PROBABLE CAUSE

On Sunday January 22, 2017 at approximately 3:26 AM, I (Officer J Franklin) was conducting traffic enforcement in the 500 block of US Highway One. I observed a vehicle traveling north on US Highway One, I visually estimated the vehicle traveling 70 mph hour in a 45 mph zone approaching me. I activated my vehicle front mounted Stalker II radar and received a tone consistent with the speed of 76 mph. I turned out of the median and began to catch up to a white Jeep Wrangler which was the only vehicle present on the roadway. I observed the vehicle slow down and began to make a left turn onto County Line Road, as the vehicle turned the vehicle lost control and turned 180 degrees and rolled back into the Village of Tequesta. I made contact with the driver who was later identified as Pearce A Lowe (W/F DOB 3/9/92). Cpl Valerio arrived and asked the driver if a search of the vehicle could be conducted. Lowe consented to the search and subsequently a small bag containing two (2) Alprazolam bars were found in Lowes wallet. The pills were not contained inside a bottle with a prescription attached and no prescription was found in the vehicle.

I requested Lowe to participate in Field Sobriety Tasks and Lowe consented, see DUI PC attached.

Based upon my investigation Lowe was placed under arrest pursuant to Florida State Statute 893.13(6a) for possession of a controlled substance without a prescription and Driving under the influence pursuant to Florida State Statute 316.193.

If you fail to submit to the test I have requested of you, your privilege to operate a motor vehicle will be suspended for a period of one (1) year for a first refusal, or eighteen (18) months if your privilege has been previously suspended as a result of a refusal to submit to a lawful test of your breath, urine or blood. Additionally, if you refuse to submit to the test I have requested of you and if your driving privilege has been previously suspended for a prior refusal to submit to a lawful test of your breath, urine or blood, you will be committing a misdemeanor. Refusal to submit to the test I have requested of you is admissible into evidence in any criminal proceeding.
