On the 12 day of June, 2018 at 02:23 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On the above date at approximately 0223 hours, I was on routine patrol in the area of West Indiantown Road and Loxahatchee Drive in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, Florida.

I observed a blue 2017 Chevrolet pickup bearing Florida license plate RLH750 traveling west in front of me. I saw the vehicle appear to drift within its lane and changed lanes to get behind it to confirm from a better angle. The vehicle was at first traveling at approximately 40 miles per hour. As it traveled west, the truck drifted within its lane. The vehicle sloppily changed lanes to the middle lane and the changed lanes back to the right hand through lane as it traveled. It did not affect other traffic. The vehicle then continued to drift to either side of its lane. The vehicle sped up to over 50 miles per hour (45 mile per hour posted zone) As the vehicle approached Palm Road, the vehicle drove over the solid white line separating the bicycle lane from the roadway before drifting back into its own lane. I then initiated a traffic stop of the vehicle. The vehicle entered the right turn lane for North Central Boulevard. The vehicle continued to the intersection and stopped completely over the marked stop bar and crosswalk. After sitting for several seconds, the vehicle turned right onto North Central Boulevard. I then activated my siren. The vehicle turned into the parking lot for 6415 West Indiantown Road, making a wide right turn to do so.

I walked up to the vehicle and made contact with the sole occupant, Paul Hiner. Hiner was smoking a cigarette. I asked him to put it out. Hiner first knocked the ash off the end then reached inside his car towards the middle and staring for a moment. Hiner then told me that there was no place to put the cigarette. Hiner had bloodshot, glassy eyes. I could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on Hiner's breath. Hiner was slow to follow directions. Hiner's movements were uncoordinated. I noticed that Hiner had slurred speech. Hiner's facial features were generally droopy.

I asked Hiner where he was coming from. Hiner stated that he was, "going home". I repeated myself, and so did Hiner, two more times. Hiner then stated he was coming from his girlfriend's house. I later confirmed that Hiner still lives on Chasewood Drive, which would have required Hiner to make a left hand turn at the intersection with Central Boulevard, rather than a right. Hiner was in the right hand lane when I activated my lights. Hiner denied drinking anything at all. Hiner stated he has taken no medicines or drugs and has no medical conditions. I asked for Hiner's registration and insurance. Hiner indicated that the documents were in his glove box. I could see Hiner's vehicle registration in the wallet Hiner had been holding open.

I set up a place directly behind Hiner's vehicle to complete Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks. I used tape to create a line. I then had Hiner exit his vehicle. Hiner hesitated and asked, "why?". I told Hiner, "Because I am asking you to". Hiner opened his door. As he exited the vehicle, Hiner dropped a piece of paper which I later found to be a receipt for 1 Titos from Sunset Cigar Lounge on 6/11/18 at 1147 pm. Hiner stumbled towards me as he exited his vehicle.

I had Hiner stand at the rear of his vehicle. Hiner refused to say where he was coming from and told me he hadn't told me where he was coming from. Hiner stated again he was going home. I asked Hiner to complete SFSTs. Hiner refused. I advised Hiner of his Taylor Warnings. Hiner became intransigent, refusing to acknowledge the warnings or otherwise converse, saying, "no" several times. Hiner's speech remained slurred and he was generally unsteady on his feet. I attempted to speak to Hiner in order to provide him with the opportunity to dispel my mounting suspicions. Hiner would not complete roadsides.

Based on my investigation and observations of Hiner, I found probable cause to arrest Hiner for DUI. I told Hiner to turn around and place his hands behind his back. Hiner complied. I secured Hiner in handcuffs which I checked for spacing and double locked. I conducted a search of Hiner's person. I located another receipt from Sunset Cigar Lounge showing the purchase of 1 Titos at 1221 hours on 6/12/18. Between Hiner's pockets and the front seat area of his vehicle, I later found another receipt from 1255 hours on 6/12/18. It showed a purchase of 1 Captain Morgan and 1 Titos. I also located two receipts from Double Roads Tavern at 1021 pm on 6/11 and 1103 pm on 6/11 for \$18.00 and \$11.68, respectively. I also located receipts from Grandes Bella Cucina on 6/11/18 at 1937 hours and two from Double Roads Tavern on 6/11/18 at 2221 and 2303 hours, but none of these were itemized. I later placed all receipts into Jupiter Police Evidence for future use in this case.

I transported Hiner to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing Facility. I conducted a 20 minute observation period. During this time, Hiner spoke to another arrestee and PBSO deputies but refused to speak to me or answer any routine booking questions. I then took Hiner to the Breath Alcohol Testing Room and asked basic booking

questions. Hiner shook his head negatively and refused to speak when I asked him those questions. Hiner refused to provide a sample of his breath, again shaking his head. I read Implied Consent. Hiner began to look away and at the ceiling and refused to speak to me, indicating by shaking his head that he did not understand. Hiner refused to engage me in conversation or attempt to understand Implied Consent. I told Hiner that I would have to take his behavior as a refusal. Hiner continued to refuse to speak. I took the refusal at 0337 hours. I then read Hiner his Miranda Rights but did not attempt to ask Hiner any questions as he was clearly refusing to answer anything.

I then secured Hiner in a holding cell while I completed my paperwork. I then booked Hiner into the Palm Beach County Jail where I charged him with DUI per FSS 316.193(1).
