance. He was then transported back to the Palm Beach County Jail and booked without further incident. Mr. Shipe was issued a DUI citation and a uniform traffic citation for DUI resulting in property damage. Trooper Mcdonough issued Mr. Shipe uniform traffic citations for leaving the scene, careless driving, failing to exhibit valid insurance at a crash, failing to exhibit valid drivers license at a crash and failing to exhibit a valid registration at a crash. All of the above events occurred in Palm Beach County, FL.



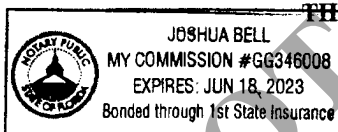
