Upon arrival, I met with the reporter/ neighbor of the parties involved, Flavia Pelaez.</p> <p>Flavia stated that she lives in apartment #331, one unit to the left of #334, and was inside when she felt the walls begin to shake from what sounded like loud pounding from the unit next door. Flavia also said that she heard a male yelling and cursing at the girlfriend. As the yelling and cursing continued, Flavia stated that she could also hear the girlfriend yelling for help as well as a baby crying aloud. Flavia decided to intervene with the help of her boyfriend and knocked on apt #331. She said that Nicole Andrade answered the door, pleading for help, stating that "he was inside, to get him, that he was hitting her, and to call for help". Flavia called 911 to report the incident and waited with Nicole and her infant son, Liam Vega, until the police arrived. It was at that time that she stated Paulo Vega, left the apartment and departed in his vehicle. Flavia also stated that this is not the first time a Domestic issue has occurred in that apartment. She provided a sworn written statement and agreed to testify in court if needed. Flavia acknowledged that she never saw what happened inside the apartment, but can only attest to what she heard.</p> <p>I next spoke with the victim, Nicole Andrade. Nicole was crying and visibly scared at the time of my interview. Her hair appeared to be messy and in disarray, but no visible injuries to her face could be seen. Nicole stated that at approximately 0900 hours, she, her boyfriend Paulo, and their son Liam, began to get ready to head out to a local restaurant to watch a FIFA soccer game. Nicole stated that Paulo told her that he wanted to smoke some marijuana before leaving the apartment. It was when he couldn't find his usual stash that he became agitated, accusing Nicole of purposely hiding it from him. She told him that she didn't have it, nor did she know where it was. Stating that this wasn't the first time Paulo became aggressive after misplacing his weed, she decided to</p>


lock herself and her son in the bedroom. Moments later, Paulo pushed in the door hard enough to defeat the lock. Paulo rushed inside and continued yelling at Nicole. Nicole grabbed her phone to call Paulo's mother to let her know how he was acting. Upset at Nicole for calling his mother, she said that while she was lying down on the mattress, Paulo grabbed her by the hair, pulled her off of the ground and dragged her for a foot or two. When she got to her feet, Nicole said that he then physically pushed her back onto the bed. Nicole grabbed her phone once again and tried to call her own mother. Angered at her attempting to use the phone again, Nicole said that Paulo once again grabbed her by the hair and commenced with dragging her by it. By that time, the neighbors had decided to intervene and knocked on their door. Nicole stated that she grabbed her son, who was lying in the crib in the same room, and ran to the door to tell them what was happening. Immediately after, Nicole said that Paulo ran out of the apartment and into his vehicle, a blue Honda Accord (Fl - IUND99), leaving in an unknown direction. Nicole said that she did not ever give Paulo permission to push her, nor drag her on the ground by her hair. She completed a sworn written statement and expressed her wishes to prosecute for Battery and testify in court. Nicole did have a slight abrasion to her right thumb which occurred from the physical contact, but refused medical treatment and stated that she had no lasting injuries from the altercation. She also affirmed that Liam was never physically harmed or assaulted during the argument and is in good health. Pictures of Liam were also taken for evidentiary purposes.

Nicole and Liam was picked up by trusted family members. She stated that she would be staying with them until this ordeal is settled and cleared. I provided her with a Domestic Rights pamphlet and advised her to cease all future contact with Paulo until a court has deemed it appropriate.

I next called Paulo, who was no longer on scene, and requested his official statement of what happened inside the apartment. He stated that he was no longer in town and was currently in the Greenacres area. He stated that he may have purchased some weed from his neighbor earlier in the day. Having it in the apartment angered Nicole and a heated verbal ensued. Paulo stated that Nicole began to yell and cry without warrant and threatened to call his mother about having drugs. Paulo then admitted to pushing Nicole onto the bed to "calm her down". However, he stated that no other physical contact occurred between the two of them. I advised Paulo that I needed him to come to the BRPD station to fill out a sworn statement as soon as he could. He stated that he would do his best to complete the statement either today or the following day.

Pictures of Nicole and the residence have been documented. Both written statements have also been submitted into evidence. DCF was notified of the incident and provided with the pertinent details for their investigation, employee #176 Laurinda.

Based on my investigation, the sworn statement of Nicole, and the admittance of guilt from Paulo in his verbal statement, I have Probable Cause to believe that Paulo did
