PROBABLE CAUSE

On the above date and time, I was stationary on westbound State Road 806 (Atlantic Blvd), in the Dunkin Dounuts parking lot. I observed a dark colored truck traveling at what appeared to be a high rate of speed westbound. When the dark colored truck passed my location, I observed two occupants, a white male driver and a white female passenger. I then began to travel westbound in an attempt to catch up with the dark colored truck. As I traveled westbound, I observed the dark truck come to a controlled stop halfway in a parking spot off the roadway, and partially blocking the outside westbound travel lane. I also observed a white female exit the truck from the passenger side of the truck, and appeared distressed. I then observed the driver door open and saw a white male driver exit the truck. I then activated my emergency lights to initiate a traffic stop to see why the truck was partially blocking the roadway, and a welfare check on the occupants.

Once out of my patrol vehicle. The male driver, who was later identified by his Florida Driver's license number P-452-698-88-406-0 as PAUL THOMAS PALANZA. Mr. Palanza was yelling to his girlfriend advising that she was driving. The female passenger then approached me and advised me that she is calling an Uber. When I asked the female passenger why, she advised that Mr. Palanza has had too much to drink. I then asked Mr. Palanza why he parked the truck partially in the road way. Mr. Palanza advised me that he and his girlfriend (passenger) were arguing when she advised him to stop the truck so she can get out. While speaking to Mr. Palanza, he was observed to have red glassy eyes, slurred speech, and an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth and breathe area. I then asked Mr. Palanza how many alcoholic beverages he consumed before driving. Mr. Palanza advised me that he had three (3) Jack and cokes.

When asked, Mr. Palanza agreed to submit to a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's).

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Exercise

Prior to beginning the exercise it was determined Mr. Palanza was not wearing contacts. Mr. Palanza's eyes were checked and his eyes displayed equal tracking and his pupils were equal sizes. Mr. Palanza was instructed to following the stimulus with his eyes only, keeping his head still. After stating he understood the instructions Mr. Palanza attempted this exercise.

The results of this exercise displayed 6 of the 6 possible clues.

- A lack of Smooth Pursuit in his left eye.
 - A lack of Smooth Pursuit in his right eye.
 - A distinct and sustained nystagmus in the left eye at maximum deviation.
 - A distinct and sustained nystagmus in the right eye at maximum deviation.
 - An onset of nystagmus in the left eye prior to 45 degrees.
 - An onset of nystagmus in the right eye prior to 45 degrees.
- The exercise further revealed the presence of vertical nystagmus. Vertical nystagmus is an indicator of high doses of alcohol, other central nervous system (CNS) depressants or inhalants, and the consumption of the drug phencyclidine (PCP).

While performing the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise, it was observed that Mr. Palanza:

- Had difficulty following and responding to instructions.
- Moved his head from side to side during the exercise.
- Swayed while standing.
- The instructions for the exercise had to be repeated before Mr. Palanza would respond

Walk and Turn exercise

Prior to attempting this exercise, Mr. Palanza indicated he did not have any medical problems that would have prevented him from performing the exercise. Mr. Palanza was instructed to put his left foot on the line and his right foot in front of it with his right heel touching the toe of his left foot. He was instructed to stand in this manner with his hands to his sides until the exercise instructions were completed and the exercise demonstrated. Mr. Palanza was instructed not to begin the exercise until told to start. He was instructed to take nine steps along the line in a heel-to-toe manner. After the ninth step he was to stop and turn around keeping his lead foot on the ground, taking several small steps with the other foot to turn around. After turning around he was to take nine steps in a heel-to-toe manner back along the line, in the direction he had come from. Mr. Palanza was further instructed to watch his feet at all times while walking, keep his arms down to his side, and to count his steps out loud. After the exercise was demonstrated Mr. Palanza stated he understood the instructions and was instructed to begin the exercise.

- After attempting the Walk and Turn exercise M.r Palanza displayed 7 of 8 possible clues.

Walk and Turn exercise observations:

- On the first set of steps Mr. Palanza failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 9 steps, failing to walk heel-to-toe on steps 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9. Mr. Palanza then stepped off the line on 5 steps, stepping off the line on steps 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8.

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1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9. I

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- On the second set of steps Mr. Palanza failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 9 steps, failing to walk heel-to-toe on steps 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9. Mr. Palanza then stepped off the line on 4 steps, stepping off the line on steps 3, 4, 5, and 6.
- Was unable to stand in a heel-to-toe manner while the instructions to the exercise were given.
- Raised arms for balance during the exercise.
- Lost his balance while walking.
- Turned incorrectly.
- Failed to count his steps out loud.
- Took the incorrect number of steps on the first set of 9 steps (up). Took 10
- Took the incorrect number of steps on the second set of 9 steps (back) Took 10
- Started the exercise before instructed to.

One Leg Stand exercise

Prior to attempting this exercise, Mr. Palanza indicated he did not have any medical problems that would have prevented him from performing the exercise. Mr. Palanza was instructed to stand with his heels together and hands down to his sides while the instructions were given and during the exercise. Mr. Palanza was instructed not to begin the exercise until he was instructed to start, and after the exercise had been demonstrated. When instructed to start, he was to raise the foot of his choice off the ground approximately 6 inches. While his leg was raised he was to keep his leg straight, watch his raised foot, and to count out loud by thousands (one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three...) and to continue the exercise until told to stop (30 seconds). After this exercise was demonstrated and indicating he understood the instructions Mr. Palanza attempted this exercise.

When Mr. Palanza attempted this exercise he raised his right foot.

The result of this exercise displayed 4 of the 4 possible clues.

- During this exercise Mr. Palanza:
- Swayed during the exercise.
 - Used arms for balance.
 - Hopped during the exercise
 - Put his foot down (4 time(s) during the exercise).

Additionally, during the One Leg Stand exercise, Mr. Palanza was observed to:

- Fail to watch his raised foot during the exercise as instructed.
- Fail to keep his raised leg straight.

After I completed the Standardize Field Sobriety Exercise observations on Mr. Palanza, I then placed Mr. Palanza under arrest for suspected driving under the influence (DUI) of alcohol. I then placed Mr. Palanza in the rear of my patrol vehicle, and secured him in. Shortly after, I departed the scene enroute to the Palm Beach County Jail. Upon arrival at the jail, I escorted Mr. Palanza to the BAT center. There, I conducted a 20 minute observation period of Mr. Palanza. Once the 20 minutes were up, I escorted Mr. Palanza into the BAT room. Once there, I requested Mr. Palanza to submit to a lawful test of his breath for the purpose of determining its alcohol content. Mr. Palanza refused to submit at 2:09AM.

After, Mr. Palanza refused, I then advised Mr. Palanza of Implied Consent. After advising Mr. Palanza of Implied Consent, Mr. Palanza advised me he would continue to refuse to provide a breathe sample. I then advised Mr. Palanza of his Constitutional rights. After doing so, Mr. Palanza understood his rights and advised that he would refuse any further questioning. I then transported Mr. Palanza to booking into the Palm Beach County Jail. Shortly after, Mr. Palanza was booked into the Palm Beach County jail on 316.193.1 Florida Statue Misdemeanor DUI. All events occurred in Palm Beach County.

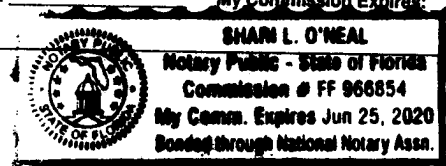

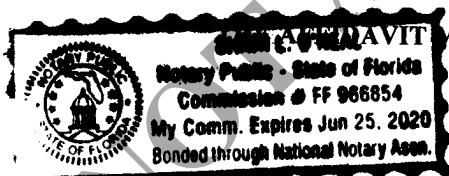
